SWEET FINAL WORK FOR LEMON DROP



The pattern is an eerie one. Third in the GII Peter Pan S. over a sloppy Belmont main track, **Lemon Drop Kid** (Kingmambo) returned in his next start to take the GI Belmont S. Given time off, the "Kid" was second to **Ecton**

Park (Forty Niner) in Saratoga's GII Jim Dandy S., also on a wet strip and he came back three weeks later to win the GI Travers. Rested for the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup, the bay caught yet another off track in a fifth-place finish behind River Keen (Ire) (Keen {GB}). Lemon Drop Kid had his final pre-Classic drill yesterday, over, you guessed it, a sloppy Gulfstream main track, getting five furlongs in 1:00 1/5 around the dogs. "I wasn't keen on working him in the slop," said trainer Scotty Schulhofer, who expressed confidence in his colt. "I think he's as good as anybody and I think he fits right at the top," he said.

STEVENS ARRIVES FOR CUP

After catching a red-eye from Los Angeles, jockey Gary Stevens had only a couple of hours of sleep Saturday night, but was up early to guide Juvenile contender Anees (Unbridled) through a six-furlong drill in 1:13 1/5 over the sloppy going at Gulfstream Park Sunday. "I was really impressed with his work," Stevens said. "He went nice and straight all the way around and he galloped out good." The California jockey's other rides Saturday are Vision and Verse (Storm Cat), Classic; Royal Anthem (Theatrical {Ire}), Turf; Docksider (Diesis {GB}), Mile; Spain (Thunder Gulch), Juvenile Fillies; and Pleasant Temper (Storm Cat), Filly/Mare Turf.

KIMMEL PAIR WORKS IN COMPANY

GII Kentucky Cup Sprint winner Successful Appeal (Valid Appeal) and GI Champagne runner-up Chief Seattle (Seattle Slew) worked five furlongs in company yesterday in 1:01, though the work was somewhat eventful for one of the John Kimmel trainees. "I didn't see it, but I'm told that (Successful Appeal) tried to jump the dogs at both the five-eighths pole and three-eighths pole," said Kimmel.

FAVORITE FAILS IN FINAL FRENCH GROUP 1

The Criterium de Saint-Cloud was the last French Group 1 race of the season, but trainer Aidan O'Brien's bid to take all bar one of France's top juvenile events came unstuck on the rain-sodden Saint-Cloud turf. O'Brien's 2-5 favorite Royal Kingdom (Fairy King) could do no better than fifth as Goldamix (Ire) (Linamix (Fr)) led home a French 1-2-3-4, giving trainer Carlos Laffon-Parias his second consecutive win in the event, following Spadoun (Fr) last year. The winner, the lone filly in the race, remained unbeaten, having taken a conditions event at Maisons-Laffitte Oct. 1 on her only other racecourse appearance. She raced keenly in the early stages alongside Crystal D'Ass (Fr) (Northern Crystal {GB}), but was given her head to stride into the outright lead after a guarter mile and brought the field up the center of the track turning for home as her opponents fanned out behind her waiting to make their bids. Goldamix was ridden into a two-length lead at the guarter-mile marker as her rivals came under pressure as one. Petroselli (Ire) (Grand Lodge), trained by Laffon-Parias' mother-in-law, Criquette Head, closed slightly inside the last half-furlong, but Goldamix kept on resolutely despite showing signs of inexperience to record a deserved win, with Dominique Boeuf punching the air as he passed the finish. Laffon-Parias said, "She is a talented filly who was taking a big step up in class for only her second start. She had worked so brilliantly on Tuesday that I was quite confident going into the race even if I thought that Royal Kingdom would be hard to beat. My main concern was that, as a daughter of Linamix, she might have run her race in her work and not repeat. She proved brave and courageous and it is guite hard to make all like she did. She will return next year with high hopes that she will make it in the Classic races." Boeuf was celebrating his fifth winner of the race. Petroselli lost no caste in defeat as the pair finished well clear of third-placed Cosmographe (Fr) (Lomitas {GB}). (Criterium chart, p2)

America's hope for the Cup, Amerique (St. Jovite), was withdrawn Friday after Joan Wakefield, who arrived last weekend to supervise for trainer Michael Dickinson, said the six-year-old was tying up after he worked. The withdrawal of Amerique leaves Yavana's Pace, Travelmate and Godolphin's Central Park as the remaining international visitors. Godolphin's trainer Saeed bin Suroor said, "This is a very important race for us--it is one of the top five races in the world. We learned from Faithful Son (seventh last year) to send the right sort of horse. Next year we will try a different system, a different horse and maybe we will send more than one horse for the Cup." All week, bookmakers were predicting Tie The Knot would start the shortestpriced Melbourne Cup favorite in modern history at around 2-1, but Sky Heights firmed to 7-2 after drawing barrier one. Tie The Knot was eased to 7-1 after a flop in Saturday's G1 Mackinnon S. The gelding has been cleared to run following a veterinary check after the Mackinnon S., but trainer Guy Walter stressed his horse wouldn't run unless he was "100 percent right." He plans to use blinkers for the first time.

Sixth in this race a year ago, Littlebitlively followed that performance with a narrow loss to Silver Charm in the GII Clark H. A pair of subpar efforts ensued before the Franks homebred got back on the beam, but the five-year-old now has been on the board in eight of his last nine starts. Runner-up behind Behrens in the Apr. 3 GI Oaklawn H., he picked up his second straight GIII Texas Mile win two weeks later and missed by a nose in the May 31 Lone Star Park H. A fourth-place finish in the GII Iselin H. at Monmouth July 4 led to a layoff, but the dark bay returned with a perfect prep for this when second in a Keeneland allowance Oct. 15. As the gates opened, the speed came from the outside as Run Johnny established a short lead and Littlebitlively kept within striking distance in the four path. As the field reached the top of the lane, Pat Day still had Run Johnny in front, but Littlebitlively began to advance while still four wide, collared the pacesetter inside the final sixteenth and proved just best to eclipse \$1 million in career earnings. "I didn't think we were going to get (Run Johnny)," trainer Bobby Barnett said, "I thought we were going to run out of ground first. But (Calvin Borel) rode him superbly. He laid off the pace and maybe we learned something today." The dark bay goes next in the Nov. 26 GII Clark H. at Churchill. Tactical Cat, making his second start off a lengthy layoff, closed well from midpack to get the show.


