TAKE TAKES JAPAN CUP

Winning one for the home team, jockey Yutaka Take earned his first victory in the Japan Cup, guiding Special Week (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) to a 1 1/2-length victory over Hong Kong's first-ever representative Indigenous (Ire) (Mariu (Ire)) at Tokyo Racecourse yesterday afternoon. It was another nose back to High-Rise (Ire) (High Estate {Ire}), who was three-quarters of a length ahead of the 17-10 favorite, G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe hero Montjeu (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). But Special Week, one of eight Japanese entrants in the race, was well backed by the crowd of 155,972, going off the 2-1 second choice after winning both legs of Japan's Tenno Sho (Emperor's Cup) this year, including the Oct. 31 G1-Jpn Autumn Tenno Sho in his last start. He had been third as the favorite in the Japan Cup after winning the Japanese Derby last season. Rated near the back of the 14horse field early as 43-1 Embrasser Moi (Jpn) (Russian Bond) set the pace, the four-year-old rallied wide into the stretch to take the lead and was going away at the wire. "Another one of my dreams finally came true," said the 30-year-old Take, who missed the ride on Special Week last year due to a suspension. "It felt exceptional. He settled well in mid-division, so I knew he would have enough left in the end." But Montjeu, who captured the French and Irish Derbies before taking the Arc, let his backers down, becoming the 14th consecutive losing favorite in the race. Settled in 12th through moderate fractions, he came through along the inside on the turn and swung to the outside for the stretch run, but lacked a killer closing kick and had to settle for fourth. Trainer John Hammond thought the journey from France may have affected his colt's chances. "The trip over to Tokyo was not entirely trouble-free and I was not able to give him as much work as he perhaps needed prior to the race," Hammond said. "He lacked a bit of match fitness." Symboli Rudolf (Jpn), the winner in 1985, is the only favorite to succeed in 19 editions of the Japan Cup. Handle for Sunday's card at Tokyo was ¥42,876,777,200, down nine percent from last year, with ¥29,646,375,200 (an 11-percent drop) wagered on the Japan Cup alone. The winner will make his final career start in the Dec. 26 G1-Jpn Arima Kinen at Nakayama, then heads to Shadai Farm to begin his stud career in 2000. (Japan Cup chart, p2)

A BIRD? A PLANE? IT'S SUPER OUERCUS!

Super Quercus (Fr) (Hero's Honor) showed he could close at this distance against these horses when he came from 14 lengths back early to run third to Mula Gula (Lil. E. Tee) and Eagleton (Majestic Light) in the GII Oak Tree Derby at Santa Anita Oct. 23 after nearly a year layoff. In that race, Fighting Falcon (Manila) was the pacesetter before fading to fifth and he set off to try again, setting moderate fractions. Super Quercus, who raced in France for Jean-Claude Rouget, was still 10th with three-eighths of a mile to run, but when jockey Alex Solis swung him four wide into the stretch, he started to pick up horses easily. Manndar (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}), fourth in the Oak Tree Derby, had caught the pacesetter in midstretch, but had no answer when Super Quercus challenged while favorite Mula Gula was wide most of the way and weakened in the stretch. "He figured to be a little sharper the second time out," said winning trainer Bobby Frankel. "He jumped right into it today. [Jockey] Alex [Solis] says he could win the Breeders' Cup Mile next yer. I'm not going to run him back right away. I'll probably wait until the middle of the summer."

The fans were expecting a battle between Tuzla, a neck loser in the Breeders' Cup Mile in her last, and Happyanunoit, four-length winner of the Vinery First Lady H. at Keeneland in her most recent start. The crowd got what it wanted. Longshot Candy Lonly (Baynoun {Ire}) went out quickly, but she was overhauled by Tuzla turning for home and the five-year-old looked a winner as she opened 1 1/2 lengths on the rallying Happyanunoit, who had come wide off the turn. Tuzla just failed to hold off the winner, though, who is now just shy of becoming a millionaire. Winning trainer Bobby Frankel, who also trained third-place finisher Spanish Fern and took the GI Hollywood Derby two races earlier, said, "At the sixteenth pole I didn't think we were going to get there. She showed a lot of guts to win this one." Jockey Brice Blanc shared his boss's fears. "I didn't know if I could catch her [Tuzla]," he said. "With the heart she showed me today, we're going to hear a lot more from her."

