Major Success (Mazel Trick) came out on top in a three-way battle to the wire to take the GII Palos Verdes H. at Santa Anita vesterday afternoon. The fiveyear-old was a neck in front of Jet West (Western Fame), with 3-2 chalk Attila's Storm (Forest Wildcat) another head back in third. "I thought he was beat at the top of the stretch, but I saw him coming back," trainer Bobby Frankel said. "I don't usually root, but I rooted this time and he got it done." A \$200,000 FTFFEB purchase, Major Success started just twice as a juvenile, winning a two-turn test at Hollywood in November. He was one-for-two again at three, posting a nose decision in a Santa Anita allowance test in October, then was sidelined for another 10-month stretch. The dark bay was off the board in his first two outings last season, but got on track when dropped back to 6 1/2 panels, winning a pair of optional claimers at Hollywood Nov. 26 and Dec. 19. He didn't make his debut until June of his four-yearold season, but Happy Hunting has been beaten just once since breaking his maiden in the mud at Saratoga



Favored to extend his skein in his stakes debut, Happy Hunting settled back in second as Mr. Whitestone cut out a moderate pace. He moved to challenge after six furlongs, finally put that rival away inside the eighth pole and held Evening Attire at bay. "He's certainly going the right way," said Buzz Tenney, assistant to trainer Shug McGaughey. "It just took him a little while to get going." As for future plans, Tenney said, "He's going to go back to Florida. I don't know where he will run next." Veteran Evening Attire hesitated at the start and was last early, but closed well for second. "What are you going to do?," asked trainer Pat Kelly. "We've been working with him at the gate. He's old and he does what he wants to do. You just can't give these horses a head start, but he finished up great." Added his jockey, Jose Santos, "Nothing happened in the gate, he just likes the gate too much. He's got a bad habit now. If he breaks with the bunch, probably he wins."

EHV SPREADS TO PENN NATIONAL; PIMLICO UNDER QUARANTINE West End Lady, who raced at Laurel Park earlier this month before returning to her barn at Penn National, has tested positive for equine herpesvirus-1, it was reported yesterday. Trainer Todd Beattie had the mare tested after she exhibited symptoms of the disease, and shipped her off the Penn National grounds when the diagnosis was confirmed Friday. In the wake of the news, Philadelphia Park has banned all shippers from Penn National until further notice. "We don't have any problems right now, and we'd like to keep it that way," Philadelphia's Assistant Racing Secretary Nick Black told www.bloodhorse.com. Philly Park has already banned all shippers from Maryland, as has the New York Racing Association. Gulfstream Park and Palm Meadows will not allow horses on the grounds that have either raced or been stabled in Maryland since Jan. 1, while Penn National is restricting horses that have been in Maryland since Jan. 9. In addition, the Maryland Jockey Club has placed Pimlico Race Course under quarantine. "This is a precautionary measure," said Lou Raffetto, chief operating officer for the MJC. "It is in our best interest to restrict the movement in and out of Pimlico until we see the outcome of the tests on the horse in Barn A." A total of 11 horses have shown signs of the virus since Jan. 1, and two have been euthanized. A horse stabled in Barn A exhibited symptoms Thursday morning, with test results pending. More than 20 percent of the nearly 500 horses on the Pimlico backstretch are the subject of "investigational animal hold orders" because they may have been exposed to the virus.


NY ENACTS PRE-RACE 'MILKSHAKING' TESTS

The New York State Racing and Wagering Board voted Jan. 19 to adopt an emergency rule allowing for the collection of pre-race blood samples from horses entered into races at the state's Thoroughbred and harness tracks to test for excess alkalizing agents (milkshaking) that could affect the outcome of the race. The blood samples are sent to the Equine Drug Testing Program at Cornell University, where the laboratory detects and confirms the presence of elevated levels of total carbon dioxide [TCO2] in the horse's system. "It is important to ensure the betting public that horses that compete in pari-mutuel races in New York State have not been tampered with and that no advantage has been given to a horse chemically or otherwise," said Board Chairwoman Cheryl Buley. "New York continues to lead the way on substance and drug detection which reflects upon the integrity of this industry." For the complete story, click here.


