FINAL LOT TOPS KEENELAND THURSDAY

Saving the best for the last, Hip 4542, a weanling colt by Is It True--Snooker, by Pool Court, brought \$72,000 to close out Thursday's session of the Keeneland November Sale. Consigned by Eaton Sales as agent for Deer Haven Farm, he was purchased by Whitestone Farm. Love Tunnel, a seven-year-old mare in foal to Acceptable was the top-selling broodmare at \$62,000. The half-sister to the dam of MGISW Val's Prince was consigned by Mr. & Mrs. William Wofford, agent, and bought by Roger Toffolon. The record-setting sale ends today with a 10 a.m. session. NEW ZEALAND SALE SKYROCKETS

Trainer Roger James gave top price of NZ\$300,000 (\$153,838) for the much-hyped three-quarter brother to 10-time Group 1 winner Octagonal (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}--Eight Carat {GB}) at the New Zealand Bloodstock Ready To Run Sale at Karaka, near Auckland, Wednesday, Nov. 17. The two-year-old, by Zabeel out of Great Klaire (GB) (Great Nephew {GB}), was the star of the 168 juveniles sold at the two-day sale, which averaged NZ\$43,804 (\$22,462), an almost 45 percent increase on last year's average of just over \$NZ30,000 (\$15,384). Over the past three years, the sale average has jumped more than 200 percent. The select session sale aggregate of NZ\$7,359,000 (\$3,773,636) was up 49 percent from last year's NZ\$4,948,000 (\$2,537,295). Fourteen two-year-olds went for NZ\$100,000 or more, compared with just four last year, while 51 went for NZ\$50,000 or more, as opposed to 24 in 1998. New Zealand Bloodstock as agent was leading buyer, with orders for Asian clients in particular, spending NZ\$873,000 (\$447,667). The second-leading buyer was Randwick-based trainer Graeme Rogerson, who purchased 14 lots, totaling NZ\$758,500 (\$388,953). Asian buyers were much in force, with several Hong Kong, Singapore, Malaysia and Macau trainers and agents accounting for a significant slice of the sale.

Jockey Club Signs Australian Data Accord:

The Jockey Club announced Thursday that it will expand content for its global database to include full racing and pedigree information from Australia following an agreement with the Australian Racing Services Bureau. The agreement will also provide a more accurate account of shuttle stallion activity. "Australia's emergence as a primary destination for Northern Hemisphere stallions is further evidence of our industry's involvement into a truly global marketplace," said Jockey Club president Hans Stahl. The automated transfer of Australian information is expected to start, and be available to the general public, early in 2000.

NTRA Contributions Increase:

During the Keeneland September Yearling Sale, contributions to the National Thoroughbred Racing Association more than doubled from last year. Contributions were made by buyers, sellers, consignors and Keeneland itself. "The response to the voluntary contribution program in effect for the September sales was very gratifying," said Nick Nicholson, chairman of the NTRA advisory committee on funding and a special assistant to the group's commissioner, Tim Smith. "We thank everyone who invested in racing through this contribution and thank Keeneland especially for reminding buyers of this options by putting it on their invoices. That made a big difference." Buyers at Keeneland September contributed \$130,000 while seller/consignor participation reached \$150,000.
