ECLIPSE CHAMPS HOLD THEIR WEIGHT

Recently crowned juvenile champions **Stevie Wonderboy** (Stephen Got Even) and **Folklore** (Tiznow) have received top weight assignments for their respective divisions in the 2005 Experimental Free Handicap, it was announced yesterday by The Jockey Club. The GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile hero led the way for colts and geldings, receiving 126 pounds, with **First Samurai** (Giant's Causeway) checking in second with 124 and **Henny Hughes** (Hennessy) third with

123. GI Hollywood Futurity winner **Brother Derek** (Benchmark), who defeated Stevie Wonderboy by 1 1/2 lengths in the GII San Rafael S., was assigned 121. Juvenile Fillies heroine Folklore was assigned high weight for fillies with 123. **Adieu** (El Corredor) recieved 122 and **Wild Fit** (Wild Wonder) 120.

GLITTER WOMAN DIES

Grade I winner **Glitter Woman** (Glitterman--Carols Folly, by Taylor's Falls) was euthanized Jan. 12 at Claiborne Farm in Paris, Kentucky due to complications of colic, according to published reports. The 12-year-old mare had foaled a Fusaichi Pegasus filly before colicking; the filly died three days later. A half-sister to GI Breeders' Cup Distaff heroine Unbridled Elaine, Glitter Woman placed in three graded stakes during her juvenile season in 1996. At three, she reeled off four straight victories in the GIII Forward Gal S., GIII Davona Dale S., GII Bonnie Miss S. and GI Ashland S. by a total of 32 1/2 lengths for owner Joseph Allen. The bay finished seventh as the favorite in the GI Kentucky Oaks, but exited the race with an ankle chip and was shelved for the remainder of the year. In 1998, she landed the GIII Sixty Sails H. and posted runner-up finishes in the GI Apple Blossom H. and GI Hempstead H. Glitter Woman made three starts at five, winning a Gulfstream allowance by 6 1/4 lengths before taking second in both the GII Rampart H. and Oaklawn Breeders' Cup H., and retired with a record of 23-10-9-3 and earnings of \$1,256,805. Her third foal, an Unbridled's Song colt named Political Force, ran second in the GIII Nashua S. in 2005. Glitter Woman produced a Pulpit filly in 2004, but slipped in 2005.

ALL 'HEART' IN THE DESERT

Heart Alone (Brz) (Music Prospector), winner of last year's G1 Gran Premio Major Suckow, gave jockey Michael Kinane his third win of the evening when he galloped away to an easy victory in the G3 Al Shindagha Sprint at Nad Al Sheba yesterday. Making his first start since being placed fifth through disqualification in the G2 Gran Premio Proclamacao da Republica Nov. 12, he was in front from the start and held the advantage all the way home, winning by 3 3/4 lengths over local hero **Conroy** (Gone West).

FIFTH AVENUE LOOKS TO REBOUND Fifth Avenue (Monarchos), off since finishing a distant sixth in the GI Matron S. at Belmont Sept. 17, looks to return to her winning ways in the Sunshine Millions Ocala Stud Oaks Saturday at Gulfstream Park. The \$90,000 OBSAUG yearling purchase began her career with two straight victories, including a maiden win over eventual champion Folklore. "We stopped on Fifth Avenue after the Matron," trainer Mark Hennig commented. "She had some shin problems and had a couple of unfortunate trips in her last two starts." After notching Belmont's Fashion S. in her second career start, Fifth Avenue went on to finish second behind Folklore in Saratoga's GII Adirondack S., before a pair of unplaced finishes in the GII Spinaway S. and the Matron.

"Hold Order" Placed on Kent County Stable:

The Maryland State Veterinarian placed an "investigational animal hold order" on a private farm in Kent County after cases of equine herpesvirus (EHV-1) appeared at the off-track training facility. The farm, which received a horse from Pimlico Jan. 10, was closed to ingoing and outgoing traffic. The Maryland Department of Agriculture is waiting for test results, which are expected next week, to determine the cause of illness for one horse euthanized yesterday morning and another showing neurologic signs of the disease. "This new occurrence is extremely unfortunate and we are working closely with everyone involved and using the best science available in the equine research community to prevent any possible spread of illness," said Maryland State Veterinarian Guy Hohenhaus. "It is believed that this incident is not a distinctly new case. We encourage horse owners with concerns to contact their private veterinarian to determine if a vaccination or booster is recommended for their horses at this time."

Herpesvirus Claims Another:

General Strike (Smart Strike), a three-year-old colt trained by Joe DeLozier, was euthanized Wednesday at Pimlico, just two days after he tested positive for the equine herpesvirus. The dark bay showed symptoms of the virus last Thursday and it was determined that recovery was unlikely. So far in 2006, 11 horses in Maryland have tested positive for the virus. Three horses have been euthanized thus far.

Laurel Cancels Two Sunday Cards:

Live racing at Laurel Park has been canceled Sunday, Jan. 29 and Sunday, Feb. 5, officials at the Maryland Jockey Club announced yesterday. Due to the outbreak of the equine herpesvirus, the Maryland racetrack has suffered a shortage of entries. "We are working with a limited pool of horses and it has taken its toll on our entries," said Chief Operating Officer Lou Raffetto. "Cutting back to four days a week the next two weeks will allow us to have the quality and quantity we were accustomed to before the outbreak of the virus."

Vague likely punched her ticket to the \$250,000 UAE 1000 Guineas Feb. 16 with a 1 1/2-length victory over seven furlongs. Ridden for speed, the bay assumed command with two furlongs to race and ran out a comfortable winner.

"The UAE 1,000 Guineas is definitely on the agenda," Dave Bradley, assistant to trainer Jeremy Nosedo, told *Racing Post*. "We rode her prominently as you are never sure about the kickback and she was idling in front. She has done it well, but we knew she was in good form as her work had been solid. We will see about the [Mar. 9] UAE Oaks after the Guineas." Second to La Chunga in the G3 Albany S. at the Royal meeting last June while racing for Mohammed Rashid bin Ghadayer, Vague was posting her second career victory from six starts.
