"MONARCH" RULES RED SMITH

Three-for-five on the lawn, Monarch's Maze (Kingmambo) captured the GII Jamaica H. over the Belmont turf last time out Oct. 17, but was 14-1 taking on his elders in yesterday's GII Red Smith H. at Aqueduct. The three-year-old showed the older crowd no respect, closing from dead last after six furlongs to best 8-1 Williams News (Alleged) by a length. "He's really beginning to open his eyes," winning jockey Joe Bravo said. "I turned him loose at the three-eighths pole and he really responded. He's a very special colt. He just blew them away today." Trainer Pat Kelly added, "We know we have a good horse for next year. Now we just have to decide whether we want to go to Gulfstream or wait until spring." Veteran Johns Call (Lord at War {Arg}) was the slight 3-1 favorite in the overflow field, but after winning back-to-back stakes in the Oct. 24 Bald Eagle Breeders' Cup H. and Nov. 11 GIII Laurel Turf Cup, the eight-year-old was stuck in traffic after rating on the inside early and could make no headway in the stretch, running ninth. "I had no breaks at all," said his jockey, Steve Hamilton. "I had plenty of horse, but I had to sit with nowhere to go."

LAST LAUGH FOR SILVER COMIC

St Clair Ridge (Ire) (Indian Ridge (Ire)) was the 17-10 favorite in yesterday's GII Mrs. Revere S. at Churchill Downs, but it was her less-fancied stablemate Silver Comic (Silver Hawk) who had the last laugh, rallying past the favorite in the final furlong and drawing off to give trainer Elliott Walden a one-two finish in the race. Making her stakes debut, Silver Comic was coming off two straight allowance wins, scoring at Keeneland Oct. 17 and again over this course Nov. 6. Off at 6-1 facing graded foes, the bay was rated while wide early, joined the speedier St Clair Ridge for the stretch drive and proved best, getting 2 1/4 lengths clear at the wire. "These two fillies complement each other with their running styles," Walden said. "One filly has speed and the other comes from behind. (Silver Comic) is now three-for-three here at Churchill, and (St Clair Ridge) is real nice, too, so I thought I had a good hand going into this race. They'll both go on the shelf now at Payson Park." Jockey Pat Day, aboard the runner-up, said, "We got away with some pretty realistic fractions. In the drive, she didn't hold anything back. She just couldn't finish up with (Silver Comic)."

New Japanese Dirt Race Open to Foreign Horses:

The Japan Racing Association announced an increase in the purse of the G1 Japan Cup to ¥528.5 million, and the formation of a new race, the Japan Dirt Cup, to be run Nov. 25, 2000, the day before the Japan Cup. The Dirt Cup, worth ¥275 million, will be open to three-year-olds and up at 1 3/8 miles.

Hong Kong Set for Second Jockey Challenge:

The Hong Kong Jockey Club will stage its second International Jockeys' Championship Dec. 8 in conjunction with its International Races Day, Dec. 12. Last year's champion Olivier Peslier has indicated that he will defend his title. Other probables include Frankie Dettori, Gary Stevens, Gerard Mossé and Michael Kinane. The format of the Championship will be three races, with mounts allocated by draw. The winning rider will receive bonus prize money of HK\$200,000 (\$25,732).
