JUST ANOTHER MAGIC MONDAY

The Conrad Jupiters Magic Millions 2006 Yearling Sale concluded four select sessions Sunday with spectacular results, and action during the first of three open sessions Monday continued to show strength. Leading the way was hip 893, a filly by Sequalo (Aus) who was knocked down to local trainer Alan Bailey for A\$210,000. Bailey, who signed the ticket under Magic Bloodstock, came out on top after a prolonged duel with Ron Maund,

who was representing Lauriston Thoroughbred Farm. Bailey is familiar with the family of the top lot; he trains the filly's half brother Willy Leica (Aus) (Latarmiss {Ire}), a stakes winner who has twice placed at the group level. Bailey said he was instructed to buy the chestnut at any cost, but admitted he didn't think he'd have to go that high. "The buyer really liked the breeding and he was going to buy her no matter what," he said. "He didn't expect it would be that much for her, but anyhow, that's what happens. The breeding was just what we wanted and she's the complete filly." The sale was easily the best ever for the consignor, Terry Catip's Misty Downs Stud. "Our previous best was around A\$100,000," said Catip, adding, "The amount of interest since she's hit the deck here has been enormous. Everyone's looked at her. She was out of her box so often that she's now footsore. I thought she might have pulled A\$100,000 or so, and I was hoping for a good result. It made up for some of the bad ones."

Falvelon Colt Brings \$200,000...

Topping the colts Monday was hip 812, a son of crack sprinter and young sire Falvelon (Aus) who was purchased by the Greg Grant Saddlery Trading Co. for A\$200,000. The colt is out of the Success Express mare Fantessa (Aus), a half-sister to a pair of stakes winners. Craigow Stud, agent, consigned the day's second-highest-priced yearling. ANOTHER BC CHAMP BEATEN IN ARCADIA

Two days after GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile hero Stevie Wonderboy settled for second in the GII San Rafael S., GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies winner **Folklore** (Tiznow) went down to defeat, tiring to be third behind stablemate **Dance Daily** (Five Star Day) and **Talullah Lula** (Old Trieste) in the GII Santa Ynez S. at Santa Anita. "In Folklore's defense, she was coming off a long layoff on three works and I think she got a little late right there at the end, but she'll be back," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas, who also sent out the winner. The entry was bet down to 1-10, but Dance Daily might have been 20-1 on her own. An allowance winner at Keeneland in October, she was off the board against stakes foes in her next three, most recently running sixth in the off-the-turf Blue Norther S. Jan. 1. The chestnut, supplemented to the race for \$3,000, tracked front-running Folklore through the opening splits, drove to the lead inside the eighth pole and held on by the bob of the head. "I thought she'd make a little bit of noise in the race," Lukas said. "The other day when she ran, she didn't like the track at all--it was wet and she struggled every step of the way." The many admirers of Unbridled will have enjoyed Saturday's graded-stakes events. At Louisiana Downs, the GIII Silverbulletday S. was won in very courageous fashion by Baghdaria, a Royal Academy filly produced by Unbridled's speedy daughter Oatsee. Then, over at Santa Anita, Unbridled's son Unbridled Song supplied the winner of another valuable prize when Unbridled Energy took the GII San Fernando Breeders' Cup S.

This dual success rather prompts the question of whether it is Unbridled's stallion sons which are making the greater impact, or his broodmare daughters?

Judged on Unbridled's own results, the sons and daughters should be enjoying success on a similar scale. In 10 years at stud, divided between Gainesway and Claiborne, Unbridled sired a dozen Grade I winners, made up of six colts, one gelding and five fillies. His six Grade II winners divided evenly between the sexes and fillies were well represented among Unbridled's total of 43 stakes winners.

Up till now, though, it has been Unbridled's sons which have made the greater impact at stud, thanks in no small part to the fact that they have far more foals of racing age than their female counterparts. Unbridled's Song and Grindstone between them had over 750 foals of racing age to the end of last year, whereas Unbridled's daughters had only 291 named foals of racing age.

