WHISTLING DIXIE IN THE HIGHWEIGHT?

Aqueduct's Thanksgiving Day feature brings together some talented sophomores against a group of tough older sprinters. Bought in Dixie (Dixieland Band) has shown several gears for trainer Allen Jerkens. Most recently, the Florida bred bay stalked the pace en route to a 3 3/4-length score in the Chief Pennekeck S. at the Big M last out and returns to the surface where he broke his maiden last March. Another late-bloomer from the connections of Artax is Aristotle (Two Punch), who just missed in the GIII Sport Page going seven panels at Aqueduct Nov. 6, where he defeated Bought in Dixie. Kashatreya (Daring Groom), off since a third in the Gen. MacArthur H. at Belmont Sept10, defeated Artax in the GII True North this past June.

DA DEVIL IN DA CLARK?

Da Devil (Leo Castelli) defeated Cat Thief in the GII Kentucky Cup Classic at Turfway before finishing fifth in the GIII Hawthorne Gold Cup, but rebounded with a sharp score in the "Clark prep," a money allowance at Churchill Nov. 11. The four-year-old watched from the sidelines as Cat Thief powered home in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Gulfstream. Nite Dreamer (El Prado {Ire}) bypassed the Breeders' Cup in favor of the Sunday Silence S. on the undercard at Gulfstream, which he won by two lengths. The gray was second to Victory Gallop in the GII Stephen Foster H. over this surface in June. Tactical Cat (Storm Cat) captured the GI Hollywood Futurity last December before heading to the sidelines with a condylar fracture. The Lukas trainee returned an impressive allowance victory Oct. 20 at Keeneland, and was a good third to Littlebitlively (Lively One) in the GIII Ack Ack H. at Churchill on Halloween last out.

The Phipps entry looms as a tough obstacle for their rivals. Country Hideaway ran down Harpia in the GII First Flight H. going seven-eighths over this surface Nov. 6. With only a loss to Silverbulletday marring an otherwise perfect record, the bay sophomore is the one to beat. Stablemate Furlough returns to the fillies after a 10th in the Nov. 7 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. Prior to that, she captured the GI Ballerina H. at Saratoga before going down by a nose to Catinca in the Sept. 18 Ruffian H. at Belmont. Harpia makes her final start before heading to Juddmonte to begin her breeding career, and the full sister to Danehill should improve off her narrow loss in the First Flight. Highweight Catinca was not entered after coming down with a cough and will be rested for a 2000 campaign. The Top Flight would have marked her first start in the colors of Elizabeth Moran's Brushwood Stables, which purchased the Storm Cat filly for \$2.8 million from the Robert K. Waxman dispersal Nov. 7.

Matter of Honour Wins Debut:

Matter of Honour (NZ) (Casual Lies) demonstrated the same front-running ability as his famous half brother Might and Power (NZ) (Zabeel {NZ}) when he won his debut under the lights last night at Canterbury. The three-year-old quickly established a two-length lead from his wide barrier and was never challenged in the Truscott's Toyota H. over 1250m. He is trained by Paul Perry. Meanwhile, seven-time Group 1 winner Might and Power continues to progress well from a tendon injury. "He's coming along well and his leg seems to be completely healed," said owner Nick Moraitis of the gelding, who is currently working towards a comeback at Jack Denham's stable.

The 20-year-old mare Au Printemps is wielding a powerful influence this year. Her two-year-old Meadowlake colt Greenwood Lake showed himself to be one of the best juveniles in the country with a win in the GI Champagne S.; Au Printemps' son Success Express, a three-quarters brother to Greenwood Lake, enjoyed an outstanding season at stud in Australia; and Charlie Barley, a half brother to Greenwood Lake and Success Express, has done well with limited opportunities in Canada, siring five stakes winners from 61 starters.

The latest stakes winner for Charlie Barley is Barlee Mist, who was capturing her first graded victory when taking the GIII Bessarabian H. at Woodbine on Sunday.

The key to Barlee Mist's pedigree seems to be some complex inbreeding revolving around Nearctic, who is 6x6x4 in this pedigree. Nearctic most commonly appears in pedigrees through his sons Northern Dancer and Icecapade, but here, in addition to one strain of Northern Dancer, he is found through two daughters. This pair, Nangela (third dam of Key to the Moon, broodmare sire of Barlee Mist) and Muskoka (third dam of Barlee Mist herself), have extremely interesting pedigrees.

