SURFSIDE OUTCLASSES STARLET FIELD

Trainer D. Wayne Lukas thought she should have won the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies. Surfside (Seattle Slew), who is about as well-bred as a horse can be, had a troubled trip in the Breeders' Cup, but was only beaten 1 3/4 lengths as she finished third behind stablemate Cash Run. "She got disoriented on the first turn [in the Breeders' Cup] and lost a lot of ground," said Lukas. She tried to make it up on her class, but it wasn't in the cards." Jockey Pat Day put the daughter of champion Flanders on the front end here, dueling through moderate fractions with She's Classy (Boundary). But come the stretch, Surfside kicked clear and showed her class, drawing away to a seven-length win. "She was very enthusiastic early and she took me right into the race," said Day. "She surprised me a little bit, bouncing out of there, surprised Pat too," said Lukas. "I let her freshen a bit since the Breeders' Cup and I think it put a little bit of spring in her step and she came out of there bouncing. I really think she's the best filly in the country. I don't think that will be recognized this year, but she'll have a chance next year." Surfside gave Lukas his record seventh win in the Hollywood Starlet, including five of the last six.

"I wanted to be forward in the race and ended up with a nice run from the alley." Cameron said St. Clemens Belle had needed the race and been unsuited by the slow pace in the Lee Steere S. two weeks ago, when she was beaten by Slavonic. The top three finishers will meet again in the Group 1 Railway S. later this month.



Irish Year In Review

by Larry Stratton

They can't, by definition, all be vintage years, and 1999 certainly wasn't one in Ireland on any front, with the glorious exception of Aidan O'Brien's outstanding record with his juveniles. They dominated their division domestically from the opening day of the flat season, and by season's end they (or, more correctly, the Ballydoyle colts) had virtually dominated all of Europe. O'Brien runners won more than one-third (54 out of 148) of all two-year-old races run in Ireland in 1999, and full two-thirds (12 out of 18) of all juvenile black-type events, including five of the six Group 3s. But the stable's domination is best illustrated by the mortgage it holds on the top of the Irish juvenile classification, the top 12 colts raced in Ireland in 1999 are all trained in Ballydoyle.

Foremost among them was the unbeaten Fasiliyev (USA) (Nureyev {USA}), whose retirement to stud in 2000 after fracturing a pastern in a paddock accident in October is a big blow, even given the strength in depth of the rest of the trainer's team. Fasliyev had been progressive throughout the season and gave every indication that there was plenty more improvement still to come, which have put a race like the 2000 Guineas very much within his grasp. As it is, he retires five-for-five, his season comprised of a classic progression of maiden, Listed, Group 3 (Royal Ascot's Coventry S.) and two Group 1s, the first a weakly contested Heinz 57 Phoenix S. in Ireland which he nearly threw away by veering alarmingly in the final furlong, the second an emphatic score over better opponents in the Prix Morny. A hugely impressive individual, the son of Nureyev is from a 'hot' (in terms of commerciality, not temperament) line, being the first foal of a half-sister to 1999 Travers winner and Kentucky Derby runner-up Menifee (USA).

The Ballydoyle colts with Classic or Group 1 aspirations for 2000 are too numerous to cover in detail, but impressive performances were registered by the following during the year:

Rossini (USA)--A Miswaki (USA) colt closely related to Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner Anees (USA)(Unbridled {USA}), who won the G2 Prix Robert Papin in bloodless style and ran a good second, giving weight to the winner, behind leading English colt Distant Music (USA) (Distant View {USA}) in Doncaster's G2 Champagne S.

Aristotle (Ire)--A twice-raced son of Sadler's Wells (USA) and an unbeaten Group 1 winner following his hard-earned Racing Post Trophy success. Needs a lot of stoking up, but looks a high-class middle-distance prospect.

Monashee Mountain (USA)--By Danzig (USA) out of a Mr. Prospector (USA) mare, and might be anything after wins in Listed and Group 3 company on his only two outings.

Bernstein (USA)--the Storm Cat (USA) talking horse of the early part of the season won his first two by wide margins but came unstuck when trying to make all over a mile in bad ground in the Group 1 National S. High-class chance dropped back in trip.

One non-O'Brien trained colt made his mark in 1999, Sinndar (Ire), the Aga Khan's son of Grand Lodge (USA) who retired unbeaten in both his attempts, the second a hard-fought National S. victory which was arguably less impressive than his excellent debut win. On good ground he might win a good race in 2000, though his Group 1 penalty and the lack of a trip displayed by his sire's stock are worries.

