NORTHERN DANCER MARE HEADS KEENELAND DAY 7

Northern Aspen (Northern Dancer), a Grade I-winning half-sister to eight stakes winners, including 1994 Two-Year-Old Champion Timber Country (Woodman), topped Saturday's session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale, selling for \$325,000. The 17-year-old was consigned by Hill 'n' Dale Sales Agency as agent for Brookside Farms and was bought by Aisling Cross, as agent. Youth was served as four-year-old Green Chartreuse (Green Dancer), a half-sister to millionaire GISW Victory Speech (Deputy Minister), went for \$285,000 to Gainesway as agent. The top weanling, who brought \$285,000 from Cam Allard, is by Dixieland Band out of Honey Bee Gold (Drone), whose second dam, Gold Sun (Arg) (Solazo), is also the second dam of two-time Horse of the Year Cigar (Palace Music). The record-breaking sale, which has grossed more than \$284 million so far, still has six days to run. (Statistics P. 3)

LET GOES...SCORES FIRST GRADED WIN

Let (A.P. Indy) added considerably to her residual value in capturing her first graded stakes score. The dark bay, second in the GI Ashland as a sophomore, started the year off indifferently, finishing unplaced in her first four outings. She turned things around with a sharp tally in Monmouth's Inside Information S. in July and, after being headed by Roza Robata in a Saratoga allowance Aug. 9, returned to the Jersey Shore for a game victory in the Personal Ensign S. Aug. 28. Shipped to Kentucky, Let rallied to be second in the GIII Turfway Breeders' Cup before running a lackluster ninth in the GI Spinster S. at Keeneland Oct. 19. Unhurried early, she settled at the back of the pack and moved into contention approaching the half. Making a sweeping five-wide move on the turn, Let caught pacesetter Ruby Surprise (Farma Way) after three-quarters in 1:09 3/5 and quickly opened up on the field. Jockev Calvin Borel took a peek behind at the sixteenth pole and geared the four-year-old down in the final strides. "I worked this filly about four days ago and she went in 46 and change," said Borel. "It was just unbelievable." Assistant trainer Jack Bohannon added, "We've looked at her poor race in the Spinster and we still don't know what happened to her."

A Group 3 winner in England and third in last year's G1 English Oaks, Midnight Line had cashed a check in each of her six U.S. starts to date. She was third in the GII Santa Barbara H. and GIII Yerba Buena H., second in the GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. and fourth in the July 3 GI Beverly Hills H. before getting a rest. She returned with a third in the GIII Canadian H. at Woodbine Sept. 19, and was third again in the GI E.P. Taylor S., beaten 3 1/2 lengths. With the scratch of likely pacesetter Free Vacation (Fly So Free), jockey Jerry Bailey decided to put the newly blinkered Midnight Line on the lead and nursed the field through very pedestrian fractions, including six furlongs in 1:16 3/5 and the mile in 1:42. As the field turned for home, Midnight Line repulsed a challenge to her lead from Black Mystery (Miswaki), shook loose to lead by 1 1/2 lengths at the eighth pole, then held on for an easier victory than the margin indicated. "She's got a long and steady stride and I wanted to keep it smooth," said Bailey. "Once we turned for home, she responded and no one could really close."

Having broken his maiden at the second attempt at Longchamp Aug. 31, Hightori was fifth in the G3 Prix de Conde at Longchamp Oct. 2. He returned to winning ways in a conditions race at Longchamp Oct. 24. He was restrained in midfield as Loyal Tartare (Astair {Fr}) led. Crystal D'Ass assumed the mantle of leader at the quarter-mile marker, but was soon tackled by Hightori, who grabbed the lead approaching the final furlong. Hightori was ridden clear inside the final half-furlong to record a comfortable victory with Crystal D'Ass staying on to be a safe second.
