### **VICAR SHARP AT GULFSTREAM**



Sprint hopeful Vicar (Wild Again)
zipped five furlongs in :59 4/5 at
Gulfstream yesterday. The three-yearold, who won the 1 1/8-mile GI Florida
Derby and 1 1/16-mile GI Fountain Of
Youth S., dropped back to six furlongs

for the first time in his career in the Phoenix Breeders' Cup S. at Keeneland last time out and finished third, beaten just a neck. Is he a Grade I sprinter? "If you go out there and they knock him down, run him over and shut him off, everybody will say he wasn't a sprinter anyway," trainer Carl Nafzger said. "If the lanes open up, they'll say, 'what a great horse.' It's just a matter of the way things unfold in the race."

### ORSENO DUO ON WORK TAB

Trainer Joe Orseno sent two of his Breeders' Cup contenders out to breeze yesterday, with Classic entrant Golden Missile (A.P. Indy) going five furlongs in 1:02 over a fast main track and "Distaff Turf" filly Perfect Sting (Red Ransom) getting a half in :52 over a soft turf. Orseno was happy with the condition of the course. "The turf course was in good shape and she handled it well," he said. "The time might not have seemed that impressive, but it wasn't about time. The 'dogs' were way out and that's good because I want them to save the turf course."

### A BULLET FOR TALK BACK

Undefeated Talk Back (Talkin Man), who posted a 6 1/2-length victory in the Princess Elizabeth S. at Woodbine Oct. 16, zipped three furlongs in :33 4/5 on her way to a five-furlong breeze in 1:00 1/5 over the Canadian oval yesterday. The Juvenile Fillies runner galloped out six furlongs in 1:14 2/5. "I just wanted her to get some dirt in her face, so I put a two-year-old about five lengths in front at the start and she caught up before they went three eighths," trainer Robert Tiller said. "The time was spectacular for the deep racetrack. Her ears were up in the stretch. I've got her as ready as I can and the rest is up to her." The filly, along with Turf candidate Thornfield (Sky Classic) and Mile alternate Dawson's Legacy (Roanoke), will ship to Lexington tomorrow, spend the night, then head to Louisville Monday morning for a flight to Ft. Lauderdale.

### LAST LAUGH FOR COMIC STRIP AT BIG A?

Comic Strip (Red Ransom), on the board in eight of his nine grass starts with four wins, will try to go fivefor-10 in today's \$100,000 GII Knickerbocker H. at Aqueduct. The four-year-old suffered his lone grassy loss when he ran seventh over a soft course in his only other start over the Big A turf, the GIII Fort Marcy H. in May. But he has won three of his five starts since, including a 2 1/2-length tally in the Aug. 28 GIII Fourstardaye H., then finished a rallying second in the Sept. 25 GII Belmont Breeders' Cup H. last time out. "I'm not shocked at the year he has had," trainer Neil Howard said of the colt who captured the GIII Louisiana Derby and has earned more than \$500,000 on the dirt. "You never want to anticipate too much, but we thought he could be a good grass horse." Wised Up (Dixieland Band), the winner of the Fort Marcy despite nearly falling after clipping heels early in the race, is a perfect two-for-two over the Aqueduct turf. The fouryear-old bruised his hoof in the GI Manhattan H. next time out, then had to compete with a bar shoe for the next two months, finishing off the board in three of his four appearances. "He was just never comfortable in the bar shoe, and one spot on the hoof staved really sensitive," trainer Rich DeStasio explained. "He has run better since the shoe came off." The bay was third. beaten a length and a half, in the Belmont Breeders' Cup, then finished third again in the Oct. 16 GII Kelso H. at a flat mile. "He got carried out by a horse inside of him (in the Kelso) and that may have cost him second," DeStasio said.

### BAEDEKER NAMED HOLLYWOOD PARK

PRESIDENT Rick Baedeker was yesterday named president of Hollywood Park by the track's owner, Churchill Downs Incorporated. Churchill completed its purchase of Hollywood in August. Baedeker, a native Californian, served as vice president of marketing and public relations for Hollywood Park from 1992-98 and as senior vice president of marketing for the National Thoroughbred Racing Association, where he remains a special assistant. He was most recently the vice president of communications for Television Games Network. Baedeker will assume his new post Nov. 10, opening day of the Autumn Meet.

# STRONG FOREIGN INTEREST HIGHLIGHTS TATTERSALLS AUTUMN SALES

The five-day Tattersalls Autumn Horses in Training and Yearling Sales ended last night with a session after racing at Newmarket. The best price yesterday among the yearlings came for an Emperor Jones (USA) colt, bought for 11,500 guineas last year, who achieved 17,500 guineas and will go to trainer Bryan Smart. Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony commented on a successful week's trading, "There is nothing quite like the Autumn Horses In Training Sale anywhere else in the world, and each year the sale attracts a cosmopolitan crowd of buyers, but even regular observers remarked on the extraordinary number of overseas buyers at this year's sale. As well as the sheer number of buvers from abroad, the other crucial factor has been the depth of the demand at all levels of the market. At the top end, a large number of North American buyers, many of them here courtesy of a joint DTI/Tattersalls Inward Mission, have been active, as have Saudi Arabian buyers and British and Irish National Hunt connections. In the middle market, buyers from Hong Kong, Macau, Malaysia, Singapore and the traditional European markets have been strong, while new European markets including Bosnia, Cyprus, Greece, Poland and Spain and prolific buying from a large Kuwaiti contingent have ensured a very high clearance rate."

### **LEVY DEAL TERMED A "MACABRE JOKE"**

British racing figures responded angrily to yesterday's levy deal which will give the sport an increase next year of £8 million to £61 million, a 15 percent rise. British Horseracing Board chairman Peter Savill said he was staggered by the Levy Board's acceptance of the bookmaking industry's revised offer and called for the levy system to be scrapped. Industry Committee chairman Rhydian Morgan-Jones described the agreement as a macabre joke while Racecourse Association chairman Angus Crichton-Miller said the betting industry contribution was completely inadequate. Racehorse Owners Association president Sir Eric Parker called the settlement an insult to every racehorse owner in Britain and Jockey Club Senior Steward Christopher Spence called the settlement deeply disappointing. Bookmakers' Committee chairman Warwick Bartlett said, "We have made an extremely generous offer amounting to £61 million in total given current turnover estimates."
