BELMONT WRAP-UP

Commendable (Gone West) came out of his victory in Saturday's Belmont S. in good order, according to trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "He's perfect," said Lukas yesterday morning. "He didn't show a lot of stress from (Saturday's race). He ate well and had a very good night." Lukas said he had no immediate plans for his fourth Belmont winner. "I'm going to leave him in New York for a while," he said. "I don't want to ship him unnecessarily." Trainer Bobby Frankel said he had not decided on a next start for runner-up **Aptitude** (A.P. Indy). "He came out fine," said Frankel. "I have no idea what's next." **Unshaded** (Unbridled), who suffered from mild heat exhaustion after his third-place finish, was showing no ill effects yesterday morning, according to Sara Dunham, assistant to trainer Carl Nafzger. "He's doing just fine," she said. "I don't know if he's staying in New York or going to Kentucky. The (Aug. 26, GI) Travers will probably be a goal for him." Fourth-place finisher **Wheelaway** (Unbridled), who looked full of run nearing the stretch, was affected by the heat, according to trainer John Kimmel. "I'm going to take it easy on him," said Kimmel, who hopes to aim for the Aug. 5 GII Jim Dandy S. and the Travers at Saratoga. "I probably won't breeze him for two or three weeks. I might even send him down to Fair Hill and let him have some easy time." Fifth-place **Impeachment** (Deputy Minister) will also point for the Jim Dandy, said trainer Todd Pletcher.

BAILEY TO RIDE FOR GODOLPHIN AT ASCOT

Jockey Jerry Bailey will replace Frankie Dettori aboard a number of choice mounts during the Royal Ascot meeting June 20-23, *Sporting Life* reports. The 43-year-old has had success in the past riding for the Dubai operation, including a victory in the 1998 GI Man o' War S. with Daylami. Among the rider's possible mounts are said to be G1 Dubai World Cup winner **Dubai Millennium** (GB) (Seeking the Gold) in the June 21 G1 Prince of Wales's S. and **Kayf Tara** (GB) (Sadler's Wells) in the G1 Ascot Gold Cup the following afternoon.

EGYPTBAND REBOUNDS TO CLASSIC WIN

The winner of her only two previous starts, a condition race as a juvenile in mid-November and another conditions event at Saint-Cloud in mid-March, **Egyptband** (Dixieland Band) had since been sidelined with a virus, like most of Criquelette Head's stable. After showing a return to health a few weeks ago, however, she was allowed to take her place in yesterday's G1 Prix de Diane Hermes (French Oaks) at Chantilly and confirm the return to form of her trainer's string with a superb effort. Settled in midfield towards the outside as **Baume Au Coeur** (Ire) (Common Grounds {GB}) led from **Arduine** (GB) (Diesis {GB}) and her stable companion **Goldamix** (Linamix {Fr}), Egyptband made swift progress toward the leaders early in the straight and after Goldamix and then the favourite **Volvoreta** (Suave Dancer) had each grabbed the lead in turn, she swept past them at the distance and soon went clear to win unchallenged. It was a highly emotional Criquelette Head who welcomed her filly after the victory. "This filly was very sick after her last race, but she had always shown ability," she said. "I had hoped to run my filly America (Ire) in this race, but she is presently on the sidelines and with Egyptband coming back to her best just recently, we decided to take a chance. She has shown her class here and, after having a holiday and all being well, she will now have the (G1) Prix Vermeille (at Longchamp Sept. 10) as her target." Delighted jockey Olivier Doleuze said, "This is the most beautiful day of my life. My father won this race 20 years ago and it's very special to follow in his footsteps." Carlos Lerner, trainer of the beaten favorite Volvoreta, said, "Egyptband was the only filly in the field which Volvoreta had never met before. She had a beautiful trip but was beaten by the better filly on the day. I will now point her to the Prix Vermeille, probably without the benefit of a prep race."

Freemason gave trainer John Hawkes his fifth Group
1 win of the season and his third Queensland Derby
with this win. The victor in last year's G1 T J Smith at
the same track, Freemason settled well back in the field
before jockey Larry Cassidy brought the colt with a
perfectly timed finish to hit the lead inside the final 200
meters. AJC Australian Derby winner Fairway (Danzero
{Aus}), the 7-2 co-favorite, had no luck when he was
caught three and four wide for most of the trip before
finishing fourth. "The race worked out perfectly for him
today with plenty of speed on," Hawkes said.

