## UNSHADED ENJOYS A DAY IN THE SUN

Making his stakes debut in yesterday's GII Coolmore Lexington S. at Keeneland, **Unshaded** (Unbridled) earned a share of the three-year-old spotlight with a widening three-length win. Will he try to follow in the hoofsteps of last year's Lexington--and GI Kentucky Derby and GI Preakness--winner Charismatic? "[Owner James Tafel] will have to make that decision," trainer Carl Nafzger said. The colt, who was winless in two starts last season but is now three-for-three in 2000, would have to be supplemented to the May 6 "Run for the Roses" at a cost of \$150,000. Jockey Shane Sellers, who lost his Derby mount when **Mighty** went down with an injured knee (see p6), chimed in, "He's a big son of a gun who is just learning what he is doing out there. I don't know what Mr. Tafel and Mr. Carl are planning on doing, but I sure wouldn't mind if they decided to go on to the Kentucky Derby." The bay opened the season with a maiden win sprinting at Gulfstream Jan. 29 and added an allowance win going 1 1/16 miles over that track Feb. 26. Allowed to settle in seventh this time, he circled the field on the far turn and drove past GII Turfway Spiral S. winner **Globalize** (Summer Squall) for his third in a row. "We overcame three obstacles today," Nafzger said, "We had not run in 2 1/2 months, we moved from allowance to stakes company and he was running over a speed-favoring track with tight turns. And that's a lot to overcome." The only Lexington starter who has definite plans for the first Saturday in May is fourth-place finisher **Commendable** (Gone West), who shipped in from California after finishing fourth in the Mar. 4 GII San Rafael S. and in the Mar. 19 GII San Felipe S. "He was in a convoy the whole way around there," trainer D. Wayne Lukas said. "This horse doesn't have the experience that some of our other horses have, but he learned to cope with some adversity today. He ran well when he got his chance. We ran well, we came back in good shape and now we can look at the next stop. We're still two weeks from this thing [Kentucky Derby]."

## SUNSHINE STREAKS TO CAPISTRANO SCORE

**Sunshine Street** (Sunshine Forever), who could manage only one win from his first 17 starts, picked up his third consecutive victory at Santa Anita yesterday, out-finishing 7-10 **Single Empire (Ire)** (Kris {GB}) to win the GI San Juan Capistrano H. by two lengths. The 2-1 second choice in the five-horse field, he had started the year with an allowance score going 1 1/4 miles Jan. 30, took two months off, and came back to take another allowance, this time at 1 1/8 miles Apr. 2. Stretching out to the marathon distance of the Capistrano, the bay sat last of the tightly bunched group through 10 furlongs in 2:06, but kicked it into gear in the final three furlongs, taking control at the top of the stretch and holding the favorite safe to the wire. "[Trainer Neil Drysdale] told me not to lay any worse than fifth," quipped winning rider Jerry Bailey. "Actually, Neil didn't give me any specific instructions except to get him to turn off and gallop along until I asked him. I did take a beating going around the turf as far as losing ground was concerned, but he was going so smoothly I didn't want to change anything." Drysdale, who saddled the top two finishers, added, "Sunshine Street had a nice clear run, but...[jockey Kent Desormeaux] said that when [Single Empire] came through at the three-eighths pole, he got hammered and he felt it kind of knocked the breath out of the horse. He ran the rest of the way just on guts."

A Listed winner in France, Snow Polina had earned two victories in her five prior U.S. starts. Off from May of 1999 until January of this year, she picked up an allowance win at Gulfstream Feb. 11 and was most recently second to today's GII Santa Barbara H. hopeful Histoire Sainte (Fr) in the Mar. 4 Bayou Breeders' Cup H. at Fair Grounds. The choice to notch her first U.S. stakes score, the chestnut shadowed 31-1 Treasure Town (Pirate's Bounty) (fifth) through pedestrian fractions, took over at the top of the lane and held off Neptune's Bride. "She suffered a condylar fracture last year and I have to give [veterinarian Dr. Stephen Selway] a lot of credit," trainer Bill Mott said. "He did a good job of putting her back together. She's been a big project for us and we feel pretty good about this win."

Monkey Puzzle shed his bridesmaid status in capturing the biggest race of his career. Multiple graded-stakes placed at three, he returned this season with an allowance win over this course. After placing second in another allowance, he finished a troubled sixth in the GII Pan American H. Mar. 4, beaten just three lengths by Buck's Boy. With new pilot Rene Douglas aboard, the bay colt was unhurried early and began to pick up horses on the far turn. Angling to the outside, he outkicked favored Honor Glide for the score. "Although it looked like he had a wide trip, he had a good trip," said trainer Stephen DiMauro. "He's had a lot of bad trips in the past and, believe me, this was a clear trip." Monkey Puzzle may have punched his ticket for the May 6 GI Woodford Reserve Turf Classic at Churchill.

Winless since taking the GI Met Mile at Belmont Park last May 29, Sir Bear ended last season with a seventh-place finish in the Oct. 15 GII Meadowlands Cup and had been off the board in his two previous starts this term, running fifth in the Feb. 5 GI Donn H. and fourth when dropped back to seven furlongs for the Mar. 10 GII Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup Sprint Championship H. Stretching out to a distance at which he has never been beaten, the veteran gelding relaxed near the back of the pack early, set his sights on pacesetter Lexington Park on the final bend and outgamed that rival to the wire to take the photo. Breaking smartly, the bay mare quickly opened up on the field, leading by as much as five lengths, and was kept busy down the stretch over the late-closing Up We Go. "People don't understand that she's a warrior," commented winning trainer John Parisella. "The last race was tough, but the race before that was nothing. I'm sorry Frankel didn't show." Trainer Bobby Frankel scratched morning-line favorite Honest Lady (Seattle Slew) due to the wet track.

