

MCCARRON READY TO CALL IT A CAREER

Jockey Chris McCarron, a two-time Eclipse Award winner who was elected to racing's Hall of Fame in

1989, will ride his last race June 23 at Hollywood Park. The 47year-old rider began breaking the news of his imminent retirement to those close to him last week. Born in Dorchester, Massachusetts, McCarron rode his first winner at Marvland's Bowie Racetrack on Feb. 9, 1974. He ended the season with a thenrecord 546 victories and earned an Eclipse as the country's leading apprentice. The red-headed reinsman, who shifted his tack to Southern California in 1978, picked up a second Eclipse in McCarron Takes Kentucky 1980, becoming only the third rider in history to win the award as both an apprentice and a journeyman (Steve Cauthen and Kent

Desormeaux also accomplished the feat). During his 28 years in the saddle, McCarron has won 7,137 races (through Friday) to rank sixth in career victories and is the all-time leading rider by earnings, winning more than \$264 million in purses. He won the Kentucky Derby, the Preakness and the Belmont S. twice each, and has nine Breeders' Cup races to his credit, including five Classics. "About 10 days ago, I told my wife Judy that this would be my last year," an emotional McCarron said in a press conference at Hollywood Park. "I always said that when I stopped having fun, when I stopped feeling the thrill of winning, that I'd retire." McCarron, with his wife Judy and comedian Tim Conway, established the Don MacBeth Memorial Jockey Fund to raise money for injured riders and said he will remain active in the Fund. A racing analyst for NBC on the 1986 Breeders' Cup telecast while sidelined by a broken leg, McCarron could also pursue a new career in TV. "I want to stay in the game," he told Daily Racing Form.

EASY STREET

Godolphin's Street Cry (Ire) (Machiavellian) stayed in cruise control all the way down the long stretch at Churchill Downs to take the GI Stephen Foster H. Saturday afternoon. The dark bay had earned a reputation as something of a hanger in his first two seasons of racing, but has left that far, far behind in 2002. After opening his season with a facile romp at Nad al Sheba Feb. 28, the Irish-bred was ridden out to an easy victory in the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 23 and was sent off as the second choice to Congaree (Arazi) in his first start back. Away smoothly under Jerry Bailey, Street Cry settled just off the pace and moved up to challenge for the lead on the far turn. He swept to the front and strode home under a hand ride. "He's a much different horse than last year," said winning trainer Saeed bin Suroor. "The way he worked, the way he looked; also mentally, he's a different horse. I think if he stays nice and sound that we will have a good chance with him in the Breeders' Cup Classic." Congaree held the lead briefly at the quarter pole, but tired to sixth.

Winner of the G3 Prix de Fontainebleau, Denon was fourth as the favorite in the G3 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano in his final European start Aug. 15. Sent to the U.S. barn of trainer Bobby Frankel, the bay made an immediate impression when he rallied from midpack to register a one-length victory in the GI Hollywood Derby Nov. 25, but things had not gone so smoothly in two starts this season. Stretched to 12 furlongs for the first time, the colt was a troubled fifth in the GII San Luis Obispo H. at Santa Anita Feb. 16 and was last seen when a disappointing fifth-place effort in the GII San Luis Rey H. over a mile and a half Mar. 16. Rested off that effort and cutting back to a more comfortable distance, Denon was let go at odds of 7-1. Night Patrol took the early lead and was angled over to the inside where he took the field along through soft fractions while Denon tucked in behind the speed while saving all the ground. The pacesetter showed no signs of slowing down after six furlongs in 1:15, but the Frankel trainee edged closer on the turn, came out at midstretch to collar Night Patrol and inched clear. Favored Skipping closed willingly for third. "He did everything perfectly," commented winning rider Garrett Gomez. "When I moved him out turning for home, he wore the other horse down and that one got away with some soft fractions." He could go next in the GI United Nations at Monmouth July 6. strongly down the stretch to deny Chris McCarron and Bosque Redondo in the shadow of the wire. "People thought he got lucky in the Santa Anita H.," acknowledged winning trainer Bobby Frankel, "but now people will think he's a pretty good horse." As a three-yearold, Milwaukee Brew won the GII Ohio Derby, but he failed to get a win in four starts in 2001 and wasn't seen after July. He resurfaced in Frankel's care Feb. 10, finishing sixth to Valhol in the Whirlaway H., but loped home a four-length winner of the GI Santa Anita H. Mar. 2. Given a brief vacation, he was sent off as the favorite of nine runners. The Stronach colorbearer saved ground early just behind solid early fractions and angled to the outside approaching the stretch. Bosque Redondo and Momentum looked to have the race between them in midstretch, but Milwaukee Brew came rolling down the middle of the track and just got up in the final strides. "It's hard to make up ground on this track, but he came hard in the stretch," said Frankel. "I haven't seen anybody make up two lengths on a horse like Bosque Redondo in the last sixteenth." As for the five-year-old's schedule, Frankel explained, "After winning the Santa Anita H., Mr. Stronach wanted this horse for the Breeders' Cup. So we freshened him up for a summer campaign. The Hollywood Gold Cup [GI, July 14] will be next. At a mile and a guarter, he can be ridden a little more conservatively." Click here for the brisnet.com chart.

