MONASHEE WINS COMEBACKER

The winner of his only previous start when successful in the Listed Rochestown S. at Leopardstown June 7, Monashee Mountain was returning to the track after a near five-month absence. He was entered for the G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket Oct. 16, and that train of thought was to prove the correct one as he coasted to an easy victory ahead of stablemate Bashkir. The Aidan O'Brien machine looks unstoppable at present. With two maiden wins on the supporting card, he has now registered 64 juvenile successes this season, 14 of those in group company. Monashee Mountain was settled in behind the leader Polish Panache (Gone West), but eased his way into the lead at the quartermile marker. Quickening clear approaching the final furlong, he settled the contest in a matter of strides and was eased nearing the line for an easy win. Bashkir proved best of the remainder, but had no response to Monashee Mountain's decisive burst.

A sextet of D. Wayne Lukas hopefuls posted morning drills yesterday at Churchill Downs headed by GI Frizette winner **Surfside** (Seattle Slew), who went five furlongs in 1:01, the second best of 45 works at the distance. Surfside will try to emulate the performance of her

dam Flanders, who won the 1994 Juvenile Fillies. Also prepping for the Juvenile Fillies were GII Walmac Int'! Alcibiades third Cash Run (Seeking the Gold), who breezed four furlongs in :51, and GII Schuylerville winner Magicalmysterycat (Storm Cat), who got her five panels in 1:03 3/5.

Bob & Beverly Lewis' GI Hopeful winner High Yield (Storm Cat), most recently third to Greenwood Lake in the GI Champagne, drilled seven-eighths of a mile in 1:28 2/5, while fellow Juvenile contender and GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile winner Millencolin (Dehere) breezed five furlongs in 1:01 2/5.

A warrior of the winter three-year-old series at Gulfstream and third in the GI Florida Derby, Cat Thief (Storm Cat), third in the GII Kentucky Cup Classic last out, went seven furlongs in preparation for the Classic in 1:28 2/5.

STRONG BREEZE FOR THE BULLET

Silverbulletday (Silver Deputy) worked seven furlongs in 1:27 yesterday at a windy Gulfstream Park yesterday as she continues her preparation for the Distaff. "There was a real strong headwind down the backstretch so she started slowly," Baffert said. One of the difficult decisions that breeders regularly have to make is whether or not to rest a late-foaling mare. Is it better to take a deliberate decision to rest her, and therefore have every chance of getting her in foal early the next season? Or is it best simply to keep having her mated late in the season until nature makes the decision for you, when the mare eventually fails to get in foal?

I much prefer the idea of resting a mare if she is young and healthy, because there is a danger that she will be under-mated if she is covered late. After all, how many breeders can afford to risk a very high-priced season on a late-foaling mare?

Sheikh Mohammed was faced with this type of decision back in 1989, when his G1-winning filly Flamenco Wave disappointed very badly in her two starts in the spring. She trailed home last in the Athasi S. and the Irish 1000 Guineas, showing nothing approaching the form that had won her both her juvenile starts, including the G1 Moyglare Stud S. Flamenco Wave's second season therefore came to an end May 27, 1989, and she must have been covered almost immediately afterwards because she produced a Sure Blade filly April 28 of the following year.

All horses in the International *TDN* were bred in North America unless otherwise indicated.

I suspect that her connections came to wish that they had not had Flamenco Wave covered as a three-year-old. Although she became a regular producer, her next five foals (by Dancing Brave, Reference Point, Belmez, Soviet Star and Wolfhound) were produced May 16, April 23, May 27, May 15 and May 7 respectively. The odds finally caught up with Flamenco Wave in 1995, when she failed to conceive to her June 6 service by Green Desert, and she was then dispatched to Tattersalls' December Sales.

With no 1996 foal in the offing from Flamenco Wave, the bidding for this nine-year-old G1 winner rose no higher than 45,000 guineas, with the successful bid coming from none other than Coolmore supremo John Magnier. Magnier's purchase has proved to be inspired. Although Flamenco Wave was credited in the sales catalogue with only two minor winners from four foals of racing age, one of those winners was Spanish Falls. This daughter of Belmez narrowly won the G3 Prix de Royaumont over 1½ miles in 1996 and better was to follow in 1997, when Starborough, Flamenco Wave's Soviet Star colt, recorded G1 victories in the Prix Jean Prat and St James's Palace S. after finishing a creditable fourth in the 2,000 Guineas.

By the time Starborough was strutting his stuff as a three-year-old, Flamenco Wave had already produced her first foal for her new owners, a February-foaled colt by Sadler's Wells. This colt, named Aristotle, became Flamenco Wave's third Group winner when he slogged through the Doncaster mud to catch tiring rivals in the G1 Racing Post Trophy. This was his second win from as many starts, following a debut win over seven furlongs at Galway in July, and this lazy colt looks likely to be even more effective once he has 1½ miles to tackle next year.

