SANAN TO SELL AT KEENELAND NOVEMBER

Satish Sanan, who purchased the two-time Irish champion **Dance Design (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) for a record 2,500,000 guineas at the 1997 Tattersalls December Breeding Stock Sale, will sell the six-year-old mare as part of a 14-horse consignment at this year's Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale. **Dance Design** is one of two mares from the consignment in foal to A.P. Indy; there will also be mares in foal to **Gone West** and **Woodman**, two three-year-old fillies and weanlings by Mr. Prospector, Sadler's Wells and Seeking the Gold. Sanan, a computer software wizard who has become one of the major players at Thoroughbred auctions over the last two years, said he was selling the horses as part of a plan to "consolidate my Thoroughbred holdings so I can concentrate on racing." Keeneland will produce a supplemental catalogue for the Sanan consignment, which, with Eaton Sales as agent, will sell Monday, Nov. 8. This year's November Sale will offer a near-record 4,862 horses and two stallion shares, just 65 lots less than were catalogued last year. There will be 2,314 broodmares, 92 broodmare prospects, 90 racing or broodmare prospects, 20 racing or stallion prospects, 11 stallion prospects and 2,215 weanlings. The 13-day auction begins Sunday, Nov. 7 at noon with the dispersals of Georgia Hofmann's Wycombe House Stud, Robert and Bea Roberts, the estate of the late Paul Mellon and Silverleaf Farms. The Mellon consignment will include 1993 Kentucky Derby winner **Sea Hero**. Beginning Monday, Nov. 8 and running through Nov. 19, the bidding will begin at 10 a.m. daily.

HOMETOWN HORSE TAKES INTERNATIONAL

Thornfield (Sky Classic), who has made every one of his career starts at Woodbine, followed in his sire's hoofsteps to upset the field in the GI Canadian International at Woodbine yesterday afternoon. Off at 18-1, the five-year-old gelding was a perfect two-for-two at the 1 1/2-mile distance of the International and had won five of his last seven starts. He took the Sept. 4 GII Niagara Breeders' Cup H. before running third in the Sept. 25 GIII Sky Classic H. Rated early while saving ground along the rail, the chestnut moved into second as 16-1 **Courteous (GB)** (Generous {Ire}) set sail on the front end, leading by five lengths with two furlongs to run. But **Thornfield** came rolling as the pace took its toll, driving past **Courteous** in deep stretch to win by a length. "It's a great feeling for the home team," winning trainer Phil England said. "We managed to keep the money in Canada. I need a minute of two to think about where he'll go next--we hope it's the Breeders' Cup." **Fruits Of Love** (Hansel), the 9-5 favorite, finished well to get second. Trainer Mark Johnston said, "Everything went right, but he just wasn't in a winning position turning for home...he got shuffled back to last at the top of the turn." Johnston added that the Japan Cup in Tokyo next month will definitely be next.

Insight ended her 1998 season with a win in the Oct. 4 G2 Prix de l'Opera, but had been off the board in three of her four starts this year. The bay was second in a Listed stakes in France Aug. 21 and made her U.S. debut in her next appearance, running fifth by three lengths in the Oct. 3 GI Flower Bowl Invitational H. at Belmont Park. But trainer John Hammond, who earlier this month won the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe with Montjeu (Ire), had the filly ready for her second North American outing. The fifth choice in the seven-horse field, she stalked the soft fractions set by Free Vacation (Fly So Free) while saving ground, angled to the outside on the far turn to take over as they swung into the straight and held off the late charge of Cerulean Sky for the score.

Italian champion jockey Mirco Demuro produced a brilliant ride to secure this dramatic victory for the three-year-old Sumati, who upset the 2-5 favorite Silver Patriarch, winner of last year's edition of the race. Although third in the G2 Premio Parioli (Italian 2000 Guineas) back in April, he failed to win on his three subsequent starts and only came good two weeks ago in a conditions event over nine furlongs here. But that field of older horses did not possess the class of most of these opponents. Sumati's stable companion Jar (Niniski) set a moderate pace from the start, leading from Best Grey (Ezzoud {Ire}) with Sumati in third and Silver Patriarch just behind him. Early in the straight, Best Grey grabbed the lead, with Ivan Luis coming to challenge, but Sumati was cruising on the outside with Silver Patriarch wider still. Demuro sent Sumati to the front inside the final quarter mile and the colt and stayed on gamely, resisting the strong late charge of the unlucky favourite, who was struck into during the race and returned bleeding badly from his off-fore leg. Sumati may now attempt a Group 1 double in the Premio Roma Nov. 7.

