TUZLA TACKLES MONROVIA

Eclipse champion finalist Tuzla (Fr) (Panoramic {GB}) looks to sneak in her fourth graded stakes victory of 1999 in today's GIII Monrovia H. at Santa Anita. The five-year-old mare, purchased last summer by Robert and Janice McNair's Stonerside Stable, has been first or second in seven of eight starts this year. Her lone stumble was a fifth-place outing in the 1 1/4-mile GI Yellow Ribbon S., but she rebounded from that effort to run strong seconds in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile and in the Nov. 28 GI Matriarch last time out. Defending Monrovia H. winner **Desert Lady (Ire)** (Danehill) was fourth against colts in the Nov. 26 GIII Hollywood Turf Express H. in her last start. **Optical Solution (Arg)** (Candy Stripes) puts her unbeaten record on the line in her stakes debut. She won her bow over the main track at Santa Anita last February before taking back-to-back Hollywood turf allowances. The four-year-old filly has been off since recording the second of those wins on June 26. **Honest Lady (Seattle Slew)**, winner of the GII Santa Ynez last January, won her Nov. 4 turf debut over this course and distance in her last trip to the post. **Show Me the Stage (Slew the Surgeon)** defeated the boys in her lone turf appearance, Calder's July 31 Turf Sprint H. The three-year-old filly comes off a two-length victory in the Dec. 9 off-the-turf Dr. A. B. Leggio H. at Fair Grounds.

PRADO HITS 400 AGAIN Edgar Prado recorded his 400th victory of 1999 yesterday at Calder. It was the third consecutive year Prado had reached the 400 plateau. Currently the country's leading rider by wins, he took the national title with 470 victories in 1998 and 536 in 1997. Only jockeys Chris McCarron and Russell Baze have won 400 races or more for three consecutive years. "It took a lot of hard work, but I had a lot of support from trainers at a lot of tracks and a lot of good horses to ride," Prado said after winning yesterday's fifth race at Calder aboard Prince of Theater. "I'm looking forward to riding 401."

Drawing in off the also-eligibles, the 16-1 shot flashed his speed from the outside and recovered from a bump on the turn to stride clear by 3 1/2 lengths over Iron Chancellor (Roy). Migliore Comeback Delayed:

Sometimes time doesn't heal all wounds, at least not yet. That's what jockey Richard Migliore found out yesterday when he couldn't get an okay from his doctor to ride today. X-rays revealed there was still a gap in Migliore's right forearm which was shattered in a spill at Belmont Park on July 17. "It's disappointing," said Migliore. The frustrating news came after Migliore worked two horses yesterday morning for trainer John Kimmel. "I went to the doctor to get the okay but wasn't able to secure it," said Migliore. "There's still a gap in the fracture, but it looks great but not enough." Even though he is able to work horses in the morning, the gap still is a cause for concern when racing. "He told me that if I fell it wouldn't take much to shatter the arm completely again," continued Migliore. The 35-year-old was scheduled to ride two horses today at Aqueduct and Go Again Valid in tomorrow's GIII Interborough H. He will go back for more x-rays on Jan. 12 and then consult with his doctor Steven Erlanger before announcing his next comeback try. "It's tough to accept," said Migliore. "I was working on my weight and weighed in at 113 pounds stripped yesterday. I'm ready to go so this is discouraging."

Looking to make it three in a row, the colt set the pace from the start and gamely held off the late charge of favored Stormy Jack. "He was looking around a little bit in the first part because he was going so easy," explained winning rider David Flores. "When we got to the three-eighths pole, he really started running and he was doing so much on his own. He made me work on him the last part but he was just good enough to make it there." Trainer Bob Baffert added, "This is as far as he can run. Sometimes when you're Cal-bred, that's as far as you need to run."

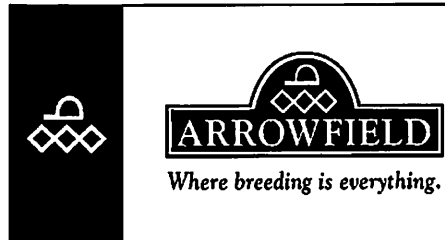
