FORWARD GAL'S CAN'T 'MISS' PROSPECT

Longshot **Miraculous Miss** (Mr. Greeley) lost her unbeaten record struggling home fifth in a sloppy renewal of the GIII Old Hat S. Feb. 4, but made amends for that effort with a rousing last-to-first victory in the GII Forward Gal S. at Gulfstream Sunday afternoon. "I had a pretty good trip," admitted Jeremy Rose, who was aboard the 18-1 bomb. "They went pretty fast the first part of it, so at about the five-sixteenths pole, I just swung around all the horses in front of me. I

thought I had enough horse to make it...and she did fine." It was the second graded win for the three-year-old filly, who won the GIII Valley Stream S. last November. CHECK 'MATE' IN BONNIE MISS ROMP

Joseph Allen's homebred **Teammate** (A.P. Indy), making just her second start in stakes company, was treated with Lasix for the first time and responded with an impressive wire-to-wire romp in yesterday's GII Bonnie Miss S. at Gulfstream Park. The win came at the expense of even-money favorite **Wait a While** (Maria's Mon), who was rank in the early going and who, after failing to match strides with the winner down the lane, was nipped for the place spot by

Wonder Lady Anne L (Real Quiet). Teammate was coming off a 14-length runner-up effort to Wait a While in the GII Davona Dale S. over a sloppy Gulfstream track Feb. 4, but emerged from that race with an excuse. "Last time it was muddy, and she was behind a lot of dirt," said winning trainer Allen Jerkens. "We put her on Lasix because we thought it would help her a little bit. [S]he bled just a little amount, but we figured next time it could be much worse." **Cont. p2**

Redemption in Forward Gal...

A \$350,000 purchase at last year's Fasig-Tipton Midlantic juvenile sale in May, **Miraculous Miss** won in her debut four months later, taking a Delaware maiden Sept. 19. She annexed an allowance at that course Oct. 17, then prevailed as a 9-1 longshot in the Valley Stream Nov. 20. Given a 5-2 chance to succeed in her seasonal bow in the Feb. 4 GIII Old Hat S. at Gulfstream, she could do no better than fifth over the rain-soaked surface, a loss trainer Steve Klesaris attributes to the conditions. "There's no doubt it was the track last time," he said after yesterday's win. "We felt confident to go in this one knowing she'd be able to come from off the pace with [nine] horses in front of her." Let go at 18-1 yesterday, she caboosed the field through a half in :44 2/5, then came calling with a powerful run that propelled her past the game favorite **India**. "We'll possibly look at the [GII] Comely S. [one mile at Aqueduct Apr. 15]," said Klesaris, who owns the winner with Puglisi Stables, his main client. "As far as her best distance, we don't know that yet. She's picked up another furlong every race, except for the slop race, and she's answered the bell every time."

New Tactics for Teammate...

Teammate faced the starter three times before breaking her maiden in her route debut at Calder Dec. 11, winning an off-the-turfer by 8 3/4 lengths. A hard-fought head winner in a one-mile Gulfstream allowance Jan. 13, she posed no threat to Wait a While in a sloppy renewal of the GII Davona Dale S. and was aiming for another crack at that foe here. Hustled to the front under Cornelio Velasquez--the first time she'd been put on the lead--Teammate clicked off even :23 4/5, :48, and 1:12 splits, then just kept on motoring down the lane as Wait a While gave futile chase. The change in tactics was not by design, according to trainer Allen Jerkens. "I didn't think she'd be on the lead, but I didn't tell Cornelio [jockey Velasquez] what to do," said the Hall of Famer. "I left it up to him." As for the future, Jerkens commented, "It looks like she'll go a distance. Of course, these fillies don't have to go much farther in distance in the big races. I have no idea what might be next. I would prefer the [GI] Acorn S. Technically, the state veterinarian [Dr. Gary Beck] made a note of it and put him on the injured list, but it’s anything but.

It was just a mild little thing and not a problem at all. It won’t cost him any time.” Hendricks added that Brother Derek, who went off the favorite in Pool Two of the Kentucky Derby Future Wager, would “take it easy for a couple weeks, then have a couple of breezes and be ready to run.”

Sweetnorthernstaint (Sweetsourthernstaint), winner of the Feb. 4 Miracle Wood S. at Laurel, worked six furlongs in 1:12 at Laurel Sunday morning, and according to trainer Mike Trombetta, the colt may make his next start in the GIII Gotham S. at Aqueduct Mar. 18. "He worked very well," said Trombetta. "I put him in with one of my older horses so he'd be a little more aggressive in the work. He hasn't run in a while, so we needed to do a little more with him." To ship to New York, Sweetnorthernstaint must receive the Ok from New York Racing Association's Chief Examining Veterinarian Dr. Anthony Verderosa. "We're waiting to hear more results from Bowie and Pimlico, where the last four positives are located," Verderosa said. Verderosa indicated that more information on the situation would be available next week.
