BARBARO RULES THE DAY

Lael Stables' homebred **Barbaro** (Dynaformer) had some questions to answer in yesterday's GI Florida Derby. Could he handle a fast main track? Could he overcome a wide draw? Could he head to Louisville a

perfect five-for-five? How about a two-month hiatus? Yes. Yes. Yes. And yes. The well-built dark bay hounded pacesetting **Sharp Humor** (Distorted Humor), last-out winner of the GII Swale S., through reasonable fractions and willed himself to the line, defeating the hard-knocking New York-bred by a half-length. "I think he's a good horse," said winning trainer Michael Matz, in

easily the biggest understatement of the millennium. As for the immediate future, "We'll keep him here about a week or so, and then probably go to Keeneland, probably work once there, and then go to Churchill [Downs]."

Turf a Logical Starting Point...

By the noted turf sire Dynaformer and out of a mare who was twice graded-stakes placed on the grass, Barbaro began his career on the green stuff, winning his maiden by 8 1/2 lengths at Delaware Oct. 14, the Laurel Futurity by eight Nov. 19 and the Jan. 1 GIII Tropical Park Derby by 3 3/4 lengths at Calder. After mulling over his options, Matz decided to see if his charge belonged on the Triple Crown trail and Barbaro gave him the answer he was looking for, taking a sloppy renewal of the GIII Holy Bull S. by 3/4 of a length Feb. 4.

An Unorthodox Preparation...

Given two months off ahead of this, Matz opened himself to criticism, but, yesterday, let the horse do the talking. Away in a bit of a tangle, Barbaro bumped slightly with **Charming Image** (Halo's Image), but recovered and raced just outside of Sharp Humor, who got

an opening quarter in :23.45 and a half in :47.35. The two raced nearly inseparably through the next two furlongs in :24.02 and had it to themselves as the quarter pole loomed. For a second, it looked as if Sharp Humor would outstay the favorite, but Barbaro kept to his work and was

along in the final strides. "I saw Sharp Humor break sharp, so I just followed him," said winning rider Edgar Prado. "He [Barbaro] was pretty much in control of the race. So far this is my Derby horse. We'll see how he comes back over the next couple of days and make a decision from there." Prado had previously ridden First Samurai and is expected to pilot Strong Contender in the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Apr. 15. Also expected to go on to the Derby are **Sunriver** (Saint Ballado) and seventh-place finisher **Flashy Bull** (Holy Bull).