Godolphin's Diktat (Warning {GB}) had won four straight, including Group 1 wins in the Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville in August and the Stanley Leisure Cup at Haydock on his last start Sept. 4, and was odds-on to keep the streak alive here. Trans Island tried to make all the running, but Field Of Hope, who traveled in mid-division early, quickened well two furlongs out, taking the lead with 100 yards to run. Keos, second-last with two furlongs to go, finished very fast on the outside to deny Trans Island second in the final stride. Diktat, who drew the outside 11 post, closed strongly between horses but was never really a threat. Winning trainer Pascal Bary said, "Field Of Hope had everything in her favor today with the distance and the soft ground. She ran a good race in the Moulin [sixth to Sendawar (Ire) Sept. 5] and I thought she would run well today. It is possible she will go on to the Breeders' Cup Mile but we will have to see how she comes out of the race. She will be retired to the breeding shed at the end of the season." Diktat is also still a possible Breeders' Cup starter.

The Walmac International Alcibiades has produced the winners of the last two Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies: champions Countess Diana in 1997 and Silverbulletday a year ago. "No doubt about it. She's going to the Breeders' Cup," said trainer Joe Waunsch after his Scratch Pad took this year's Alcibiades. The bay made her first two starts at sprint distances, coming home fourth in her career bow at Calder June 13 and improving on that effort to be third going six furlongs Aug. 15. Stretched out to a two-turn mile for her next, Scratch Pad graduated in style by 9 3/4 lengths Sept. 4, then returned three weeks later to score her first stakes victory in Calder's Brave Raj S. Cash Run broke alertly and set the pace as Scratch Pad, who was very fractious in the gate, edged ever closer while five wide down the backstretch. As the pacesetter began to tire approaching the stretch, jockey Willie Martinez, pinch hitting for Eibar Coa, sent Scratch Run towards the lead and she drew clear despite an erratic finish which saw her drift out late. "She's a big long-striding filly," said Martinez. "I really thought that she would finish the last part of it. She was a little on edge, but I knew if she would settle down and just run...she would have a big chance." Cash Run, the 9-5 second choice, had Craig Perret in the saddle when Jerry Bailey was grounded in New York due to fog. "She pulled on the bridle the whole way," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "When you do that, you don't have much left for the end of the race, and she didn't."

Ancient Title Breeders' Cup H. cont.

After a six-race stint on the turf which culminated with a win in the July 19 Robert Kerlan Memorial H. at Hollywood Park, Lexicon switched to the main track and scored a seven-length victory in a Del Mar allowance Aug. 8. The chestnut was off at 7-5 in his latest and set the pace, but tired to be third in the Sept. 11 Bay Meadows Breeders' Cup Sprint H. Kona Gold, making his first start since running second in the Mar. 6 Gil San Carlos H., was the 4-5 chalk, but second-choice Lexicon had his measure. He broke sharply, set the pace on a clear lead, turned back a challenge from the favorite at the eighth pole and opened up once again to win by daylight in a time three ticks off the track record. "He was sure ready to roll and he was going fast, but he always well within himself," jockey Kent Desormeaux said. "That was the key. He turned for home full of run and we were very fortunate that (Kona Gold) came up the rail at us, because this horse likes that. He would have put a lot of horses away today." Looking toward a berth in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint, trainer Richard Mandella said, "I think he has to be invited because he doesn't have enough points," but he added, "I'm trying to get a plane and ship on Oct. 31." The runner-up is also headed to Gulfstream Park.

The U.K. arm of the British Bloodstock Agency was the most prolific, acquiring 47 for 988,500 guineas (average--21,031 guineas) while the Irish part of the BBA was responsible for 21 for 602,300 guineas (average--28,680 guinea). The other agents in the top 10 purchasers were John Warren, The Curragh Bloodstock Agency, John Ferguson, Amanda Skiffington and Emerald Bloodstock. The only other buyer to reach the top 10 was trainer Peter Harris, who splashed out on 15 for 428,500 guineas (average--28,566 guineas). Ted Voute, agent, was the top vendor, selling 27 lots for 655,600 guineas (average--24,281 guineas), followed by Timmy Hyde's Camas Park Stud with 14 for 654,500 guineas (average--46,750 guineas) and fellow Irish stud, Yeomanstown with 20 for 614,000 guineas (average--30,700 guineas).