The leading distaff earner, Spain may not have that many more opportunities to add to her bankroll now that she is in foal to Storm Cat, but the bay mare took charge of a solid field yesterday to add \$204,228 to her bankroll. The 2000 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine won just once in nine starts last year, missing by just a head in her Distaff title defence Oct. 27 at Belmont. She started off slowly in 2002 as well, losing her first four starts, but got back on track with a victory in the GII Louisville Breeders' Cup H. on the eve of the Kentucky Derby, a win which took her earnings past that of fellow D. Wayne Lukas charge Serena's Song. Tucked into a ground-saving third by Jorge Chavez, Spain angled out five wide approaching the stretch and drew even with pacesetter With Ability in midstretch. She took charge passing the eighth pole and drew off to win going away. "I told Jorge to ride her like she's the best horse in the race, because she is the best horse," said Lukas. "Jorge waited and waited and then when he asked her, she took off. We'll look at the Molly Pitcher [GII, June 29, Monmouth] now as her next possible start." With Ability clung on stubbornly to the place spot, denying even-money Dancethruthedawn by a neck.

The versatile Adoration made it two straight in graded stakes with this determined effort. An eightlength maiden winner on the main track at Santa Anita Feb. 21, the bay filly got caught in a speed duel in the GI Santa Anita Oaks Mar. 9, finishing eighth. Switched to the turf, she came in second to the promising Carinae in a sprint Apr. 12, then stretched out to a mile on the Hollywood lawn May 4 and posted a front-running victory in the GIII Senorita S. Breaking from the outside, the second choice pressed the pace while four wide. Favored Saint Bernadette came through on the inside to take the lead turning for home, but Adoration surged past her in the final furlong for the win. "[Trainer] Dave Hofmans has done a wonderful job with this filly," said winning rider Garrett Gomez. "We're just trying to figure out the difference between the grass and the dirt. She settled behind the two horses in front of her like an old professional, like she had run 100 times. Then she came home nicely." Closing strongly for second was longshot Sister Girl Blues, whose only previous start had been a maiden win on the turf. Seeking Daylight took flight over the slop at Belmont, cruising home by daylight while posting a sprightly 1:46 1/5 for the mile and an eighth, just a few ticks off Secretariat's track record of 1:45 2/5. The dark bay had captured both of his starts at two, including an 8 1/4length allowance win at Aqueduct, but spent his threeyear-old season on the sidelines with a fractured cannon bone. An Edward Evans homebred, he returned from a 15-month hiatus with seventh at Gulfstream Feb. 27 and improved to second at Aqueduct Mar. 28. He caught a sloppy strip at the Big A Apr. 20 and rolled to a 5 1/4-length score, then tried stakes company for the first time, finishing a solid fourth in the GIII Westchester H. at Belmont May 8. Unhurried early as Dayton Flyer (Honour and Glory) and E Dubai (Mr. Prospector) set a solid pace, Seeking Daylight advanced along the inside on the turn and swung to the outside at the top of the lane. He glided past E Dubai, began to open up after a mile in 1:33.87 and was taken in hand in the final strides. "He did everything very easily," said winning rider Edgar Prado. "When I found a spot, you saw what happened: he just took off. He will only get better." Trainer Mark Hennig had always been high on the colt. "Unfortunately, he was hurt last year with the fractured cannon bone," he said. "I think he could have made some noise as a three-year-old." Hennig indicated that the July 6 GII Suburban H. A three-time winner in four starts in Britain, Distant Valley posted a head victory in the G2 Rockfel S. in her European finale last