Yavana's Pace is the ultimate evergreen, and he seems to be getting better with age. Last year he made the step from top handicap to Group class by taking the Listed March S. at Goodwood in August and the G3 September S. at Epsom the following month, before a disappointing attempt when unplaced in the G1 Melbourne Cup. He showed that he retains all his ability and gameness here, establishing a lead from the start, setting a slow pace and upping the tempo until he was headed after the bend by Capri. That one looked like he would go on, but the eight-year-old battled back and in a tussle to the line, he just overcame the runner-up in the dying strides. Trainer Mark Johnston said, "Because he's getting on in years, people think that because he runs a bad race he's finished, but that's not the case."

The winner of the Gilll What a Pleasure S. at Calder to end his juvenile campaign, Tahkodha Hills took a Jan. 15 Gulfstream allowance in his first try this year. Second in the \$75,000 Unbridled allowance on the GI Fountain of Youth S. undercard, he was 57-1 in the Mar. 20 GI Florida Derby and finished third, but 10 lengths behind Hal's Hope and High Yield. He was 6-1 in his latest outing, but ended up 10 lengths in arrears once again, this time running fourth behind the unbeaten Trippi in the Apr. 8 Gilll Flamingo S. The second choice after a trip to Texas, the dark bay shadowed the leaders off an untaxing pace, moved to the outside for the stretch run and bested Jebblar Sez Who after a dog fight down the stretch for the narrow score. Trainer Ralph Ziadie insisted after the race that he will not head to the May 6 GI Kentucky Derby, but added, "If he cools out good, I would not rule him out running him in the Preakness [May 20], but it's doubtful. I'd really like to point him for the Belmont S. [June 10]. The Illinois Derby [GII, May 13 at Sportsman's Park] is always a possibility."

Returning after a five-month layoff here, the New Zealand champion, four-for-eight in the States, put in a bullet six-furlong work Apr. 13. **Caffe Latte**, a Listed stakes winner in France, ran second in both the July 31 GII San Clemente H. and the Oct. 2 GI Yellow Ribbon S. last season and ended the campaign with a creditable fourth in the Nov. 6 GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf. She came back after a five-month break to earn her first U.S. win, taking an optional claimer at Santa Anita Apr. 6. GI Yellow Ribbon winner **Spanish Fern**, a too-bad-to-be-true 14th at the Breeders' Cup, bounced back to be third in the Matriarch, second in the Jan. 17 GII San Gorgonio H. and most recently came home a half-length winner in the GII Santa Ana H. Mar. 26.

**Captain Steve Sharp at Churchill:**

Trainer Bob Baffert, who already has two Kentucky Derby trophies on the shelf, sent his 2000 hopeful **Captain Steve** (Fly So Free) out to work five furlongs over the Churchill Downs strip yesterday morning. The colt dashed through fractions of :23 4/5 and :35 3/5 before completing the breeze in :59 4/5. "He showing me right now that he's getting into his work," Baffert said. "The whole plan was to get him to start peaking. I backed off him after December...and I said you've got to start from scratch. So now he's finally going the right way again and whether he peaks for the Derby or the Preakness, we don't know yet."

**Godolphin Update:**

After watching Godolphin Kentucky Derby candidate **China Visit** (Red Ransom) win a trial in handy fashion at Nad Al Sheba Friday, the stable's racing manager Simon Crisford told *Racing Post*, "It was a good run--they went very fast and they finished in a good time. He's on target for the Kentucky Derby, provided he gets in." As for **Chief Seattle** (Seattle Slew), who has not raced since finishing second in last year's GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile and finished a well-beaten fifth behind China Visit, Crisford commented, "He got very tired, as we knew he would. Hopefully this will bring him on significantly. He's still in the Kentucky Derby, but we're going to see how the situation is over the next week." The pair, as well as **Curule** (Go for Gin), who was second to China Visit in Friday's trial and third behind his stable-mate in the Mar. 25 UAE Derby, will ship to Kentucky Tuesday and go through quarantine at Keeneland, then head to Churchill Downs Thursday. Only Chief Seattle, who has \$303,000 in graded-stakes earnings, would make the Derby cut if the race draws more than 20 three-year-olds. Godolphin's other two colts are without any graded winnings.

**Mighty Out of Derby:**

GI Louisiana Derby winner **Mighty** (Lord at War {Arg}) will be forced to miss the May 6 GI Kentucky Derby after straining the carpal tunnel behind his right knee. The colt was a disappointing seventh in the Apr. 15 GI Toyota Blue Grass S. last time out. "It's probably from the race," trainer Frank Brothers said. "He seemed fine out of the race, but sometimes you have to train them a few days to see what happens. He seemed fine, but he galloped a couple of days and he had a little filling behind his knee." As for the colt's status for the future, Brothers said, "It could be something that could be [healed] in a week or two, or less. But if it's a little more involved, it could be a month or two. We really don't know right now--we're kind of in a gray area. But it looks to be minor." He added, "When he's right, we'll get a game plan and go down the road."

### CHANGES TO SHERGAR CUP FORMAT

This year's Blue Square-sponsored Shergar Cup day, which will offer £400,000 in guaranteed prize money at Ascot Aug. 12, will include some major changes to last year's format. Most notably, the distance of the £100,000 Shergar Cup Classic has been changed to a mile and a half; and there will be two new races, the £50,000 Shergar Cup Juvenile, run over a mile, and the European Breeders' Fund-sponsored £50,000 Shergar Cup Oaks, run over a mile and a half for fillies and mares. The Shergar Cup Distaff, run over a mile last year, now will be a handicap sprint over six furlongs, while the Shergar Cup Stayers has been extended from 1 3/4 miles to two miles. Entries, which will again be free, close July 12.
