Brother Derek was off at 7-2 when he bested A.P. Warrior by 3/4 of a length in the GII Norfolk S. in October, but was sent off at 56-1 in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile 27 days later. The Cal-bred pressed the pace before tiring to be fourth in the World Thoroughbred Championships, but he has been unbeatable ever since. He capped his 2005 campaign with a victory in the GI Hollywood Futurity and opened 2006 with a win in the Jan. 14 GII San Rafael S. He made it three in a row in the Mar. 4 GII Santa Catalina S. and the majority of the 54,189 at Santa Anita yesterday were betting he would keep the streak alive. His connections were also convinced their colt would prevail. "He relaxed real well, and that's all he needed to do to get the mile and an eighth," trainer Dan Hendricks said. "I don't think distance now is any question. We just have to keep doing what he's been doing and crank him up for the first Saturday in May." Hendricks added, "The Derby is what the Derby is, 20 horses, it's THE horse race and we're heading there and we're going to have fun with it." Will Brother Derek try to lead them all the way in the May 6 GI Kentucky Derby? Jockey Alex Solis isn't married to that strategy. "He certainly doesn't have to be on the lead," Solis said. "I mean, today he felt like he was just walking around there. He takes it easy. He's not a crazy horse, speed crazy or anything like that." 