Campaigned on the turf for the first seven starts of her career and a graded-stakes winner on the surface, Belle Cherie was switched to the dirt for the Sept. 6 GIII Honey Bee H. at the Meadowlands and found a new home, winning by a head. A rallying fourth in the Oct. 2 GII Cotillion H. at Philly Park in her next outing, she came back to take the GIII Turnback the Alarm H. at Aqueduct Oct. 30. Looking to make it three-for-four on the main track, the chestnut rated off the solid fractions et by 14-1 Anklet (Wild Again), crept up along the rail on the turn, angled to the outside for the stretch drive to take command and left her rivals in the dust in an impressive display. "I thought she was going to run a good race over the summer on the turf, but the turf got too hard." trainer Phil Johnson said. "We entered her in the first dirt race we could find. She's really maturing. [Jockey John Velazquez] said he could anything with her now." As for the future, Johnson said, "The Ladies H. [GIII, Dec. 18 at Aqueduct] is a consideration. We'll keep her at Belmont for the winter and look at races like the [GI Hempstead H.] in the spring. I wouldn't pass up a Grade I on the turf, though." Furlough, coupled with Country Hideaway (Seeking the Gold) as the 4-5 favorite, was off slowly, and trailed the field early. She rallied on the turn and kept coming down the lane to get on even terms with Harpia at the wire. The two runner-ups will both be retired.

GOFFS NOVEMBER MARE SALE CONCLUDES

The strong trade for the better-credentialed stock continued as Goffs November sale ended its filly and mare section vesterday. Three lots made six figures and the highest of the three was one of two consecutive offerings which sold less than half an hour into the proceedings, but brought the day's two best prices. Both were sold by Sheikh Hamdan al Maktoum's Derrinstown Stud. The first, Lot 943, Sabayik (Ire) (Unfuwain), is an eightyear-old mare from the family of GISW Slew the Dragon. Already the dam of a listed stakes winner and carrying a full-brother or sister by Royal Applause (GB) to the weanling colt which, at Ir£60,000, topped Day Two of the foal sale, she was purchased for Ir£120,000 by agent Brian Grassick on behalf of Joe Higgins of Gerardstown Stud. Barronstown Stud is always active for well-bred mares at this vendue and, having acquired Saturday's second top lot at Ir£200,000, picked up the other two six-figure Sunday lots. At Ir£110,000, they secured Lot 944, Kadwah (Mr. Prospector), out of GI Yellow Ribbon S. winner Castilla (Bold Reason), and for Ir£100,000, they bought another mare from the same vendor, Derrinstown, Mahrah (Vaguely Noble {GB}). Sold as Lot 1014, she is the dam of stakes-winning GI Sword Dancer H. runner-up Fahim (GB) and in foal to the vendor stud's extremely popular young horse Alhaarth (Ire). The action wasn't all confined to Irish studs. Buyers from a number of other countries, including France, Japan, Italy, New Zealand and, in particular, Turkey, were active during the week. Over the two sessions of the mare section, the average rose 18 percent from 1998, and the median was up a fraction as well. (Statistics p4)

The sale begins at 9:30 a.m. with 266 lots catalogued, and the December Sales, Europe's largest bloodstock auction, resumes Wednesday with foals running through to Saturday, with the "Mares etc." book offered from Monday to Friday of next week.

TOP FLIGHT PRODUCES TOP BROODMARES

Both Harpia (Danzig--Razyana, by His Majesty) and Furlough (Easy Goer--Blitey, by Riva Ridge), who deadheated for second in yesterday's GII Delta Air Lines Top Flight H. at Aqueduct, have been retired. The five-year-old Harpia, winner of the GII Shirley Jones H. in February, retires with five wins, four seconds and a third from 13 starts and earnings of \$294,388. "She has been a solid mare," trainer John Kimmel said. "She'll now be headed to the breeding shed. She leaves for [owner-breeder] Juddmonte Farms in Kentucky later this week." Furlough, also five, retires with eight wins, nine seconds and two thirds from her 33 starts, amassing a bankroll of \$671,844. Winner of the GIII Honorable Miss S. at four, she added the GI Ballerina H. and GII Distaff Breeders' Cup H. this year.