With two G1 winners for his parents, Aristotle is certainly bred well enough to be a classic contender, even though Flamenco Wave was one of the few good winners by Desert Wine. His second dam, Armada Way, earned a Blood-Horse Free Handicap rating of 115 as a three-year-old, and his fourth dam, Fleet Flight, is ancestress of several good performers, none better than White Muzzle, who went close to winning the King George and the Arc. As Fleet Flight was herself a half-sister to the very smart American juveniles Leallah and Lea Lane, Flamenco Wave is by no means the first very good broodmare from this female line.

THE GRASS IS GREENER...

Trainer Neil Drysdale couldn't wait for the Gulfstream turf course to open for training Wednesday and instead sent his three runners across town to work at Calder. Mile candidate Hawksley Hill (Ire) (Rahy) and Turf probable Single Empire (Ire) (Kris {GB}) worked seven furlongs in company in 1:33, while 1998 champion turf filly Fiji (GB) (Rainbow Quest) was clocked in 1:33 2/5 for the same distance. "I didn't have any choice but to ship them to Calder to work," said Drysdale. "They all went well and I'm pleased with their works."

DICKINSON HAS ONE AFTER ALL

Supreme Sound (GB) (Superlative {Ire}), the wire-to-wire winner of the GIII Hawthorne Gold Cup last out, will make his next start in the Classic, according to trainer Michael Dickinson. "He'll improve off his last race, but it might not be good enough. If the rail is golden and if we draw on the inside, he could have a shot to get a piece of it," Dickinson told the Blood-Horse Online. In the meantime, Old Trieste (A.P. Indy) came out of the GII Goodwood with a foot abscess and his Classic participation hinges on a workout at the end of the week.

STORM CAT FILLY TOPS STRONG FASIG

OPENER A bay filly by Storm Cat out of multiple stakes winner Testy Trestle (Private Account) brought a final bid of \$925,000 to top the opening session of the two-day Fasig-Tipton Kentucky Fall Yearling Sale at Lexington, Kentucky. Sold as hip number 299, the filly was consigned to the sale by Eaton Sales as agent. The vearling is the third foal from her dam, herself a full sister to both Classy Cathy (MGISW) and Ms. Margi (SW & GISP) and a half sister to MGSW Sports View (Cox's Ridge). Testy Trestle was purchased at the 1997 Keeneland November Mixed Sale for \$950,000 by Gilman Investment Co. and was also consigned to that sale by Eaton Sales as agent. The top-selling colt of the afternoon was hip number 195, which went for a final bid of \$155,000 to Don Snellings acting as agent. The dark bay was consigned by Westover Ridge, agent as the property of John W. Rooker. The average price for the first session was \$16,051, up some 59 percent against the corresponding figure from a year ago. Gross receipts were in excess of \$3.3 million, a figure which represents a 50 percent increase against 1998. The sale's final session kicks off this morning at 10 a.m. with 324 yearlings cataloged for sale.

Toribio Notches 1,000th Victory:

Abdiel Toribio earned the 1,000th win of his career yesterday at Calder when he guided Brassy Fred to victory in the eighth race. Toribio was the second jockey to reach the plateau at the current Calder meeting, following Rosemary Homeister, Jr. who earned her 1,000th win on Oct. 9. The 28-year-old Panamanian was involved in a spill on Saturday and was forced to miss his riding engagements on Sunday. "I could have done it yesterday (Sunday), because two of my horses won," Toribio explained. "I am looking forward to the next thousand wins."

Progressive Irish sprinter Rolo Tomasi (Ire) (Mujtahid {USA}}, who won the Listed Waterford Testimonial S. at The Curragh Oct. 16, went for 150,000 guineas to agent Peter Dovle, who overcame Margaret O'Toole and the Curragh Bloodstock Agency's Susie McKeever, who was with American trainer Wally Dollase. The threeyear-old will join champion Scandinavian trainer Wido Neuroth and Doyle said, "He's the best sprinter in Ireland." Shadoof (GB) (Green Desert {USA}), at 105,000 guineas, was another snapped up by Gordon-Watson and the 10-furlong handicapper will continue racing in Saudi Arabia. American buyers were in evidence and two first-time visitors were Pete Bradley and Neil Bowden, Johnny McKeever of the CBA paid 70,000 guineas on their behalf for three-year-old miler Tobruk (Ire) (Red Ransom {USA}), who will be trained by Richard Lundy, and 66,000 guineas for three-year-old filly Gino's Spirits (GB) (Perugino {USA}), G2-placed, who will join Elliott Walden. The aggregate and average were sharply up compared with last year, for the first day of the four-day sale. Ray Cochrane, suspended for two days, including Melbourne Cup day a week today for careless riding on Dancing Phantom at Doncaster Saturday, believes he will still be able to ride in Australia's most famous race. The British rules allow a two-day ban not to count with Group 1 races. Cochrane said, "I have spoken to Lynn Williams at the [British] Jockey Club disciplinary committee and he said he will be sending a letter to the Australian Jockey Club in due course, and provided they uphold the rule, it will be okay." He is due to ride the James Fanshawe-trained Travelmate (GB) (Persian Bold {GB}).