Although Grindstone sired the excellent Birdstone, Unbridled's Song has been easily the best advertisement so far for Unbridled as a sire of sires. His 15 Northern Hemisphere graded winners, which include the Grade I scorers Buddha, Unbridled Elaine, Splendid Blended, Songandaprayer and Marylebone, represent more than three percent of his output.

It is worth pointing out though that only three of Unbridled's six Grade I-winning colts are old enough to have had runners, the other being the short-lived Anees, who sired a couple of classy performers in Coin Silver and Along the Sea. Next in line are the GI Preakness S. winner Red Bullet, the GI Belmont S. hero Empire Maker and the GI Pimlico Special H. winner Eddington, who will shortly start his bid to step into his sire's shoes at Claiborne. Red Bullet, who represents the same Unbridled-Caro cross as Unbridled's Song, will have his first runners this year, while Empire Maker, who has received tremendous support from breeders, will surely create a stir when his first yearlings sell later this year.

Some of Unbridled's sons which didn't manage to win at Grade I level are also well worth keeping an eye on. Broken Vow made a bright start last year for a horse who didn't himself race at two, coming up with 13 first-crop juvenile winners headed by the dual Grade II winner Private Vow. Then there's the very well-bred Saarland, who covered 120 mares in his first season last year, and Malabar Gold, who has his first runners this year.

As I said earlier, Unbridled's daughters--the eldest of them now 13 years old--have nearly 300 foals of racing age to the end of last year, but Baghdaria is only the third of them to win at graded level. She follows Pulpit's son Tapit, a winner of the GIII Laurel Futurity at two and the GI Wood Memorial S. at three, and Thunder Gulch's daughter Better Now, who took the GIII Tempted S. last fall. I should add that nearly 90 of those 300 foals have just turned three, with Better Now and Baghdaria among them.

It is fair to expect this number of graded winners to escalate quite quickly as the number of broodmares by Unbridled approaches its peak. With Unbridled's youngest fillies now four years old, his daughters will soon be at maximum production, adding possibly as many as 150 foals to their tally each year.

Breeders would do well to remember that it generally takes a stallion a few years to build up a big enough sample of foals to assess his ability as a sire of broodmares. Take A.P. Indy as an example. Virtually everything about him says he is destined to become an important sire of broodmares, including the fact that he has been a prolific source of above-average racemares. He is also a son of Seattle Slew, a stallion who twice headed the annual broodmare sires' table. However, with under 250 foals of racing age, A.P. Indy's broodmare daughters have yet to catch fire. They have produced just four graded winners, none at Grade I level, but time is again likely to remedy this situation.

To get back to Unbridled's daughters, we shouldn't be surprised that the three daughters which have produced a graded winner were all talented track performers. Tapit's dam, Tap Your Heels, won the Hildene S. at two; Better Now's dam, Scenic Point, won a stakes and was placed at Grade II level; and Baghdaria's dam, Oatsee, was third in a \$100,000 stakes at four.

Baghdaria appeared in Book 7 of the 2004 Keeneland September Sale, as hip 4484, which reflects the fact that there were no graded winners or graded-placed horses listed under any of her first three dams.

However, her fourth dam, Taminette, had a very illustrious background. In addition to being a sister to the Classic-winning Known Fact, Taminette was a half-sister to Secrettame, the dam of Gone West and Lion Cavern, and to the very successful stallion Terete.

Taminette didn't let the side down, notably producing Tappiano, a triple Grade I winner at two, and her smart Japanese brother A.P. Jet. As Tappiano was by Fappiano, it is easy to understand why Fappiano's son Unbridled was selected for a descendant of Taminette.

Baghdaria also represents another feather in the cap of her underrated stallion Royal Academy. It is no doubt his reputation for being primarily a turf sire that has forced Royal Academy's fee as low as \$15,000, but Baghdaria shows that he can sire the occasional good dirt performer in addition to leading turf runners all over the globe.
