John's Call Will Supplement

John's Call (Lord At War {Arg}) will be supplemented to the Breeders' Cup Turf, owner Douglas Joyce said last night. The nine-year-old gelding will be the oldest horse ever to start in a

Breeders' Cup race. A two-time Grade I winner this year, he comes off a victory in Belmont's Turf Classic and figures to be one of the main contenders. Joyce will have to pay a \$240,000 supplementary fee to run. "I don't know how many chances you get in life to participate in a race like this," said Joyce. "For me, this might be the only one."

No Sprint for Forest Camp

Forest Camp (Deputy Minister), a four-length winner of the six-furlong Pirate's Bounty H. at Del Mar Sept. 9, will not make the Breeders' Cup Sprint, according to his trainer, Eduardo Inda. "We're going to pass that race," said the trainer. Forest Camp followed his Del Mar win with a fourth-place finish as the favorite in the GII Forest Hills. H. Oct. 14 at Belmont. Inda's Breeders' Cup Distaff favorite Riboletta (Brz) (Roi Normand) is scheduled to work three furlongs at Churchill Downs this morning.

Lu Ravi Works Blistering Six Furlongs

Lu Ravi (A.P. Indy) worked six furlongs in 1:11 over the Churchill Downs surface yesteray morning in preparation for the Breeders' Cup Distaff. "It was an excellent work for her," said trainer Carl Bowman. "I worked her hard today because she's got a lot of flesh on her and this will be her last significant work before she runs." Lu Ravi won three straight races under Pat Day this spring and summer--the GIII Sixty Sails, GII Molly Pitcher and GIII Delaware H--before finishing sixth in the GI Ruffian H. at Belmont Sept. 16 under Jerry Bailey in her most recent outing. Bailey gets the call again.

Plenty of Light Unlikely

Aaron and Marie Jones GI Three Chimneys Spinster winner Plenty of Light (Colony of Light) is unlikely to start in the Distaff against the Jones's own Riboletta, said trainer Elliott Walden yesterday, though they may pre-enter as a precaution, he added. "We're training her, but in all likelihood, they're going to run Riboletta," he said. "I don't want to run against her."

GROUP ONE HAT TRICK FOR GOLDEN SNAKE

Golden Snake (Danzig) collected his third Group 1 success in yesterday's G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club Italiano in Milan, Italy, adding the score to those in the G1 Prix Jean Prat at Chantilly in 1999 and the G1 Preis von Europa at Cologne Sept. 24. That he is a stakes winner in Britain, France, Germany, and now Italy speaks volumes for this admirable colt. This year, he had returned with two defeats when fourth to Montieu (Ire) in the G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup at The Curragh May 28 and when fifth to Agol Lack in the G3 Coupe de Maisons-Laffitte Sept. 13, but he has now hit a rich vein of form to win twice at the highest level. Yesterday, he raced in second behind Shibuni's Falcon (GB) (Polar Falcon) early before hitting the front with two and a half furlongs remaining to hold the strong challenge of Reve D'Oscar (Fr) (Highest Honor (Fr)) and jockey Frankie Dettori. In pursuit of further glory, connections will either send him to Rome next for the G1 Premio Roma Nov. 19 or to Hong Kong for the G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin.

Count Dubois has been beaten by two useful colts this season in Mozart (Ire) in the Tattersalls Houghton Sales S. (Newmarket, Sept. 26) and Nayef in the Listed Autumn S. (Ascot, Oct. 7) but found the opportunity to excel at the highest level at first asking. Although a longshot, he was always travelling well in the race and won easily enough despite the company. Racing in second early behind jockey Frankie Dettori and Spettro, he quickened with a quarter of a mile remaining before holding the late challenge of jockey Michael Kinane and King's County, the favourite here. He will be rested now for the G1 Derby Italiano at Rome next year, which is a route likely to be taken by the connections of Spettro.