October. The bay made her U.S. debut after a seven-month layoff and just missed, tiring after setting the pace to finish a closeup third in a Churchill allowance test May 25. Stepping back into the stakes ranks in her second stateside appearance, she tracked the speedy Peace River Lady from third through the opening half, edged closer on the far turn, gained control as they raced into the stretch and opened it up late to win handily. "When we ran her in the Regret prep [May 25], she was a bit rank," said winning trainer Niall O'Callaghan. "We thought she needed to be eased back. Van Minister always gives an honest effort, as witnessed by his seven on-the-board finishes from his first eight starts. The lion's share of those efforts came against maiden claiming competition, including a second-place finish versus \$50,000 maidens over the Aqueduct main track Apr. 25 before finally breaking his maiden by 4 3/4 lengths over the local dirt May 15. The bay colt gave his connections something to think about in his latest June 1, his first try on the turf and first versus winners, when he came from off the pace to finish second by a neck at boxcar odds. Smoked Em (Smoke Glacken) set an easy pace over the soft going tracked by Miesque's Approval as Van Minister raced unhurriedly in last through the opening six furlongs. As the pacesetter gave way in upper stretch, Miesque's Approval inherited the lead, but could not withstand the late run of the winner, who flew down the center of the track to register the upset. "It got a little frustrating over the winter because we always wanted to try turf with him and we couldn't," winning trainer Carlos Martin commented. "He is just getting better and better. 

Grundlefoot came from midpack to record a welldeserved first graded-stakes victory in vesterday's feature at Pimlico. The bay pieced together a threerace winning skein last fall, all in stakes company, including a 5 1/4-length victory in the Walter Haight H. at Laurel Dec. 15. Sent to the Big Apple for his seasonal finale, he was sent off the 3-1 favorite in the 13-furlong GIII Gallant Fox H. Dec. 29, but the distance proved to be too much, as he tailed off to be a well-beaten sixth. Returned to action in the GIII W.D. Schaefer H. at Pimlico May 18, Grundlefoot tired to be fourth, but was nonetheless the second choice in the wagering here. He beat stable companion Grandera (Ire) by 3 1/4 lengths in the G3 Dubai City of Gold at Nad al Sheba Feb. 24 and that form holds up to the closest inspection. Hawkeve bids to become the fourth British-trained colt to win this since 1996, but must improve on his fifth in the G1 Singapore Airlines International Cup at Kranji May 11.

RACING INVOLVED IN MONEY LAUNDERING

SCANDAL British horseracing received another bodyblow yesterday as Operation Extend, the largest investigation in UK drugs law enforcement history, was linked to the sport. It was revealed that former jockey Graham Bradley, now a bloodstock agent, admitted last year that he had provided inside racing information to Brian Wright, the subject of an international arrest warrant. Bradley now faces a possible "warning off" by the Jockey Club, who will, in the words of Senior Steward Christopher Spence, "look at what further measures are necessary to increase the effectiveness of the regulation of racing." The revelation was disclosed on Friday when the trials into the drug smuggling, which had spanned a period of several months, had reporting restrictions lifted. Bradley, a close friend of Wright, had passed on sensitive information alongside Barrie Wright-who is no relation--in exchange for money and other forms of reward. Spence told the Racing Post: "It was a long time ago, but we are still vulnerable, and I hope the message that we get across will be that we must be increasingly vigilant. Ultimately, I would hope people will be a little more understanding and realise that every barrel has its bad apples."
