#### FIJI IS FINISHED

According to Daily Racing Form, trainer Neil Drysdale has decided to retire Prince Fahd Salman's five-year-old mare Fiji (GB) (Rainbow Quest) after not being able to satisfactorily ready her for

the Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf. She will be bred to A.P. Indy next season. She had been off a year with an airway infection after winning the 1998 GI Yellow Ribbon S., returning to run sixth in the same race this year. She was then third in the Vinery First Lady at Keeneland Oct. 14.

#### BANSHEE BREEZE ON TRACK FOR DISTAFF

Banshee Breeze (Unbridled), one of the favorites for the Distaff, was out on the Gulfstream strip Saturday, working a half-mile in 50 seconds over a good track with the "dogs" at 12 feet. "She went good, just what we wanted," said trainer Carl Nafzger. "I'm very happy with the way she is training. I think she is as good as she ever was."

#### FORTY ONE CARATS IS GOLDEN IN PEGASUS

Forty One Carats broke his maiden by 13 lengths in his fourth career start at Gulfstream going seven furlongs Feb. 20. He then returned to take a Gulfstream allowance and ran second in the GIII Flamingo S. at Hialeah Apr. 3. After being on the sidelines for five months, the chestnut colt came back to win a Calder allowance Sept. 4, then annexed the Oct. 2 Indiana Derby at Hoosier Park. Away alertly and guided to the front by Jorge Chavez, Forty One Carats set a good pace while racing off the rail, took a commanding lead into the stretch and was desperate to hold off a fast-closing Unbridled Jet at the wire.

One of the best juveniles in France in 1997, Charge d'Affaires won the G1 Prix Morny in only his fourth lifetime start and closed out his freshman campaign with second-place finishes in the G1 Prix de la Salamandre and G1 Grand Criterium. A disappointing three-year-old season saw the colt register only one inthe-money finish, that coming when second to top European sprinter Tomba in the G1 Prix de la Foret in his final European start last Oct. 18. Switched to the care of Christophe Clement in the U.S., the bay was a half-length winner of a one-mile Saratoga allowance Aug. 22 before a troubled trip in the GI Atto Mile at Woodbine, where he struck the rail at the half-mile pole and finished 14th. Charge d'Affaires was taken inside by jockey Jose Santos and saved ground while well in hand through easy fractions dictated by longshot Nat's Big Party. At the top of the lane, Santos asked for run from the four-year-old and he quickened up nicely to overtake the leader at the sixteenth-pole and had just enough left to hold off odds-on Comic Strip for the narrow victory. Said Santos, "We were a little concerned about the mile and an eighth. I just kept him behind horses and just asked him the last quarter-mile."

Belle Cherie, winner of last year's GIII Miss Grillo S. over the Belmont turf, was switched to the main track for the first time in the GIII Honey Bee H. at the Meadowlands and responded with a come-from-behind victory at odds of 26-1. She nearly duplicated that performance in the GII Cotillion Oct. 2 at Philadelphia Park, but finished a length out in fourth due to a wide trip. The co-third choice at 6-1, Belle Cherie raced close up on the inside early, began her run turning for home, angled out to find room and quickly scampered away to win by three lengths. "She'll stay on dirt for the rest of this year," said trainer Phil Johnson. "Her next race will either be the [GIII] Ladies H. [at Aqueduct] or the [GIII] Falls City H. at Churchill Downs."

Third over the Saratoga turf off her maiden-breaking victory, the sophomore filly strung together back-to-back allowance victories before testing graded-stakes waters in the GIII Pebbles H. at Belmont, a race in which she finished second, beaten a half-length. Colstar broke alertly and took up a stalking position two lengths behind frontrunning Chimes Tower (Imperial Falcon) through six furlongs over the soft going in 1:14 3/5. The bay launched a bid from the two path into the stretch, assumed a daylight advantage at the furlong marker, then was fully extended to hold Polaire safe for the win. Victorious trainer Paul Fout indicated that his filly would likely be put away for the winter, before launching a springtime campaign.

Irish trainer Aidan O'Brien seeks to achieve a clean sweep of all four Group 1 juvenile events in France this season, having won the Prix Morny with Fasliyev, the Prix de la Salamandre with Giant's Causeway and the Grand Criterium with Ciro. He saddles the odds-on favorite here in the unbeaten Royal Kingdom, who goes for his fourth straight win, having previously taken the Listed Tyros S. at The Curragh Aug. 14 and the G2 Royal Lodge S. at Ascot on his most recent start Sept. 26. He is the only Group race winner in the field. His main opposition may come from his compatriot Sharp Focus, but he has already beaten him in the Tyros S. and Sharp Focus was only third to Royal Kingdom's stable companions Lermontov and Barrier Reef in the G3 Juddmonte Beresford S. at The Curragh Oct. 16. Two unbeaten French colts, Cosmographe and Goldamix, are in the line-up, but they have had only one race each, both winning conditions events at Maisons-Laffitte Oct. 1, and the best local hopes appear to be Crystal D'Ass and Petroselli, second and third respectively in the G3 Prix de Conde at Longchamp Oct. 2.

Highlights of the day's earlier action were the sales of two good-looking colts by first-crop sires. At Ir£13,000, Irish trainer Ger Lyons got a Bishop of Cashel (GB) colt, the first foal of a Seeking the Gold (USA) mare now in New Zealand, from the family of Late Bloomer (USA) and Ends Well (USA), while for Ir£12,000, Ballylinch Stud sold a half-brother by their new Sadler's Wells (USA) horse King's Theatre (Ire) to good Irish sprinter Bawnanell (Ire).