Winner of the GIII Iselin BC H. at Monmouth last August, the dark bay was fifth in the sloppy Empire Classic at Belmont Oct. 22 and second by a neck in this track's GIII Stuyvesant H. and GIII Queens County H. Honey Ryder proved that she will be a force to be reckoned with in the Turf Distaff division with a comprehensive victory here. The defending champion of this event, the gray added scores in the Robert G. Dick BC H. at Delaware July 16 and the GIII Glens Falls H. at Saratoga Sept. 5. She earned a valuable Grade I success in the E.P. Taylor S. at Woodbine Oct. 23, but was likely in need of the run when third in the GIII Honey Fox H. over an insufficient 8 1/2 furlongs Mar. 4. Allowed to lope along towards the back of the pack, Honey Ryder eased out four wide approaching the final turn, advanced in hand at the quarter pole and won as much the best. "I think this is probably the best race she's ever run, which is saying a lot because she's been such a very good, consistent mare," commented winning trainer Todd Pletcher. Silver Whistle took back-to-back turf allowances last spring then was an even fourth to English Channel in the GIII Virginia Derby at Colonial Downs July 16. He endured tough beats in his next two, missing by a nose in both the Aug. 8 GII Hall of Fame H. at Saratoga and the GIII Saranac S. Sept. 4. Rested thereafter, the Stronach homebred was steadied repeatedly in a Feb. 22 allowance over 11 furlongs and came on to lose by a head. Longshot Ramazutti cut out the early pace as Silver Whistle saved ground beneath Edgar Prado. Eased out to the two path on the final bend, he took aim on the long-time leader in the stretch and was all out to wear that one down. "It took him all the way to the wire to finally win one of these," said winning trainer Bill Mott. "I guess he needed the extra distance. He had a nice trip inside. We knew he would be able to step up to this level of competition. He had some near misses at Saratoga and it looked like he could stay [go a distance]. He did it in decent company. A rank outsider with the return to the main track here, she rated off an opening half in :43.67, then slipped through on the rail to catch El Mirage Queen in the final furlong to light up the tote board at 31-1. Bandini ran his local record to four wins from five starts, leading past every pole en route to an easy victory in this prep for the GI Met Mile at Belmont Park May 29. A 4 1/4-length maiden winner over Noble Causeway (Giant's Causeway) last Jan. 6, the attractive dark bay was a nine-length allowance winner Feb. 5 and second to High Fly in the GII Fountain of Youth S. Mar. 5. A six-length winner of the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. Apr. 16, he was 19th of 20 in the GI Kentucky Derby and was put away thereafter. The Smith/Tabor runner resurfaced with a track-record setting performance over a mile Mar. 1 and was the heavy chalk in his four-year-old stakes bow. Racing with front wraps for the first time, Bandini broke alertly and set the pace in hand while hugging what appeared to be a golden rail on the day. Still comfortably in front after six furlongs in an easy 1:11.73, he opened a daylight advantage past the eighth pole and held sway late. "This horse has matured quite a bit from last year," commented winning trainer Todd Pletcher. "He's made progress every step of the way and that performance was pretty much what we were hoping for. On paper he looked like he was the controlling speed. Sometimes race don't turn out the way they look on paper, but he was able to get to the front and do what we expected. Wanna Runner followed a Hollywood maiden score in November with an allowance victory at Santa Anita Dec. 28. The chestnut stepped up into stakes competition for his sophomore debut and was not disgraced, finishing third behind Brother Derek in the Jan. 14 GII San Rafael S., but he could do no better than fifth in the Jan. 29 GIII EI Camino Real Derby last time out. The odds-on chalk to get back on track after the trip to the Land of Enchantment, Wanna Runner raced with the leaders from the outset, was in command at midstretch and pulled away from stablemate Sky Diving to give trainer Bob Baffert the 1-2 finish. FLORIDA FOAL DIES; MRLS SAFETY MEASURES CITED

A second foal has been confirmed as having died

A second foal has been confirmed as having died from Mare Reproductive Loss Syndrome (MRLS) in Florida, according to Dr. Dana Zimmel of the University of Florida's College of Veterinary Medicine. The first case was a Thoroughbred foal from the University of Florida research herd, the second was a Quarter Horse foal born on a private farm. Both mares foaled in Alachua County, and both foals were born alive but were hospitalized and euthanized due to their deteriorating conditions. The first foal was born on Mar. 18 and died on Mar. 20. The University of Florida herd of research mares lives near Ocala, Fla., until about 30 days prior to foaling, when they are brought to the university's farm in Alachua County. The Quarter Horse foal was born on a private farm on Mar. 25 and died on Mar. 26. Zimmel said there is still one suspect case that was a late-term abortion from a Thoroughbred mare from the University of Florida breeding herd. 

No Simulcasting in Massachusetts:

Interstate simulcasting at each of the four racetracks in Massachusetts expired at midnight Friday after the state House and Senate failed to agree to the renewal of a license extension. The tracks were allowed to continue simulcasting for the first three months of this year, the result of another extension when no agreement could be reached by the beginning of 2006. The laws that govern off-track betting were lumped into a bill which would allow slots to be installed at the racing facilities. The state Senate passed that measure, but the House did not take up the issue before January and they passed a three-month extension, expecting the slots vote to come by the end of last month. The legislature returns to session on Monday. "We're hopeful that the matter can be resolved quickly, but in the meantime roughly 250 people are temporarily out of work," Suffolk Downs Media Director Christian Teja told Daily Racing Form.
