COUNTDOWN CONTINUES IN TURF CUP

Assuming he doesn't break Bill Shoemaker's record beforehand, jockey Laffit Pincay Jr. will continue his trek toward magic win number 8,834 in today's GI Hollywood Turf Cup. Pincay picked up the mount on last year's Turf Cup champ Lazy Lode (Arg) (Lode) just last week. "(Regular rider) Gary Stevens is unavailable, Laffit's available and he's riding extremely well," Richard Mulhall, racing manager for Lazy Lode's owner, The Thoroughbred Corp., said explaining the switch. "And Laffit has ridden a lot of winners over the years for (Lazy Lode's trainer) Richard Mandella. Five-year-old Lazy Lode has notched only one win since his Turf Cup score, taking the restricted Jim Murray Memorial H. at Hollywood in June. But the chestnut has shown an affinity for the Hollywood turf, winning three of his five tries over the course with a second and a third. Second after setting the pace in the GI Oak Tree Turf Championship going a mile and a quarter at Santa Anita Oct. 3, he comes off an eighth-place showing in the Nov. 5 Fraise S. at Gulfstream. The favorite, despite a streak of three off-the-board finishes, will be Yagli (Jade Hunter). The Turf Cup runner-up last season, the six-year-old reeled off wins in the GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H., GI Manhattan H. and GI United Nations H., but failed as the favorite in his next two. Seventh as the 3-5 chalk in the GI Sword Dancer H. at Saratoga, he encountered traffic in a fourth-place finish at 8-5 in the GI Turf Classic Invitational and was steadied on the far turn in his latest, a fourth-place effort in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. "Obviously, we wouldn't have come out here if he wasn't doing well," said Kevin McCarthy, assistant to trainer Bill Mott. "He's only raced six times this year-he's still a fresh horse."

MEDIAN RISES AT TATTERSALLS

The market was much stronger on the third day of the 1999 Tattersalls December Foal Sale, with the best foals seen so far in Europe. Coolmore stallion Entrepreneur (GB) was responsible for the joint-highest price of 220,000 guineas when Lot 1051, a colt out of Blinding (Ire) (High Top {Ire}), consigned by West Blagdon Stud, was purchased by Woodcote Stud's Barry Reilly as a pinhooking prospect. "He was the star of the show, I don't think there is a nicer foal on offer this week," said Reilly. "He will come back home to Woodcote to be re-offered next year. I cannot say any more about his new ownership." The price was matched soon after when Dick Fowlston's Britton House Stud offered a full sister to the 1999 G1 Coronation S. winner Balisada (GB) (Kris {GB}). Agent James Delahooke purchased the chestnut filly, who sold as Lot 1085. "She is for a new English client who will race her and then breed from her," said Delahooke. Three years ago, Fowlston bought the filly's dam Balnaha (GB) (Lomond) for 42,000 guineas, carrying to Deploy (GB). Balnaha, in foal to Hector Protector, is due to go under the hammer at the December Sales next week. Raffin Stud's Sadler's Wells colt (Lot 1077) out of Moss (Woodman) was captured by the British Bloodstock Agency's Johnny Lewis for 170,000 guineas after Timmy Hyde gave way. Hyde took another Sadler's Wells colt, out of Charming Tiara (Alydar), a half sister to Seattle Slew, for 135,000 quineas. A gray filly from Old Mill Stud by Breeders' Cup Mile winner Spinning World went to Londoner Maril Christofi for 160,000 guineas as a pinhooking prospect. The median price of 16,500 guineas compared to 14,000 guineas this day a year ago, showing the strength in depth of yesterday's market. The fourth and last day of foals starts at 9:30 a.m. today.