Amilynx made little fuss of becoming the first horse since this contest was opened up to older horses in 1980 to win two renewals. In doing so, he confirmed that he is one of the leading lights of the staying division for many a year, having the ability to win over a mile and a half as well as imposing his strength on his rivals over this trip. Last year he picked up the winning thread in the G2 Prix Hubert de Chaudenay here before beating Tajoun by a length and a half in this contest. This year, he was second over the 10 furlongs of the G3 Prix Exbury at Saint-Cloud Mar. 11 on his return, before finishing seventh at Nad Al Sheba in the G3 Dubai Sheema Classic Mar. 25. Having taken the G2 Prix Vicomtesse Vigier here May 21, he was ready to stake his claim for a second victory in this. Ridden to perfection by jockey Olivier Peslier, he raced in fourth in behind the early leader Apollo Victoria (Fr) (Sadler's Wells), San Sebastian and Royal Rebel (GB) (Robellino). As the latter came under pressure before the turn into the straight, Peslier moved up stealthily to target jockey Davy Bonilla and San Sebastian, while Chiang Mai (Ire) (Sadler's Wells) arrived on the scene on the rail. At the top of the straight, he asked Amilynx to go on and the grey started to draw away from the game runner-up while jockey Gerald Mosse was finishing strongly on the outside aboard Tajoun. They did not have a chance with the winner, however, and it took only hands and heels riding to assure victory as he pulled clear in the final furlong. Roland de Longevialle, racing manager for the owner Jean-Luc Lagardere, said, "I don't really know what could be next, as we had concentrated on this race first. He was supposed to return in September in the G2 Prix Foy here and then eventually go on to the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe if he had run well, but a minor setback compromised the plan. He has returned stronger than ever and we will discuss his future with the trainer and the jockey."

Volponi made his first lifetime start on the turf July 14 at Belmont Park, but, after finishing third as the even-money choice (albeit to the yesterday's race favorite, Baptize) was switched to the dirt. Twice second and finally third last out in an Oct. 1 Belmont six-furlong dirt affair, he had been favorite in each of his four lifetime starts--until this race. As it turned out, the fans jumped off him just a shade too early as the former maiden moved four wide on the turn, took over the favorite at the eighth pole and was hand-ridden as he cruised under the wire. "Every time I had him in a maiden turf race, it would rain and I would scratch him," said trainer Phil Johnson. "Then I started running him on the dirt and he ran fair. He got in the money every time. I think the best thing for him might be to go to Camden, South Carolina, for the winter and bring him back in the spring, but I have to talk to the partners." John Velazquez completed a sweep of Belmont's graded stakes with the win.

Ruff started off her career, like most, sprinting on the dirt, but was switched to the grass after an 0-for-2 start. She won her first turf outing at first asking going six furlongs July 12 at Belmont, added a win in the Aug. 26 Jr. Champion S. at Monmouth in her next outing, and was a close third in Colonial's Tippett Breeders Cup in her most recent outing Oct. 17. Despite getting off to a "funky" start here, according to jockey John Velazquez, she saved ground early, angled out for room at the top of the stretch and drove home the winner. "She proved herself today," said trainer Dave Donk. "She might run in the (Nov. 23, Gill) Miesque S. (at Hollywood Park.)"

Proudwings was sent off the well-backed favourite here on the strength of her exploits in Germany and in Italy this season. Twice a winner at Hannover and Dusseldorf earlier in the summer, she was a half-length second to Bernardon (Ger) in the G3 Darley-Oettingen-Rennen at Baden-Baden Aug. 28 before winning the G3 Premio Pietro Bessero here Oct. 1. Here she tracked the early leader Xua (Ire) (Fairy King), before being produced with a stunning turn of foot to put her seal on the race in the final furlong and a half.

