Winner of last summer's GIII Rancho Bernardo H. at Del Mar, the five-year-old was an uncharacteristically poor eighth in the GIII Thoroughbred Club of America S. at Keeneland Oct. 16, but came home a much improved second, beaten only 3/4-of a length, in a 6 1/2-furlong turf allowance over the Santa Anita sod Nov. 5. Back to the main for her latest, the mare was 4 1/2 lengths best in an allowance at Hollywood Park and was installed the 6-5 choice to record her first Grade I victory this time. As for the fillies' future, Baffert indicated that the filly will stick to sprinting. "I think that's [seven furlongs] as far as she wants to go with this caliber of horses. 

Rehoboth (Wagon Limit), an impressive 3 3/4-length winner of a 6 1/2-furlong Gulfstream allowance Jan. 14, will make his next start in the GIII Holy Bull S. at Gulfstream Feb. 4. "He's going in the Holy Bull because he's always been a horse that looked like he'd like a route of ground," said trainer Frank Gomez, explaining his decision to bypass the 7 1/2-furlong GII Hutcheson S. in favor of the nine-panel Holy Bull. Also with GI Florida Derby aspirations, **Reaffirmed** (Quaker Ridge), winner of last year's Continental Mile S. at Monmouth Park Sept. 4, may make his next start in the Hutcheson S. "We're going to take a good look at it," said trainer Joe Orseno. "We've been working him at Palm Meadows [most recently with a half-mile work in :48 1/5 Jan. 21] and he's been training well." After that, we just decided to give him some time off, so he's been freshened up and is ready to try again."
