LOOKING TO MAINTAIN HER BALANCE

Possessed of a pedigree more likely to excel on the turf, **Balance** (Thunder Gulch) has nevertheless made a name for herself on the main track and looks to continue on the road to the first Friday in May in this afternoon's GI Santa Anita Oaks.

Indeed, the attractive bay filly made her first two starts on the grass and would have been perfect on that surface if not for a questionable demotion in the Hidden Lite S. Oct. 2. In the absence of turf racing in the fall at Hollywood, she made her next start on the dirt, winning the Sharp Cat S. Nov. 27, but was upset by 39-1 **Diplomat Lady** (Forestry) in the GI Hollywood Starlet S. the following month. The 5-2 second choice behind **Wild Fit** (Wild Wonder) in the GI Las Virgenes S. Feb. 11,

Balance took advantage of her tactical speed, got first run and held off the rallying Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies runner-up to win by a length. "She was just perfect," jockey Victor Espinoza said following the victory. "I was looking for Wild Fit, but I still had a lot of horse under me. She acts like I can do anything with her." Wild Fit should be tighter for this and runs no matter the track condition. "It's a Grade I...so we've got to go," trainer Patrick Biancone commented.

ADDICTION AT A HEALTHY MUTUEL

In three previous tries at Grade I level, **Healthy Addiction** (Boston Harbor) couldn't quite measure up, but yesterday the five-year-old mare got over that obstacle, leading past every pole to take the GI Santa Margarita H. Sixth in last year's GI Vanity H. at Hollywood, the dark bay went on a three-race winning streak thereafter, capped by a half-length victory in this track's GII Lady's Secret BC H. Oct. 2. Last of 13 in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff at the end of that month, she was rested, returning to annex the Jan. 19 Paseana S. But she found Grade I waters a touch too deep in her latest, weakening to fourth in the Feb. 11 Santa Maria H. Dismissed at a very inviting 8-1 this time around, **Healthy Addiction** outsprinted the field to the first turn, setting a strong pace over the off going. Well clear turning for home, she began to drift late, but stayed on nicely for the win. "She handled the track really well," commented winning rider Jon Court. "Actually, I was surprised to be in front. I got the lead and I was able to dictate the pace."

Stabled last year at the Hot Springs track, Round Pond won three of her four starts, including the Honeybee S. and the GII Fantasy S. After electing to pass on the GI Kentucky Oaks, the Fox Hill runner shipped to New York to post a 1 1/2-length victory in the GI Acorn S. June 4, but she was runner-up in a sloppy renewal of the GII Delaware Oaks July 16 and emerged from that race with a bone chip in her left knee. Bet down to 1-2 for her seasonal debut in a six-furlong Oaklawn allowance Feb. 16, she posted a very sharp 2 3/4-length victory and was the odds-on chalk in her return to graded company. "Both fillies really ran a game race," said jockey Stewart Elliott, who weighed in two pounds overweight. Round Pond was in receipt of four pounds from Happy Ticket. "We just matched stride for stride and when we hit the stretch, both fillies kicked it in and gave it all they had. Near the wire, the other filly got just a little ahead of us, but my filly came back and hit the wire first. She just wanted it!"

Kazoo was claimed for \$75,000 out of a winning effort at the Big A Apr. 1, then finished a well-beaten fifth in the GIII Bold Ruler H. at Belmont May 7. Freshened up after that effort, the chestnut resurfaced at the Jersey Shore and came a home a game third in the Mr. Prospector S. July 3 and followed up with a victory in a \$75,000 optional claimer over that course Sept. 18.

Placed on the sidelines again, the eight-year-old returned in a \$75,000 optional tagger at the Big A Feb. 8 and reported home second under the line after contesting quick fractions of :22, :44 4/5 and :56 4/5. Gunned from the one-hole with Richie Migliore in the irons here, Kazoo rattled off :22 and :44 3/5 splits and drew off impressively in the stretch to post his first graded stakes tally. "He's had some feet problems and some quarter cracks here and there," IEAH Stables' Mike Sherack explained. "We wanted to get him 100 percent for this race. We haven't really looked ahead yet with this horse. He's got some pedigree. Maybe we'll get a shot at making him a stallion."

Purchased for a mere A\$1,250, Takeover Target completed the Flemington Group 1 sprint treble, adding this to his victories in the 2004 Salinger S. and last month's Lightning S., the first leg of the Global Sprint Challenge. Spotting his rivals from four to 17 pounds, the veteran raced without cover throughout, but kept finding late and caught G1 Oakleigh Plate winner Snitzel in the waning strides. "They had him off the bit at the 500 metres and he was labouring a little bit but as soon I clicked him up he found that extra gear and just kept going all the way to the line," winning jockey Jay Ford told AAP. In two of their three previous meetings, Apache Cat got the better of God's Own, leaving trainer and former Olympic equestrian Greg Eurell a bit perplexed. Coming off a victory over his rival in the G3 Schweppes Cup at Caulfield Feb. 25, when torrential rains rendered the going very heavy, Apache Cat was dismissed at odds of 7-1, but led every step of the way under a heady ride from Noel Callow, who was winning this for the second year in a row. For Eurell, the thrill of victory trumped his Olympic experience. "I was fortunate enough to compete at the 1984 Olympics but to win a Group One race is even better," he told AAP. "It's an enormous thrill." God's Own pulled out for the drive, but could make no impact late, finishing fifth. Trainer Bart Cummings, yet to win this event, congered up an excuse for the 9-5 favorite. "It seems to be a leaders' track," Cummings said. "He was disappointing but I can't understand the way the track was racing."

NYRA to Allow Maryland Shippers:

The New York Racing Association will allow horses to ship to its tracks from Maryland beginning Saturday, Mar. 18. NYRA had banned horses from that jurisdiction dating back to the first of the year, when a horse tested positive for equine herpesvirus (EHV-1) and was euthanized. "We also want to make it clear that any horse that ships from New York to Maryland will have to meet these requirements in order come back," said Dr. Anthony Verderosa, chief examining veterinarian for NYRA. "Basically they will be treated as if they originated in Maryland." The requirements are as follows:

- A 48-hour health certificate with each horse(s) temperature clearly written.
- Proof of vaccination against EHV-1 no less than seven days and no more than 90 days prior to arrival with the vaccination date clearly written on the health certificate by the issuing veterinarian.
- A statement by the issuing veterinarian that each horse has NOT originated from a barn with an active EHV-1 infection.
- NYRA reserves the right to change this policy if conditions warrant.

The decision likely means that the impressive **Sweetnorthern**saint (Sweetsouthernsaint), winner in his last start of the Miracle Wood S. at Laurel Feb. 4, will make the trip for Saturday's GIII Gotham S. Trainer Mike Trombetta has tabbed Kent Desormeaux to ride. **Celestial Legend** (City Zip), a perfect six-for-six in her career, will also ship in for the GIII Cicada S. over six furlongs the same afternoon.

Greeley's Legacy Preps for Gotham:

Donald Flanagan's **Greeley's Legacy** (Mr. Greeley) breezed five furlongs over the Belmont training track yesterday morning in 1:01.68 as he prepares for his stakes debut in the Gotham.
