I was pleased with his work and even more pleased that he drew in off the preferred list yesterday." Of Dark Moondancer, McAnally added, "I was satisfied with his work. He went good and it doesn't seem the flight over here has bothered him any."

Jim and Tonic (Fr) (Double Bed {Fr}) worked four furlongs in :52 3/5 over Gulfstream's 'good' turf course yesterday. "It was a good work," commented trainer Francois Doumen. As for race strategy, Doumen said, "We'll be waiting with him--I wouldn't like him to be too near the front--so I think we'll be in the first third of the field early. It all depends how they jump out of the stalls, but usually he's fast enough to get a good position."

SURUMU DEAD Legendary German sire Surumu (Ger) (Literat {Ger}) died Wednesday afternoon after suffering a heart attack while grazing in his paddock at Gestut Fahrhof in Germany. The 25-year-old stallion captured the 1977 G1 German Derby and G2 Union-Rennen. Retired to stud in 1979, Surumu has sired 308 winners from 375 runners. His progeny have earned over DM22 million. He has been represented by 88 stakes winners and 19 group winners. Surumu sired German Derby winners and multiple Group 1 scorers Acatenango, Mondrian and Temporal as well as Platini and the champion fillies Alte Zeit, Arastou and La Colorada.

The well-related Vision's Flight, a full brother to Dolphin Street (Fr), bids to follow up his debut victory in a conditions event at Maisons-Laffitte Oct. 12. Speak In Passing boasts similar credentials having also won his only start, a conditions race at Deauville July 7. The pair, both impressive when winning, will face sturdy opposition. Blu Air Force has won four of his seven starts, all at Milan, and has been successful in his last three outings, culminating with a win in the Listed Premio Eupili at San Siro Oct. 16. The consistent Perugina was successful in the G3 Prix Eclipse at Saint-Cloud Oct. 15 on her latest start and will bid to confirm the form of that race with Touch Of The Blues (third) and Radhwa (unplaced). Akeed appears the best of the two British-trained challengers, and this half brother of Victory Gallop will seek to improve his record to twofrom-three.

JOCKEY CLUB TO REQUIRE JOCKEY SEMINARS

The Jockey Club yesterday announced that from the start of next year, jockeys will be forced to attend race-riding seminars in future as a condition of their license. There will be three seminars for flat jockeys in April and May and two for National Hunt riders in the winter. Malcolm Wallace, the Jockey Club's director of regulation, said yesterday, "Every year, jockeys get suspended and lose their livelihood unnecessarily because they may not fully understand the rules and how they are implemented. We very much hope that these seminars will prevent that in the future. In 1998 we held three jockeys' seminars on a voluntary basis. However, of the 500 jockeys licensed at the time, only a total of 28 attended. It has been agreed that from next year, all riders applying for a professional jockeys' license will give an undertaking to attend a seminar."
