TATTERSALLS FOAL WRAP-UP

The 1999 Tattersalls December Foal Sale in Newmarket, which ended Saturday after a four-day run, could not quite match up to its '98 counterpart, but did show a six-percent increase in the median. Tattersalls Chairman Edmond Mahony said, "With more than 1,000 foals, this was the largest foal catalogue ever produced in Europe and there is no doubt that the market is finding it hard to absorb the numbers, particularly at the lower end. Trade in the middle and upper-middle market has been competitive throughout the week, with a larger-than-ever contingent of Turkish buyers making their presence felt at all levels as well as new faces from Greece making an important contribution. Compared with last year, we were a little short of foals at the very top end, but British and Irish pinhookers were as active as ever and French, German and Italian buyers all made a significant impact." The top lot Saturday, a colt by Sadler's Wells out of Sequel (Ire) (Law Society), was offered by Robert Sangster's Swettenham Stud. The bay, a full brother to listed winner Family Tradition (Ire), was eventually knocked down for 355,000 guineas to Jean-Louis Branere of France Pur Sang, with another agent, John Ferguson, the persistent underbidder. Branere said, "I have been underbidder seven times today, so that is a relief. He is for an existing client and he may be resold next year." However, it would be little surprise if the the colt, who is related to Rainbow Quest, Warning (GB), Commander In Chief (GB) and Dushyantor through his second dam Where You Lead (Raise A Native), ended up with Coolmore interests. Ferguson picked up Saturday's top filly just two lots later when going to 205,000 guineas for another Sadler's Wells, this one out of Northern Script (Arts and Letters), for Sheikh Mohammed's Godolphin. The filly is a full sister to Scribe (Ire), a Group 3 winner, and listed stakes-winner Northern Hal (GB). The December Sales resume at 9:30 a.m. Monday, with broodmares and fillies and colts in training on offer through to Friday.

FOUR TO GO: PINCAY TAKES TURF CUP

Jockey Laffit Pincay Jr., inching ever closer to Bill Shoemaker's all-time record of 8,833 wins, added another in high style yesterday, driving **Lazy Lode (Arg)** (Lode) to a front-running 1 1/4-length score in the GI Hollywood Turf Cup. "He has won races for me for 25 years now and there's nobody I admire in the world more than him," trainer Richard Mandella said of the 52-year-old rider. "Laffit, even when I was starting out, it didn't matter if he was riding for Charlie Whittingham at the time or just Dick Mandella. He rode his heart out and that's the way he has always been. I guess that's how you get to where he is." Pincay didn't have to pull out all the stops to guide Lazy Lode to his second straight Turf Cup score. The five-year-old, coming off an eighth-place finish in the Nov. 5 Fraise S. over a good course at Gulfstream, went right to the front as is his custom, set moderate fractions and carried his speed all the way to the wire, holding off **Public Purse** (Private Account) under a patented Pincay hand ride. "This horse rated nicely," the Panamanian, who only picked up the mount on Lazy Lode last week, said. "I rode him just like they told me, which was to keep him off the rail, try to rate him and try to keep him relaxed. He relaxed most of the way and coming down the stretch I had plenty left. He just kept going." As does Pincay, who now needs just three wins to tie and four to break Shoemaker's mark. As for Lazy Lode, Mandella said, "He was glad to be back home. Florida kind of got to him, with all the hype and action down there. He was training great up to this race." The even-money favorite **Yagli** (Jade Hunter) trailed the tightly bunched field for six furlongs, came with his bid on the far turn, but weakened in the stretch and finished fifth. "He was flat," jockey Jerry Bailey said. "It's unlike him not to fire a little bit. But he struggled to hold third or fourth through the stretch--which he didn't." Added trainer Bill Mott, "The pace was slow and that didn't help us, but by the same token I thought he'd have a little more run than he did. He was flat all the way through the stretch." First or second in five of her seven previous starts this year, Crystal Symphony was off the board the one time she ventured outside of Florida, finishing eighth in a Saratoga allowance test, but came back to win the Oct. 23 1 1/8-mile Calder Oaks after a two-month freshening. The bay followed that effort with a rallying second-place finish in the 7 1/2-furlong Francis A. Genter H. Nov. 14. Let go at 9-1 stretching out once again, she was throttled back with the trailing pack early, swung to the middle of the track for the stretch drive and finished full of run to get up in the final yards for a narrow victory. "(Jockey Cornelio Velasquez) rode a masterful race," trainer Joseph Calascibetta said. "He deserves a lot of credit. This was a big test for (Crystal Symphony) and now I think she has a big future. We'll talk about it, but the La Prevoyante (GII, 1 1/2 miles at Calder Dec. 26) will be seriously considered. I think she'll go three turns." The 4-5 favorite Khumba Mela, winner of the Oct. 2 GIII Noble Damsel H. at Belmont before finishing 11th in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, saved ground while rating in the middle of the pack, came out for running room in the stretch and just missed catching the speedy Winfama, getting third in what was a four-way photo for second.

Brocco Filly Tops Aussie Sale:

A three-year-old filly by Brocco topped the Inglis Christmas Sale in Sydney, Australia Friday, with a syndicate of Victorian investors giving A\$125,000 for her. Named Comix (Aus), she is the first foal of dual Group 1 winner and Australian champion Spanish Mix (Aus) (Esperanto). The mixed sale catalogued a total of 133 Thoroughbreds, with 109 selling for an average of A\$5,648. The sale's gross of A\$615,700 was almost double last year's result.

FASIG-TIPTON MIDLANTIC DECEMBER SALE

STARTS TODAY The two-day Fasig-Tipton Midlantic December Mixed Sale, with a catalogue which includes the complete dispersal of Mea Culpa Stables and a total of 626 lots, begins this morning at the Timonium Sales Pavilion in Maryland. Recent graduates of the sale include **Forest Wildcat** (Storm Cat), a \$57,000 horse of racing age as a four-year-old in 1995 who went on to win a pair of graded stakes and whose first crop of yearlings averaged \$120,000 this year; 1999 graded-stakes winner **Pratella** (Jade Hunter), who sold for \$17,000 as a yearling in 1996 and has now earned \$334,578; and **Hookedonthefeelin** (Citidancer), the winner of the 1998 GII Landaluce S. and \$178,020 who picked up her fourth win from five career starts in a Hollywood Park allowance Friday. The three-year-old sold for \$38,000 as a weanling in 1996. Broodmares and broodmare prospects, followed by the 42-horse Mea Culpa consignment, sell today. The dispersal features the 10-year-old broodmare **Mz. Zill Bear** (Salutely), a multiple graded-stakes winner in foal to Dehere; her yearling colt by Broad Brush and weanling colt by Carson City; a weanling half sister to Mz. Zill Bear by Editor's Note; and nine-year-old **Dollar Poker** (Silver Buck), a full sister to champion Silver Charm in foal to Skip Away. Yearlings and weanlings, representing sires such as Cherokee Run, Cryptoclearance, End Sweep and Marquetry, as well as horses of racing age sell Monday. Bidding begins at 10:30 a.m. each day.

A LADY FROM DIXIE RETIRED A Lady From Dixie (Dixieland Band--Wicked Witchcraft, by Good Behaving), who was scratched from the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff after suffering a tendon injury, has been retired and will head to the breeding shed next year. The four-year-old filly, winner of the GII Chula Vista H. in August, finished third behind Keeper Hill and Banshee Breeze in her final start, the GI Three Chimneys Spinster S. at Keeneland Oct. 16. Owned and bred by Marylyn and David Randal, she retires with five wins and a third from 11 starts and earnings of \$383,718. She will be bred to Unbridled.
