### **BARBARO POINTING TO FLORIDA DERBY**

Undefeated Barbaro (Dynaformer) will make his next start in the \$1-million GI Florida Derby at Gulfstream

Park Apr. 1, according to Daily Racing Form. Winner of the GIII Tropical Park Derby on the Calder turf Jan. 1, the bay handled a sloppy track in capturing the GIII Holy Bull S. Feb. 4. Trainer Michael Matz had been considering the Mar. 4 GII Fountain of Youth S. as an option for his charge. "The way it stands now, Barbaro Equi-Photo we'll wait for the Florida Derby," Matz



told DRF. "His races have been scheduled five and six weeks apart all the time; he's already had two races at a mile and one-eighth, and I felt that if, God willing, we make it to the Kentucky Derby, I'd like to go in with the freshest horse possible." Matz said that he discussed the situation with Edgar Prado, who rode the colt for the first time in the Holy Bull. "I spoke with Edgar and said, 'If you feel like he needs the experience, let me know,' and he agreed he'd rather go in with a fresh horse," he explained. "So many horses this time of year are trying to play catch-up, and I feel like we're lucky to be in the spot we're in. I'm new at this thing, but I just feel it's the best way to go."

### DESORMEAUX HEADING EAST

Hall of Fame jockey Kent Desormeaux, one of the leading riders in Southern California, will take his tack to the East Coast, according to Daily Racing Form. The 35-year-old rider indicated that he would begin with a brief stint at Gulfstream Park at the end of March before heading to New York. "I really believe the pendulum has switched to the East," Desormeaux told DRF. "When I moved to California they had the best racing, but right now there are way more opportunities and much more money available in the East, and if I want to be a champion jockey I have to use my skills where those opportunities are most readily available." One of the factors was Jerry Bailey's recent retirement. "I realize there are some very good riders in New York, like Johnny Velazguez, Edgar Prado, and several others, but with Jerry gone, there is a void there, and I'm hoping I can come in and achieve the kind of business my status deserves," Desormeaux added.

### Son of Sunday Silence Makes U.S. Bow:

Silent Name (Jpn) (Sunday Silence), born in the Far East but raced exclusively in France, makes his first North American appearance in the \$80,000 Daytona H. going 6 1/2 furlongs down the hill at Santa Anita this afternoon. The four-year-old colt has won three of his 10 career starts, including two listed stakes at Deauville last summer. Fourth in the G1 Prix de la Foret, the Wertheimer et Frere homebred was sixth in the Oct. 30 G3 Prix Perth last time out. The bay has been working well for his U.S. debut, most recently firing a bullet six furlongs in 1:12 3/5 at Hollywood Feb. 12. Trainer Gary Mandella takes over for Christiane Head-Maarek. Silent Name faces Silent Lure (Joyeux Danseur), who is threefor-four over this course and distance; Richebourg (Lear Fan), who made it two-for-three with an optional-claiming score Jan. 12; and GIII Morvich H. hero Geronimo (Chi) (Gold Tribute), third while beaten less than a length in a money allowance at a mile Jan. 20.

### Purse Hike for Big 'Cap Day:

For the second year in a row, the purses on the nonstakes races on the undercard of the GI Santa Anita H. will be boosted \$15,000 each. There are seven nonstakes events scheduled for the Mar. 4 program. The purse increase is a cooperative effort of the California Marketing Committee, the Thoroughbred Owners of California and Santa Anita Park. "What we are doing, thanks to the CMC and the TOC, is pumping up our overnight purses with the belief that mutuel handle will increase substantially," said Santa Anita Racing Secretary Rick Hammerle. "The response from horsemen and the public last year was overwhelming and we were able to come up with one of the best cards of the entire year. It worked so well that everyone agreed we should do it again." The total handle on Big 'Cap day last year was \$22,675,695, up more than \$1.1 million from 2004.

### CHRB Moves to Require Synthetic Surfaces:

The California Horse Racing Board has approved a proposed rule to require a Polytrack-like (synthetic) surface at the major Thoroughbred tracks in California by the end of 2007. The rule, proposed by CHRB Chairman Richard B. Shapiro and approved unanimously by the seven racing commissioners, reads, "As a condition to license, any track that operates four weeks (or more) of continuous Thoroughbred racing in any calendar year must install a polymer, synthetic-type racing surface by no later than Dec. 31, 2007." Before the rule can be adopted, a 45-day period of public notice for input from the industry must pass, followed by a public hearing. The five tracks which would be affected are Bay Meadows, Del Mar, Golden Gate Fields, Hollywood Park and Santa Anita Park. Installing a synthetic surface is estimated to cost \$6 million and \$9 million per track. Shapiro has offered the Board's assistance in finding ways to reduce the financial burden on individual racetracks. "We must look at funds now being used by the industry for other purposes, and we might require legislation to seek financial assistance," said Shapiro. "Whatever is needed, we should start now."




