ARTAX RETIRED

Artax (Marquetry--Raging Apalachee, by Apalachee), who set two track records and equaled another (that one set by Mr. Prospector) when he capped his career with a victory in the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint at Gulfstream, has been retired after injuring a suspensory in his left front leg. The four-year-old worked a half mile in :45 4/5 Tuesday; the injury was discovered Wednesday afternoon. "We noticed he was off," trainer Louis Albertrani said. "We checked him out, and that's when we discovered a small lesion in the upper part of the suspensory. It is a shame that he is retired, but he did his job for us and really had a great year." The likely Eclipse Award winner as top sprinter and a candidate for Horse of the Year honors. Artax retires with seven wins, nine seconds and three thirds from 25 starts and earnings of \$1,685,840. In addition to his Breeders' Cup score (where he tied the track record of 1:07 4/5), he took the GI Vosburgh S., GI Carter H. (getting the seven furlongs in an Aqueduct track record 1:20) and GII Forest Hills H. (six furlongs in a Belmont Park record 1:07 3/5) this season. He captured the GII San Felipe S. and GIII Santa Catalina S. at three, and was runner-up in the GI Hollywood Futurity at two. Stud plans have not vet been finalized, but owner Ernie Paragallo said the colt would stand in New York.

ALBORADA OUT OF JAPAN CUP

The European contingent to the Japan Cup lost one of its challengers when Alborada (GB) (Alzao--Alouette {GB}, by Darshaan {GB}) bruised her left hind foot and had to be scratched. The four-year-old filly did not respond to treatment and trainer Sir Mark Prescott declared her from the race, also announcing her retirement. The winner of the G1 Dubai Champion S. both this year and last as well as the G3 C.L. Weld Park S. in '97 and the G2 Independent Pretty Polly S. and G2 Vodafone Nassau S. in '98, the gray goes to the breeding shed after winning six of 10 starts, with a second and two thirds, and earning \$989,615. She will be bred to Danzig.

MONTJEU MOUNTS JAPAN INVASION

Montieu (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), winner of the G1 Prix du Jockey Club, G1 Irish Derby and G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, looks to add the G1 Japan Cup to his resume at Tokyo Racecourse Sunday. The three-year-old is the even-money favorite facing 14 rivals in the 1 1/2-mile test. He drew post 14 for the race. "The Arc winner has not had success in the Japan Cup in the past, but I am convinced that Montjeu will be exceptional," owner Michael Tabor said. "His trainer, John Hammond, has been looking forward to the race." Tabor added that the three-year-old will remain in training next season. The home team is considered to be light this year, after Seiun Sky (Jpn), winner of the Japanese 2000 Guineas and Japanese St. Leger, was banned for a month for acting up in the starting gate before the Oct. 31 Tenno Sho; and three-time Group 1 winner Grass Wonder (Jpn) was injured. But 1998 Japan Derby hero Special Week (Jpn) (Sunday Silence), third in the Japan Cup last year and breaking from post 13 this time, is the second choice in the race at 2-1. A Japanese filly has finished second in this event for the last four years, giving the connections of 16-1 Umeno Fiber (Jpn) (Sakura Yutaka O (Jpn)) hopes for a good showing. The three-year-old took the 1999 Japanese Oaks, then came back after a four-month layoff to be fourth against sophomore fillies in the Oct. 24 Shuka Sho.

The 5-2 favorite, Crafty Friend, won back-to-back Grade II events this summer, the July 4 Tom Fool H. at Belmont and Saratoga's Sept. 6 Forego H. two months later. Brought back in just 19 days for his next, the GI Vosburgh Sept. 25 at Belmont, he finished fifth as the 4-5 choice. "He was flat in the Vosburgh," said trainer John Kimmel. "He had come off a two-month layoff to win the Forego and he ran huge that day. I just couldn't cycle him back in 19 days for the Vosburgh. But right now, he's been training super. I think he's better than ever." In his way: 6-1 stablemate Scatmandu, winner of the Nov. 6 GIII Sport Page over this surface in his last; and 3-1 second choice Affirmed Success, second to Crafty Friend in both the Tom Fool and Forego and still looking for his first win on the year.

The upset winner of the GI Champagne S. at Belmont in his last start Oct. 9, **Greenwood Lake** was made the 7-5 choice to earn the win here and start trainer Nick Zito dreaming about Derby 2000. The \$205,000 Fasig-Tipton Calder two-year-old missed by a neck in the GI Futurity in his prior start and tries two turns for the first time today. **Scottish Halo** is the only other graded winner in the field. His victory in the GIII Laurel Futurity Nov. 5 ran his record to three-for-four; he starts 5-2 second choice.

Buzz Lightyear makes it two Group 1 wins from his last two starts. He'd been too good a fortnight ago at Riccarton running away from the front to win by 1 3/4 lengths in the New Zealand 2000 Guineas and he did basically the same here. Ridden by star apprentice Opie Bosson, the colt had to work hard to get to his favoured front running position as there were a number keen to get to the lead. But at the top of the straight, Bosson let the free runner go and the pair quickly put a break of four lengths on the field and had it all to themselves to the line. "A lot of people have underrated his ability to last 1600 meters," said Bosson, "but he gives that impression because he gets lost in front on his own at the late stages of his races." Domero came with a super finishing burst to claim second, having been amongst the tail-enders half way down the straight. Buzz Lightyear is owned by former New Zealand test cricket Terry Jarvis and his sons Mark and Chris. Jarvis was also successful in the race last year as the owner of Tobruk (NZ).

DARSHAAN FILLY TOPS GOFFS NOVEMBER

The foal section of the graduated Goffs November sale in Co. Kildare, Ireland, with the better credentialed lots catalogued to sell towards the end, came to its conclusion Friday. The market, which had been warm for nice individuals all week, got fairly hot Friday late afternoon and early evening. Timmy Hyde picked up the sales topper, going to £130,000 to secure Broguestown Stud's daughter of Darshaan (GB) out of Whispered Melody (GB) (Primo Dominie {GB}). The filly showed a relatively quick profit for her vendor, having been bought in utero as her dam traded for 54,000 guineas at the '98 Tattersalls December sale. She is intended for resale as a partnership property, as is the top-selling colt, Garraun's Stud's first-crop son of Entrepreneur (GB) (Sadler's Wells) out of MSP Phylella (Ire) (Persian Bold {Ire}), who sold for £90,000. Another colt by Entrepreneur, Barronstown Stud's offering out of the good racemare Reine Mathilde (*Vaguely Noble), realized the sale's third-best price of £75,000, which should encourage the vendors of the 18 babies by the 2000 Guineas winner scheduled to sell in Newmarket next week. Thursday's clear top price was £60,000, with John Troy going that far for a first-crop son of Royal Applause (GB) (Waajib {Ire}). The Goffs November foal sale showed a five-percent drop in average from 1998, which was attributed to the 11-percent larger catalogue, (comprised of many less-marketable first-day offerings), and the real strength of the trade was shown in the much more acceptable clearance rate achieved over the last two days, and the four-percent median increase. Of the 219 weanlings offered Thursday, 25 were not sold. On Friday, 13 of the 190 lots did not sell. Broodmares go on sale today, with bidding beginning at 10 a.m. (All Goffs prices are in Irish pounds).
