Pounded down to 1-2 favoritism, Surf Cat settled well behind a crisp opening quarter mile in :21.69 and was content to let the trio of Areyoutalkintome (Smokester), Keep on Punching (Silver Deputy) and Grinding it Out (Grindstone) slug it out through a half in :44.25. Ready to pounce a sixteenth from home, the four-year-old powered past the fading leaders in deep stretch and drew off to hand Grinding it Out a 2 1/4length defeat. Oceanus (Brz) (Rainbow Corner {GB}), who trailed the field early, passed tired rivals to fill the show spot. The victory gave trainer Bruce Headley his sixth in the Potrero Grande. His other winners are Kalookan Queen (2002), Kona Gold (2000-01), Son of a Pistol (1998) and Halo Folks (1986).

### Tale of a Cat....

Third time proved the charm when Surf Cat came home a 3 1/2-length winner over this track and trip last April and he looked even better when winning in a step

Also getting in a final work before Saturday's Kentucky Derby prep, Point Determined (Point Given) covered five furlongs in a sharp :59.80. Ridden by Victor Espinoza, the colt was the sixth fastest at the distance yesterday. "He went very nice," said trainer Bob Baffert. "Victor [Espinoza] loved him."

### Flashy Bull Exits Florida Derby With Excuse...

Flashy Bull (Holy Bull), seventh as the second betting choice in Saturday's GI Florida Derby, may have been compromised by an electrolyte imbalance known as 'the thumps,' according to trainer Kiaran McLaughlin. "It was hot [Saturday], and usually the 'thumps' are caused by heat and/or dehydration in the horse's body," McLaughlin explained. "The horse came out of the race sound as he always was, but he ran a sub par race and we may have found a legitimate excuse for that performance." As for treatment of the condition, McLaughlin added, "There are various things you can do, such as an addition of calcium to the horse's diet to prevent a recurrence of the condition, so as of right now, we're still pointing toward the Kentucky Derby [May 6]."

We'll give him a little time and probably shoot for a three-year-old stakes at Arlington this summer."

Keyed Entry and Showing Up Prep for Wood...

Keyed Entry (Honour and Glory) and Showing Up (Strategic Mission) had a final major preparatory work in advance of Saturday's GI Wood Memorial at Aqueduct. Second to Like Now in the GIII Gotham S., Keyed Entry breezed five furlongs in 1:01 4/5 over Belmont's fast training track Sunday. "That was exactly what we were looking for," said trainer Todd Pletcher, who trains the colt for Starlight Stables. "All he needed was a maintenance work after running three weeks ago." Trainer Barclay Tagg gave Wood contender Showing Up a tightener, sending the Lael Stables colt five furlongs at Gulfstream Park. The chestnut completed the task in 1:00 4/5. "He didn't go quite as fast as he did last time," said Tagg, referring to the colt's Mar. 26 work in :58 2/5. "This is what we wanted." 