The winner of the GI Belmont S. in 1999, Lemon Drop Kid went on to be second in the GII Jim Dandy and added a second Grade I win to his resume with a success in the Travers. But the bay ended his '99 season with off-the-board finishes in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup and GI Breeders' Cup Classic. He returned after a 4 1/2-month break to finish first in the Mar. 18 GIII Widener H. only to be disqualified and placed fourth for causing interference at the eighth pole, then captured an Aqueduct allowance in a dead heat Apr. 15. He came into this effort as the second choice after finishing third in the May 13 GI Pimlico Special, but trainer Scotty Schulhofer said, "He should have been second in there, but he looked up and saw the gate in the stretch." Making certain he couldn't be distracted this time, Schulhofer put on the blinkers and colt responded, powering from third to take control as they raced into the stretch and striding away in an impressive performance. The Kentucky bred will make his next start in the GII Suburban H. July 4. Running Stag (Cozzene), winner of the GII Massachusetts H. just eight days ago, set a pressured pace, but folded to finish sixth. Said jockey Shane Sellers, "It was really hot out, and I knew mid-way around the turn that I had no horse left."

A multiple Grade 1 winner in Chile, Big Ten had made just one U.S. start, finishing fourth in a money allowance at Hollywood on the turf May 10. Undaunted by that loss, trainer Richard Mandella popped him into an uncharacteristically weak Californian and reaped the rewards. With Early Pioneer, the only U.S. graded stakes winner in the field, the heavy favorite, Big Ten was sent off the third choice. Scooter Brown set the pace, leading the field through three-quarters with Big Ten just off him. The winner took the lead on the turn and headed into the lane with daylight on the others and held off the late charge of Early Pioneer with both well clear of the others. Jockey Alex Solis, aboard losing favorite Aptitude in Saturday's Belmont S., was grateful for a happy outcome here. "After the disappointment yesterday, this is a great reward," said Solis. "The first time I got on this horse I thought he was very special and thank God he came through like this." Said trainer Richard Mandella, "I think his record speaks that he's a better horse on the dirt, so knowing that, we felt he had a chance to run well today. He's not a real generous work horse, so we weren't quite sure what to expect, but it's nice to see him run like this." Mandella said he would now point Big Ten for the July 9 GI Hollywood Gold Cup.

The winner of the 1999 GII Connaught Cup, Incitatus was third in this year's renewal May 27 at Woodbine in his prior outing and was looking for his first win in nearly a year here, having last come home first in an optional claiming allowance last July in Toronto. The second choice behind heavy favorite Quiet Resolve, winner of the May 20 GII Dixie H. at Pimlico last out May 20, Incitatus trailed the field through the first quarter and entered the turn with just one horse beaten, but collared the favorite on the bend, turned for home with the lead and never looked back, drawing clear for the victory.

This was a typical French middle-distance race, with the lead changing hands several times during the first mile and the ultimate result decided in a sprint finish. From the start, jockey Christophe Soumillon kept the recent Listed Prix de la Porte de Madrid winner Daring Miss in a handy position while the English challengers Little Rock (GB) (Warning {GB}) and Lucido (Ire) (Royal Academy {USA}) took it in turns to lead. Lucido was the confirmed leader around the two turns, with Daring Miss and First Magnitude close. Once in the straight, the race developed into a battle between Daring Miss and First Magnitude, with the latter threatening to follow up his recent victory in the G2 Prix Jean de Chaudenay with another G2 win here, but Soumillon always appeared to have something in hand on the filly, who kept her nose in front to the line to gain her first Group race victory.

Only once off the board in her career, Saoirse has been kept exclusively in stakes company north of the border this season and began her four-year-old campaign with a 3 3/4-length tally in the Apr. 1 La Voyageuse S. Second in the Whimsical S. two weeks later, the homebred was a one-length winner of the Gill George C. Hendrie at Woodbine May 13. The third choice in the field of seven, the bay was hustled from her inside post to dispute the early issue inside favored Runaway Venus (Runaway Groom). She stuck a head in front at the top of the turn, was joined and headed at the top of the stretch by Quanah (Lord At War {Arg}), but fought back gamely for the victory. "We've only raced her at home and so we didn't really know how good she was," said winning trainer Phillip England, who won this event in 1996 with Bunbeg for Knob Hill Stable. "When I ship I always feel that first they've got to prove they're good enough to go away and when they're away, they've got to prove they're good enough to be away." There may be another van in Saoirse's future. "I've always had Saratoga in the back of my mind and judging by what we saw today, I would think that would remain a possibility."
