AILING KNEE FORCES GARY STEVENS TO

CALL IT QUITS In a surprise announcement, jockey Gary Stevens retired from racing at a press conference at Santa Anita Park yesterday. The 36-year-old rider has been suffering from knee problems and underwent surgery on his right knee earlier this month. "It's degenerative arthritis," he said. "There is bone on bone and it's chipping away. I want to be able to walk in my later life." After finishing sixth in the Malibu S., Stevens took off his final two mounts of the day after the pain in his knee became too much to take. "At the eighth pole, I was praying for the finish line," he said. The Hall of Famer, who had recently signed a deal to ride for The Thoroughbred Corporation, had been considering retirement for several days. "I feel relieved. I'm at peace," he added. Stevens won six Triple Crown races, including three Kentucky Derbies: the 1988 running aboard the filly Winning Colors; with Thunder Gulch in 1995; and on Silver Charm in 1997. He won 4,512 races in a 20year career, with earnings of \$187,015,788.

SEEING RED IN THE MALIBU Given some time off after a victory in the Answer Do S. at Hollywood Park in July, Love That Red (Highland Park) returned with a trio of solid efforts against Cal-breds. Third to Big Jag in the California Sprint Championship at Bay Meadows Oct. 2, Love That Red won the Cal Cup Sprint H. in his next start, earning a 114 Beyer, the highest sprint figure in the field. Most recently, the gelding was second in the On Trust H. at Hollywood Park Dec. 4. Love That Red settled slightly off the rail, as Five Star Day (Carson City) outgunned Painter (Arg) (Robin des Bois) to the early lead. Jockey Garrett Gomez coaxed the dark bay to the inside on the turn, slipped through along the rail, then held on gamely for the victory. Straight Man (Saint Ballado), three deep early, dropped back some on the far turn then made a strong run through the final furlong to just miss, while Cat Thief (Storm Cat), making his first start since his Breeders' Cup Classic victory, closed well outside the top pair to finish third. Painter dropped back on the turn and was eased in the stretch. "I saw [Five Star Day] start to drift a little bit," said Gomez. "I thought this was my only shot, if I go now and slide through along the inside, hopefully it would work." Trainer D. Wayne Lukas wasn't too disappointed in Cat Thief's effort. "There was a trade-off today in that our horse is a two-turn horse and you just can't change his style too much," Lukas said.

Olympic Charmer has had a successful year sprinting, save for a forgettable 10th in the GI Test at Saratoga in August. Earlier, she was a 1 1/2-length winner of the GII Railbird S. at Hollywood Park at this trip and comes into this off a victory in the Oct. 24 Harold C. Ramser Sr. H. Penny Marie broke her maiden at first asking in February, was fourth at odds-on in her next start, but rebounded with back-to-back victories, including a 1 1/2-length score in Hollywood's Arbor Vitae S. in her last June 25. Hookedonthefeelin brings a four-for-five mark into this event. The winner of last year's GII Landaluce S. at Hollywood Park was most recently a three-length winner in Hollypark allowance company Dec. 3.

Coretta won four of her first five starts in the U.S., culminating with a two-length victory in last year's edition of the La Prevoyante. A victory in the GII Orchid H. at Gulfstream two starts later was followed by a freak injury in the GII Black Helen H. which forced her to the sidelines. The bay returned to the races this fall with a trio of strong efforts, including a pair of Grade I runner-up finishes, both to Soaring Softly, in the Flower Bowl two back and the inaugural Breeders' Cup Filly & Mare Turf last out, beaten just three-quarters of a length. Coretta broke well and was guided to the rail by jockey Jose Santos for a ground-saving journey as longshot Luna Craft (Crafty Prospector) led through reasonable fractions. Stuck behind a wall of horses at the quarter pole, Santos was forced to steady his mare as third-choice Idle Rich took over from Luna Craft, but the lead was short lived as Coretta found running room leaving the furlong grounds and outclassed her rivals under a hand ride. "I didn't expect to be as far back today as I was, but the course must have been a little fast," Santos said. "At the eighth pole, I was in tight quarters...but I felt I had a lot of power and she burst through and kicked away for me." Trainer Christophe Clement indicated that the bay could race again in the GII Orchid H. March 5 at Gulfstream Park before being bred to Seeking the Gold in 2000.

Early Warning returned from a four-month layoff to score a front-running victory in a Saratoga money allowance event Aug. 14, returning 15 days later to finish fourth in the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. The fouryear-old was third in the GIII Fayette Breeders' Cup H. at Keeneland in his next start and completed the trifecta again in the Oct. 29 Broad Brush S. at The Meadowlands. He got back into the win column when a pacepressing, two-length victor in the GIII Queen's County H. in his last effort Dec. 11. Drawn well, jockey Jorge Chavez aboard Early Warning was able to establish the lead with only moderate pressure from Durmiente and Salty Note. Chavez asked his mount to take up the running leaving the five-eighths pole and the bay colt responded to lead by 1 1/2 lengths with two furlongs to run and was kept under a drive to score his second consecutive graded-stakes victory. Said Chavez, "He won pretty easy. He runs his best when you get him to relax like that. I think he could have gone around again and no one would have caught him."

Cowboy Cop brought a four-race winning streak into last year's edition of the Gravesend, but disappointed when seventh as the 6-5 favorite. Redemption was immediate as the bay returned three weeks later to score his first graded-stakes victory in the GIII Hallandale H. at Gulfstream Park, but went to the sidelines after a sixth-place finish in the GII Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup Championship H. Feb. 13. With an eye on the Breeders' Cup Sprint, Team Stronach brought the five-year-old down to Calder to contest the Smile Sprint H. Oct. 9, but the homebred never reached contention in a seventh-place result. Cowboy Cop showed immediately in front, tracked intently by Brushed On to the far turn. The latter loomed to within a half-length of the lead after a half-mile in :45 3/5, but Cowboy Cop would not be lassoed and shook loose to win by an expanding margin. "He's a classy horse," said winning rider Aaron Gryder. "You've got to be aggressive with this horse and get into him or he won't respond."