Nangela is an example of very close inbreeding as she has Nearctic's close relative Sybil's Niece as her own third dam (she's actually 2x5 to Nearco, 3x5 to Hyperion and 3x5 to Sister Sarah). This inbreeding certainly proved profitable, as Nangela not only became a two-year-old stakes winner, but also a dynasty founding tap-root mare.

Barlee Mist's other strain of Nearctic, Muskoka, also has close inbreeding. Her granddam Eyewash is by a son of Fairway (brother to Pharos, grandsire of Nearctic) out of All Moonshine (three-quarters sister to Hyperion, broodmare sire of Nearctic). Muskoka was only a minor winner on the racetrack, but at stud produced the stakes winners Muskoka Weekend and Miss Hyperion. Barlee Mist's granddam Miss Hyperion was by Henry Tudor, a horse bred on a reverse Hyperion/Nearco cross to Nearctic. When Miss Hyperion was mated to Key to the Moon--a horse carrying Nearctic's intensely inbred daughter Nangela--the result was Barlee Mist's dam Moon Mist, a filly good enough not only to win stakes in Canada, but also to cross the border to capture the GII Barbara Fritchie H.

PEDIGREE SHORTS

Ohio sire Al Sabin had two stakes winners in two days and the second of this pair, Lady Cherie (f, 2, Al Sabin--Cherie's Companion, by Highland Blade) has an intriguing pedigree. Al Sabin is a son of Alydar, and Cherie's Companion's granddam Cup Companion is by Raise A Cup, a five-eighths relative to Alydar (they are both by Raise a Native, and Raise A Cup's third dam is also the granddam of Alydar). To add to the complexity of the pattern, Cup Companion is out of a mare by Tim Tam, a half brother to Alydar's broodmare sire On-and-On.

The young Danzig stallion Zieten has been making a very good start to his career. He was represented by another stakes winner on Monday when the Zeiting (f, 2, Zieten--Belle de Cadix, by Law Society) captured the Prix Zeddaan at Maisons-Laffitte. Zieten is out of a mare by Habitat, and since Zeiting's third dam is by Habitat's half brother Northfields, Zeiting has the noted broodmare Little Hut 4x5.

STALLION ACCESS ONLINE Stallion Access, a division of Fasig Tipton, has announced the development of the first Internet auction site for Thoroughbred seasons and shares. The site is now online at www.stallionaccess.com for the registration of members and describes the process of consigning and buying through this Internet site. Bidding will open in approximately two weeks and will provide members with a 72hour sales window to compete primarily for no-guarantee seasons. In announcing this service, Stallion Access president Ashton Moynihan explained that the online auction would supplement, not replace, Stallion Access' two major public autions of season and shares at Saratoga in August and Kentucky in November. "Although the industry has seen several sites listing seasons and shares, this will be the first online service to combine the convenience of access to the Internet with the dynamics of a live auction." Interested parties may register through the forms offered online or request them directly from stallionaccess.com.

SCATMANDU SOLD TO WALMAC Scatmandu (Storm Cat--Princess Alydar, by Alydar), winner of the GIII Sport Page H. at Aqueduct Nov. 6, has been purchased by Walmac International (John T. L. Jones, Jr.) and will make his next start for his new owner in the GI Cigar Mile H. at Aqueduct Nov. 27. A half brother to multiple GI winner November Snow, Scatmandu was a \$1.1 million juvenile at the 1997 Barretts March Sale. "Scatmandu provides Walmac with access to the prolific Storm Cat sire line," said Jones. "As a racehorse, he has already proven that he can sprint and compete at the graded stakes level at a mile and one-eighth. We're delighted not only to have him in our racing stable, but excited about his future as a stallion at Walmac." Jones indicated that immediate plans were to see how the chestnut does in his next start before a decision will be made on plans for 2000.

Albarado Back In the Saddle:

Jockey Robby Albarado, who suffered a fractured skull in spill during a Nov. 12 race at Churchill Downs, is set to return to the saddle on the final two days of the track's Fall Meet. Albarado will ride Forty One Carats (Tactical Advantage) in the GII Clark H. on Friday and will ride two Bob Baffert trainees, Captain Steve (Fly So Free) and Crown of Crimson (Seattle Slew), in their respective races in Saturday's GII Brown & Williamson Kentucky Jockey Club S. and the GIII Golden Rod S. "I feel great," said Albarado. "I've been looking out for any side effects from my accident, but I can't seem to find any. It seems like I'm ready to go." Albarado, who suffered a more serious skull fracture in the spring of 1998 in another Churchill Downs spill, suffered a nondisplaced fracture at the base of his skull in his most recent mishap.
