AMILYNX CLAIMS TOP BRANCH

Having served an apprenticeship in Listed races earlier this year, Amilynx (Fr) (Linamix {Fr})'s last two starts were a third in the G3 Prix de Lutece at Longchamp Sept. 9 and a win in the G2 Prix Hubert de Chaudenay at the same course Oct. 2. He turned it up another notch and won his first Group 1 race yesterday in the Prix Royal Oak at Longchamp. Northerntown (Manila) set the pace ahead of Amilynx and Tajoun (Fr) (General Holme). Amilynx struck the front with 1½ furlongs to run, but was immediately tackled by Tajoun. The pair drew a comfortable distance away from the remainder and were inseparable entering the final furlong as Leggera (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) moved into third. Amilynx asserted his superiority inside the last half-furlong and stayed on in determined style for the win. Leggera was later disqualified from third as her rider, Richard Quinn, weighed in without the shammy leather he used to weigh out and was a pound below his alotted weight. Quinn was fined FF8,000 and suspended for eight days by the local stewards as a result of his indiscretion.

WOLF NIPS RIVAL IN MISS GRILLO

Wolf Alert (Wolf Power {SAf}), whose only previous victory was a 4 1/2-length tally over a sloppy Saratoga track in early August, nipped 3-1 second choice Windsong (Unbridled) by a nose at the wire to take vesterday's GIII Miss Grillo S. at Belmont Park. The grey filly had been winless in three turf starts, but ran a strong second against allowance company over this course Oct. 8. Sent off at 9-2, Wolf Alert was always in contention and began drawing off on the turn for home. She dug in gamely deep in the lane to hold off the late-closing Windsong. "When (Jerry Bailey) approached me to ride her, I was ecstatic," said winning trainer Gary Contessa. "When Bailey calls you up and asks to ride your horse, you know he's already handicapped the race and thinks you have the best horse. Last time out, she had a difficult post and might have been able to turn the tables on Danzig's Edge with any kind of ground-saving trip. This time, she got the post, the trip, and everything was in her favor." Contessa added that Wolf Alert will likely get the rest of the year off.

There was no other option to run him again this year except against these older horses and the result proves that a juvenile can beat them. I think he will stay six furlongs next year, but certainly not much further, and we will aim him at all the top sprinting races."

Cox Plate Wrap-Up:

Fresh off her win in Saturday's G1 Cox Plate, Sunline (NZ) (Desert Sun {GB}) is likely to tackle the G1 MacKinnon S. Saturday at Flemington over 2000 meters before a tilt at the Hong Kong International Cup at Sha Tin Dec. 12. "We'll just have to see how she does and play it by ear," said trainer Trevor McKee of the four-year-old who is now the richest Australasian stakes-winning mare, and the fourth Australasian mare to exceed Aus\$3 million in stakes money.

Three-year-olds Testa Rossa (Aus) (Perugino) and Redoute's Choice (Aus) (Danehill) won't back up in Saturday's Aus\$1 million Victoria Derby after finishing fourth and fifth, respectively, in the Cox Plate. Trainer Dean Lawson said Testa Rossa will only have a short spell before returning to prepare for an autumn campaign that will encompass the Aus\$1 million G1 Doncaster H. and the Aus\$1 million G1 Stradbroke H. Rick Hore-Lacy reported Redoute's Choice suffered a superficial wound on his near hind pastern during the race. Hore-Lacy intends to bring the colt back for the G1 Australia S. and the G1 Futurity.

FASIG-TIPTON FALL YEARLING SALE STARTS

TODAY Last year, Four on the Floor (Academy Award) brought \$2,700 at the Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Fall Yearling Sale. This year, the colt has gone undefeated in three starts, taking the GII Summer S. and adding the GI Grey Breeders' Cup S. via a stewards' disqualification, for earnings of \$191,160. The 1999 Fall Yearling Sale gets underway this morning at Newtown Paddocks in Lexington, selling the first of 651 catalogued yearlings. Top sires represented in the offering include Cherokee Run, Danzig, Kingmambo, Miswaki, Mt. Livermore, Phone Trick, Pine Bluff, Red Ransom, Silver Deputy, Storm Cat and Woodman. The lone Danzig, hip no. 443, is a colt out of GISW Buy the Firm (Affirmed), who is a half to GSW Storm Broker (Storm Cat) and a threequarter brother to SW Royal Arrow (Dayjur). Storm Cat is represented by hip no. 299, a filly out of MSW Testy Trestle (Private Account). Bidding begins at 10 a.m. The two-day sale continues tomorrow.

HANDLE UP AT BELMONT FALL MEETING

During Belmont Park's Fall Meet, which concluded Sunday, the total handle average rose 14.6 percent from last year's figures. In 1998, the average for the 33-day meet was \$9,032,103. In 1999, the 32-day average was \$10,350,416. The average on-track handle declined 3.3 percent, from \$1,842,434 to \$1,780,697. The average on-track attendance was also down. The 1998 figure was 7,428 and the 1999 figure was 6,694--a decrease of 9.8 percent. "We're very pleased with the total handle," said New York Racing Association President and COO Terry Meyocks. "Meanwhile, we would have hoped for a better meet on track, so naturally we're disappointed. But with the weather not on our side, it took its toll. Also, when you add in all the competition for the attention of the New York sports fans this fall, it makes it even more understandable." Racing at Aqueduct begins Wednesday with a first post of 12:30 p.m.

TIMES CLAIMS RACING LAUNDERING DRUG MONEY

Britain's leading broadsheet Sunday paper, the Sunday Times, yesterday had a lead story which claimed racing "has been infiltrated by organized crime gangs seeking to launder millions of pounds of drug money," and that "as many as one in 10 jockeys is believed to have been corrupted by gangsters" with bribes of "prostitutes and drugs." The crime syndicates then place large wagers of "dirty" money with bookmakers with "the knowledge that they are likely to win, the winnings paid out in 'clean' cash." Jockey Club spokesman John Maxse said yesterday the alleged scale of the problem was overplayed, but added, "It covers some of the concerns we have already expressed publicly. We said...that the Jockey Club is concerned that some criminals are trying to influence the outcome of races. We are also aware of the amount of illegal betting on- and off-course, which may be used to launder money. The Jockey Club's power is quite limited, only those people who are licensed by us come under our jurisdiction, and we can only pass things on to the police. It is a shame for racing as people may read the piece and believe the generalizations that racing is corrupt, which it isn't. But it highlights that racing is vulnerable, like any betting medium, and maybe we need better protection from the law."

AGA KHAN TO CUT BACK STRING WITH CUMANI

The Aga Khan indicated yesterday that he will sharply reduce the number of horses he has with Newmarket trainer Luca Cumani. This follows the £1,500 fine on Cumani and the disqualification of the Aga Khan-owned Zalal (Ire) after the discovery of prohibited substances when winning at Goodwood in June. Zalal was the second horse owned by the Aga Khan and trained by Cumani in a year to test positive. The owner-breeder said yesterday, "On two occasions, the Jockey Club has drawn attention to his [Cumani's] medical records. It's up to him to look at the situation. In the meantime, I'll have three three-year-olds in training with him next year, Daliapour (Ire) included." He had 22 horses listed in training with Cumani at the start of the year.

RAIN FORCES LINGFIELD TO CHANGE RUNNING ORDER

Heavy rain has caused Lingfield to change its running order for today. The three turf races, which are under threat of waterlogging, have been put after three all-weather races. Clerk of the course Fergus Cameron said yesterday, "We have had an inch of rain in the last 24 hours, but the forecast is for dry weather."