Standout among the juvenile fillies was Neil Jones's homebred Preseli (Ire) (Caerleon {USA}), a grand-daughter of treble-Grade I winner White Star Line (USA). She came with a late and sustained run to win each of her three starts, rounding off her year by beating foreign raiders to take the Group 1 Moyglare Stud S. and championship honors. Bred to want middle-distances, she appears a genuine Oaks candidate.

Though O'Brien colts swept all before them in juvenile ranks, it was a different story among the Classic brigade. One can't cavil, of course, when a mile Classic winner and a champion sprinter are counted among the group, but you can't help reflecting that the way the season panned out bore little relation to the big plan at season's outset. Saffron Walden (Fr) (Sadler's Wells) (who experienced a spelling change mid-year, having scored his Classic success as Saffron Waldon) wasn't his stable's selected runner when he lined up, unbeaten, for his third seasonal start in the Entenmann's Irish 2000 Guineas, but then neither was his sire Sadler's Wells when he took the same race 15 years previously. Unfortunately, the second half of Saffron Walden's six-race season was a sad postscript to the first, his Derby seventh placing at least allowing the reason that he didn't stay the trip, his other two runs taking some of the shine of his Cclassic success.

In sharp contrast was the year experienced by Stravinsky (USA) (Nureyev {USA}), who started 1999 as his yard's main Guineas hope, but was twice beaten before being dropped back to the pure sprint trips he had always threatened to require. He won the G1 July Cup in awesome style by four lengths and the G1 Nunthorpe S. just as authoritatively before proving dirt wasn't his bag when only sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint. He looks an exciting stud prospect, sadly for European breeders, in Kentucky, not Ireland.

Saffron Walden's was the only Classic kept at home in Ireland in 1999. Hula Angel (USA) (Woodman {USA}), who had not been in the money at Newmarket, won a less-than-satisfactory Irish 1000 Guineas; Kayf Tara (GB) (Sadler's Wells) took his second Irish St Leger; and the two big ones went to foreign raiders who had already taken the major event in their own backyards, Ramruma (USA) (Diesis {GB}) sandwiching the G1 Irish Oaks between successes in the Epsom and Yorkshire equivalents, and Montjeu (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) blitzing his opponents in the G1 Irish Derby en route to divisional championship honors in the Arc.



Among the older horses, two performances stand out, one by an Irish runner abroad, the other by a raider in Ireland. Enzeli (GB) (Kahyasi {Ire}), trained by John Oxx for the Aga Khan, looked to be anything (certainly a lot more horse than he had seemed when winning a two-mile handicap in awful ground on his final three-year-old appearance) when taking the G1 Ascot Gold Cup, but was all wrong in the G1 Irish St Leger on his only subsequent outing. Daylami (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}), who blew the few remaining doubters away with his score in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, was unbelievable in the G1 East Digifone Champion S., powering away in the straight to beat opponents who, if they weren't the best 10-furlong group ever assembled, were nevertheless competitive, but who were made to look like platers by the winner's nine-length romp. Exploits of some very good two-year-olds included, it was the performance of the year in Ireland, probably in Europe.

On the stallion front, Sadler's Wells (Northern Dancer {Can}) reigned supreme, as always, while among the new horses Sri Pekan (USA) (Red Ransom {USA}) was well clear in the first-season sires table by earnings, but Distant View (USA) (Mr. Prospector) sired the colt with the most class (Distant Music) and Vettori (Ire) (Machiavellian {USA}) was arguably best of the bunch relative to opportunity. In the sales ring, the year was notable for a new Goffs yearling filly record of Ir£1.2 million paid by the mysterious Overseas Holdings Ltd for a Mr. Prospector filly bred and offered by Pat O'Kelly's Kilcarn Stud, but little else. Except at the top, which continues to go from strength to strength, the commercial market is very shaky with nice individuals commanding premiums, but the rest suffering as a result of the overproduction which is in danger of causing the industry serious damage over the next two or three years. And while the Irish government pleases all sectors of the business with its regularly increased handouts, the window dressing which this money has largely been spent on still hides a financially bereft racing sector whose racetracks (largely mismanaged and self-serving) seem to think grant-aid was invented for them. And the trouble with grant-aid, of course, is that it usually masks the problems it is designed to solve.
