RETIREMENT ON ICE FOR BADGE OF SILVER?

Reports of his retirement may have been premature. After **Badge of Silver** (Silver Deputy)'s eighth-place effort in the Nov. 26 GI Cigar Mile H., it was assumed the now six-year-old would retire to his owners' Ramsey Farm in Kentucky. But a win in yesterday's GI



San Gabriel H. at Santa Anita may have further postponed those plans. Winner of last year's GI New Orleans H., Badge of Silver was making his turf debut in the San Gabriel. With Pat Valenzuela aboard, the dark bay went right to the lead and was allowed to set pedestrian frac-

tions of :23.57, :49.45 and 1:14.11 over a rain-softened turf labeled good. As a host of challengers moved closer turning for home, Badge of Silver easily kicked clear for a 2 1/2-length win. "[Trainer] Bobby [Frankel] had him plenty ready and he knew his action was good on the turf," explained Valenzuela. "He said, 'He'll run good. Don't worry. Just ride him with confidence.' And that's exactly what I did." **Cont. p2**

BARBARO KEEPS ON WINNING

Heavily favored **Barbaro** (Dynaformer) kept his unbeaten streak in tact with a dominating 3 3/4-length victory in yesterday's GI Tropical Park Derby at Calder Race Course. The Lael Stables homebred colt charged to an 8 1/2-length debut win over the Delaware turf Oct. 4 and was equally dominant in his stakes debut, winning the Nov. 19 Laurel Futurity by eight lengths.

Testing the waters in graded stakes company yesterday, Barbaro sat a stalking second before forging to the lead in upper stretch and powering clear to his third win. "We got a perfect trip, but regardless of that, I could have been anywhere in the race I wanted to be and still would have won," said victorious rider Edgar Prado. "I watched his first two races and I was impressed. Now, after riding him, I'm even more impressed. He was much the best and he can be any kind of horse." Barbaro may have a future on the main track, according to trainer Michael Matz. "He's obviously a very talented horse," Matz said. "Whether he carries the class he shows on turf over to dirt, we just don't know yet, but his mother and [stakes-winning] half brother [Holy Ground] ran well on the dirt." **Click for brisnet.com chart. The **San Gabriel** was Frankel's 821st career win at Santa Anita, second only to Charlie Whittingham's 869 victories. FAMILIAR FACES TOP '05 LEADERS' LISTS

Todd Pletcher, John Velazquez and Michael Gill once again topped the lists of leading trainers, jockeys and owners by North American earnings in 2005, according to statistics released yesterday by Equibase Company LLC. All three also topped their respective categories in 2004. During 2005, Pletcher saddled 257 winners from 1,039 starters and established a new North American single-season earnings record of \$20,867,842. Rounding out the list of top 10 trainers by earnings were: Steve Asmussen, Richard

Dutrow, Jr., Doug O'Neill, Bill Mott, Scott Lake, Nick Zito, Bob Baffert and Jeff Mullins. Velazquez, who won 250 races from 1,147 mounts, led the jockeys' list with earnings of \$20,799,923. The top 10 list of jockeys was completed by Edgar Prado, Jerry Bailey, Rafael Bejarano, Garrett Gomez, Javier Castellano, Pat Valenzuela, Victor Espinoza, Cornelio Velasquez and Ramon Dominguez. For the third consecutive year, Gill topped the North American leading owners' list with earnings of \$6,397,180 and 351 victories from 1,870 races. Melnyk Racing Stables, Inc. was second on the list, followed by Live Oak Plantation, Stronach Stables, Robert Bone, Mr and Mrs William K Warren, Jr., Mr and Mrs Jerome S Moss, Phipps Stable, Robert and Beverly Lewis and Buckram Oak Farm.

Comacina came back after a 9 1/2-month layoff to take a Monmouth allowance test July 20, but tired to be seventh against Saratoga allowance company Aug. 24. After rebounding with a half-length tally in the Sept. 18 Blue Sparkler S. at the Jersey Shore, the bay shipped to Keeneland for the Oct. 22 Gil Raven Run S. Adding Lasix, she was off to a rough start and never got untracked, finishing fifth. The Flying Zee Stables colorbearer was freshened off that effort and made her first start for trainer Carlos Martin here. Let go at double-digit odds, Comacina went right to the front and held on all the way to the wire to get the narrow decision. "The last time, when she ran in the Raven Run, she got grabbed and got a big gash in her ankle," Martin explained. "She had a hole the size of a half dollar in her leg. It took three weeks to heal up. I didn't think we were going to make this race, but she worked so good that she showed me she was ready. She trained super leading up to this. I am very happy that we have her for the winter." The winner will be pointed for the Feb. 4 Correction H.