The trail-blazing Repertory gained a career-best win here with as bold a show as he has ever put up in his life. Normally, he appears in sprint handicaps in Britain, where more often than not his freewheeling style has seen him passed at the business end of the race. In 1999, he also ran second to subsequent G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp runner-up Imperial Beauty in the Listed Dubai Airport World Trophy at Newbury. He was third in this contest last year to Manzor (Fr) when Nuclear Debate was second, but this year he stepped up on that to gain a well-deserved second stakes success. Taken to the front straightaway by jockey Richard Hughes, he continued to stretch his rivals. By halfway, El Gran Lode was struggling, while Lincoln Dancer was never picking up enough to pose a danger. Ridden out to the line, he had a comfortable length to spare over that horse and, at least for a brief time, his connections can relish the experience of having a sprinter near the top of the division.

Kapitol is a consistent performer, having been placed behind talented horses such as Puntilla, Quezon City and Moonlady this season. She opened her account at Mulheim last time out in a conditions event and she carried on the winning run here. Racing in fourth early as Anzillero set a scorching pace which soon had the field strung out, she was moved closer on the back straight as the leader kept up the furious gallop. It was Laveron who delivered the first blow to the long-time leader in the straight and, as the pair drew away, it looked to be between them. However, jockey Norman Richter was at work on Kapitol and she reponded well to close the gap before hitting the front with 150 yards remaining and going away to comfortably record her first stakes success.

KENTUCKY FALL YEARLINGS KICKS OFF

TODAY Fasig-Tipton's two-day sale of Kentucky Fall Yearlings gets underway today, with 723 yearlings catalogued to go under the hammer at Newtown Paddocks in Lexington, Kentucky. Last year's sale saw 431 yearlings sell for a total of \$5,724,800, at an average of \$13,283. A daughter of Storm Cat topped the 1999 sale with a bid of \$925,000. Among the leading sires represented this year are A.P. Indy, Carson City, Cozzene, Dixieland Band, Dynaformer, Kingmambo, Kris S., Meadowlake, Miswaki, Mt. Livermore, Phone Trick, Polish Numbers, Red Ransom, Saint Ballado, Storm Cat, Theatrical (Ire), Unbridled, Wild Again and Woodman. Leading freshman sires Gold Fever, Hennessy, Honour and Glory, Maria's Mon and Storm Creek have youngsters from their second crop on offer, while first-year stallions Boston Harbor (Capote), Pulpit (A.P. Indy), Siphon (Brz) (Itajara {Brz}) and Spinning World (Nureyev) are also represented. The sale begins today at 10 a.m. and continues Tuesday at the same time.

TATTERSALLS PACKED WITH TALENT The Tattersalls Autumn Horses-In-Training Sales, the largest auction of its type in the world, begins in Newmarket at 9:15 a.m. today with high expectations for what is a flourishing sector of the market. American buyers can be expected to be out in force, but they are likely to be competing with British and Irish jumping trainers for some of the better lots. Highclere Thoroughbred Racing, the highly-successful ownership syndicate, offers an attractive draft that looks to be headed by Lot 1019, the highly-promising juvenile Atmospheric (USA) (Irish River {Fr}), the winner of two Listed races who looks set to recoup the \$100,000 he cost as a yearling with some interest. Lots from Sir Michael Stoute's stable often do well and the Royal Hunt Cup winner Caribbean Monarch (Ire) (Fairy King {USA}), Lot 603, and the progressive three-year-old Rudik (USA) (Nureyev {USA}), Lot 626, will be popular. The staying threeyear-old Riddlesdown (Ire) (Common Grounds {GB}), Lot 898, has some high-class form. Similar comments apply to his stablemate from Sean Woods's yard, Going Global (Ire) (Bob Back {USA}), Lot 850, who was beaten in a photo for the G3 Lingfield Derby Trial in May. There is a blue-blooded draft from Aidan O'Brien's Ballydoyle stable that includes Lot 188, Lermontov (USA) (Alleged {USA}), who finished second in last year's G1 Racing Post Trophy.
