"FEELIN" FINE IN LA BREA

Hookedonthefeelin (Citidancer), who came close to losing her life last year but has lost only once on the racetrack, was let go at a generous 5-1 in yesterday's GI La Brea S. at Santa Anita, but proved to be best once again. The chestnut, who missed 10 months after taking the 1998 GII Landaluce S. by four lengths, dogged 9-5 favorite Kalookan Queen (Lost Code) through a half in :44 1/5, swept into the lead as they raced out of the turn and outfinished Olympic Charmer (Olympio) to win by 1 1/2 lengths, with the pacesetter another half length back in third. "We almost lost her after the Landaluce," winning trainer Bob Baffert said. "She got pneumonia and almost died. (Assistant trainer) Tim Yakteen saved her...we had to medicate her every few hours." The filly came back to win the May 7 Miss Preakness S. at Pimlico, was off another six months, then suffered her only defeat when she returned to be fourth in the Nov. 5 Love's Exchange S. at Gulfstream Park during the three-day Breeders' Cup meet. She bounced back with a Dec. 3 allowance win on the Hollywood turf and made it five-for-six in the La Brea. "She came out running and I just kept her wide and got her to relax," jockey David Flores said. "By the time I got to the stretch, I just let her go and that was it."

IT'S A "WONDER," BY A NOSE

Grass Wonder (Silver Hawk), with four wins and a second in his last five starts--all Japanese Group 1 or 2 races--was made the slight 5-2 favorite over G1 Japan Cup winner Special Week (Jpn) (Sunday Silence) for Sunday's G1 Arima Kinen. The four-year-old did not let the crowd at Nakayama Racecourse down, holding off the Japan Cup hero for a game nose victory. Going Suzuka (Jpn) (Dyna Gulliver {Jpn}) set a slow pace, reaching the half in :51.9, with Grass Wonder back in 10th and Special Week sitting 14th. But the late closers were all moving as the field hit the final turn, now chasing Tsurumaru Tsuyoshi (Jpn) (Symboli Rudolf {Jpn}), who had taken command in mid-stretch. Grass Wonder and Japanese Derby winner T.M. Opera O (Jpn) (Opera House {GB}) caught the leader with 100 meters to go. Jockey Yutaka Take had Special Week flying on the outside and the three hit the line together, with Grass Wonder proving just slightly better. "I thought we won by a head," said Take. "It was just bad timing."

Although only a couple of feet and a few pounds separated the winner Love That Red from the third-placed Cat Thief in Sunday's Malibu S., these two three-year-olds are worlds apart in terms of the fashionableness of their pedigrees.

Whereas Cat Thief is by Storm Cat, whose nominations commanded prices of \$430,000 and \$415,000 at the Stallion Access November sale, Love That Red is by Highland Park, a stallion who stands in Virginia for a fee of \$1,200 after moving east from California.

Highland Park's current fee is a reflection of his modest overall record as a stallion rather than of any major flaw in either his racing record or his pedigree. With Raise a Native as his sire and Old Goat, winner of the GIII Golden Rod S., as his dam, Highland Park was bred to make a two-year-old and he shone at that age. The compilers of the Experimental Free Handicap considered him the fourth-best juvenile colt of 1982, inferior only to Copelan, Roving Boy and Desert Wine, and they allocated him 121 pounds.

Highland Park suffered from none of the problems that limited Raise a Native to just four juvenile starts and he enjoyed a long and busy campaign of 11 races, which produced six wins. Among his wins were the GIII Juvenile S., the GII Breeders' Futurity and the GIII Kentucky Jockey Club S., and in the last two he numbered the future GI Belmont S. winner Caveat among his victims.

Showing no signs of wear from this taxing juvenile campaign, Highland Park did well at Gulfstream Park in February, 1983, finishing a nose second in the GIII Hutcheson S. before winning a division of the GII Fountain of Youth S. However, a disappointing effort in the GI Kentucky Derby brought down the curtain on his career after 16 starts.

Highland Park was bred by Millard Waldheim of Bwamazon Farm, but Brereton C. Jones purchased a half-interest in the colt towards the end of his juvenile season and it was to Jones' Airdrie Stud that he retired in 1984 at a fee of \$15,000. Hopes that he would develop into another successful stallion son for the great Raise a Native soon began to fade, even though his first crop contained the Classic-placed French filly Duckling Park.

However, Highland Park made amends for the lack of any graded-stakes winners in his first two crops with a 1987 crop which featured Highland Talk (1990 GI Gazelle H.) and Jacodra ('91 GIII Potrero Grande H.). These winners weren't enough to keep him in Kentucky and he was moved to California, where he sired Love That Red.

Love That Red is the only stakes winner to emerge from the first 12 foals of racing age out of Pat's Lady Red, a winner of her only start. But the fact that this daughter of Circle Home was bred by Elmendorf Farm warns us that Pat's Lady Red's background is far from ordinary. Love That Red's second dam, Lady In Red, was by Prince John out of a daughter of the very good French import Nuit de Folies, which makes her a three-parts sister to Speak John. Besides siring such as Hold Your Peace, Verbatim, Talking Picture and Text, Speak John emulated his sire Prince John and grandsire Princequillo by becoming a champion sire of broodmares.

Lady In Red was also a sister to Lilac Hill, winner of the GI Cotillion S., as well as being a half-sister to Rouge Sang, a high-class European middle-distance performer. So Love That Red possesses plenty of quality bloodlines, even if he isn't bred in the height of fashion.

STOP TRAFFIC RETIRED MGISW Stop Traffic (Cure the Blues--Save My Soul, by I'ma Hell Raiser) has been retired and will head to Crystal Springs Farm in Paris, Kentucky. The Kentucky-bred bay be bred to Seattle Slew in 2000. Owned by Gerald J. Ford's Diamond A Racing Corp., the six-year-old accounted for eight stakes victories during her five seasons of racing, taking the GI Ballerina H. in 1998 and the GI Santa Monica H. in 1999. Overall, she won 12 of her 35 career starts with nine seconds and five thirds for earnings of \$864,519. Second in the Nov. 7 Safely Kept S. at Gulfstream during Breeders' Cup weekend, she made her final appearance in the Corona H. at Hollywood Park Dec. 18 and finished sixth.
