COMIC STRIP WINS RIVER CITY

After winning the Aug. 28 Gill Fourstardave H. at Saratoga, **Comic Strip** (Red Ransom) was the runner-up in both the Sept. 25 Gill Belmont Breeders' Cup H. and the Oct. 30 Gill Knickerbocker H., but the colt made it to the altar yesterday with a win in the Gill River City H. at Churchill Downs. The dark bay settled towards the rear early, came out to make a five-wide bid leaving the three-eighths pole and edged clear inside the final furlong under a hand ride. "Midway up the backside, it looked like they (the leaders) had gotten totally out of his scope," winning rider Pat Day commented. "He's a funny kind of horse, you just have to wait for him to give you the nod. When he drops down and starts picking up these horses you can go to town on him. If you encourage him before that, he resents it. He just wants to do it his way."

"All I had to do was wait for the right time to make my move. I followed the second horse around the turn--she's a nice filly, too--and when we came into the stretch I had more horse. My filly exploded. She did everything a trainer and a jockey could ask of her."
