REDEMPTION IS SWEET

Team Valor's Barry Irwin traveled halfway around the world to see **Irridescence (SAf)** (Caesour) run in the G1 Dubai Duty Free S. Mar. 25, but those plans were foiled when the four-year-old spooked in the paddock, suffered a stifle injury and was scratched. The dual South African Group 1 winner put that unfortunate incident behind her yesterday, leading nearly every step of the way for a thrilling victory in the G1 Audemars Piguet Queen Elizabeth II Cup at Sha Tin. "That wasn't exactly the plan!" jockey Weichong Marwing said of the race tactics. "I think that she is a better filly when she is held up, but when there was no pace and she broke well, I felt that I had to go on." Favored **Ouija Board (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) made up a ton of ground in the stretch, but had to settle for third. **Coverage cont. p2**

MYSTERIOUS ILLNESS CLAIMS WITH A CITY

G1 Kentucky Derby hopeful **With a City (City Zip)** was euthanized Sunday morning after a three-day battle with a mysterious illness. The three-year-old first showed signs of the illness Thursday, including diarrhea, and was transported to Hagyard Equine Medical Institute on Friday. There, his condition began to deteriorate and he began to suffer from seizures. Veterinarians were unable to stabilize the colt, and the decision was made yesterday to put him down. According to trainer Mike Maker, the cause of the illness has not yet been discovered. "He was absolutely a picture of health one minute and gone the next," Maker said. "They treated him for everything and ran tests on everything. They just don't know at this time. Hopefully, a necropsy will tell us more, but their feeling right now is that they're not so sure they're going to be able to tell." Owned by Ron Peltz's Equirace.com, With a City posted a 49-1 upset when taking the GII Lane's End S. at Turfway Mar. 25. Overall, he had a record of 13-4-0-2 and earned \$359,680.

T.H. APPROVAL THE 'JUAN' AT SANTA ANITA

If only they all could be 14 furlongs. Yesterday, distance specialist **T.H. Approval (With Approval)** successfully defended his title in the a1 3/4-mile GII San Juan Capistrano Invitational H. at Santa Anita, rallying powerfully to win the longest graded race in the United States by a length over **One Off (GB)** (Barathea {Ire}). In doing so, the five-year-old ended a four-race losing skein that dated back to last year's San Juan. "I was very happy and it's very nice to win a race like this, and I need to win," said trainer Eduardo Inda, who has just three horses in his stable. "We don't know yet [as to what race is next]. Irridescence won her first two career starts, but really blossomed about a year ago, finishing second in the G2 Gauteng Guineas before winning, in succession, the G1 SA Classic, G2 Rosenberg S. and G1 Woodlavington S. in the span of two months from April to June. Rested off a fifth in the G1 Durban July H. July 2, she returned to action in Dubai, evoking memories of Ipi Tombe (Zim) in winning the Listed Balanchine S. Feb. 24.

Pace Helps Winner, Hinders Others....

Irridescence sprung the gates, but was hardly in a hurry on the front end, covering the opening 800 meters in an unpressured :51.20 and her first six furlongs in 1:16.10. Still rolling nicely on the final turn, she

cornered a bit wide into the stretch, allowing **Super Kid (NZ)** (Gaius {Ire}) to slide up the rail and challenge momentarily for the lead. But, with the easy early tempo, Marwing was able to coax a bit more from his filly and she stayed on dourly for the win as **Best**

Gift (NZ) (Bahhare) lunged late. **Ouija Board**, looking to complete the Hong Kong Vase--QE II double, raced slightly worse than midfield down the backstretch and had better than five lengths to find in the final quarter mile. Steered widest of all by jockey Frankie Dettori, the Lord Derby runner managed to clock :21.80 for the final 400 meters, but just missed at a distance short of her optimum. "I just ran out of track and things didn't go her way," Dettori commented. "She felt as good as ever, and I don't see why she shouldn't have a great season ahead of her." **Viva Pataca (GB)** (Marju {Ire}), the Hong Kong Derby winner and 5-2 second choice, was forced to cover a lot of ground, and finished sixth, beaten 4 1/2 lengths.

a nice, long work, just as we planned." Matz said Barbaro would walk Monday, then go to the track Tuesday and Wednesday before shipping to Churchill Thursday.

McLaughlin Confirms Like Now is Preakness Bound...

John Dillon's **Like Now** (Jules), who was gallant in a runner-up finish to Showing Up in Saturday's GII Coolmore Lexington S. at Keeneland, will not contest the GI Kentucky Derby and will instead be aimed toward the GI Preakness S. May 20, trainer Kiaran McLaughlin confirmed yesterday. The announcement still leaves McLaughlin with two Derby hopefuls, **Jazil** (Seeking the Gold) and **Flashy Bull** (Holy Bull). The latter, currently 21st on the graded-stakes earnings list (*see p8 for complete list*), worked a half mile in :50 2/5 (2/28) over Keeneland's Polytrack training track yesterday morning. "He went very well," said McLaughlin. "He's doing very well and he will work again next Sunday at Churchill Downs."

Path to the Winner's Circle...

Sent off at 5-1 in last year's San Juan, **T.H. Approval** stayed close to the pace and asserted well late to earn his first graded win. Fifth to Runaway Dancer in his next outing, the GIII Jim Murray Memorial H. at Holly-

wood May 14, he then began a run of second-place finishes in the GII Sunset BC H. in mid-July. Derailed for the remainder of the year with a minor injury, the Tadahiro Hotehama homebred came back to fill the exacta in

the Feb. 26 GII San Luis Obispo H. and again in the Mar. 25 GII San Luis Rey H., both over this course and both at 12 panels. Mere sprint tune-ups for this test, as it turned out, with the Santa Anita crowd backing the gray at 6-5 adding two furlongs. Rated off unrealistically quick splits, he got cranked up turning for home, fought to the lead in upper stretch, opened by daylight and had enough of a cushion to hold the game **One Off** at bay. "He was so good today," said winning rider Alex Solis. "Eduardo [Inda, trainer] has done such a great job with him. I love this horse; he's so great to ride. Eduardo gets all the credit. He is such a cool horse and that's good for this kind of a race because he relaxes very well." T.H. Approval becomes the first back-to-back winner of the San Juan since Niarkos in 1967-68. Action now moves to Hollywood Park, which kicks off with the Cougar II S. Wednesday at 1:20 p.m. local time. Potrichal was a G1SW in Argentina and GSP in the U.S., and is a full sister to four Group 1 winners, including Potrinner (Arg), the dam of Melhor Ainda (Pulpit).

Rattle and Hum came out of this war of attrition on top to provide trainers Fabrizio and Luigi Camici with a second renewal since 1998. In that year, Crisos il Monaco (Ire) denied the British raider Trans Island (GB), and it was a case of deja vu as the San Valentino color-bearer outran Royal Power in the closing stages. The only blot on Rattle and Hum's otherwise perfect copybook at two came when fifth on his second start in the Listed Premio Giuseppe de Montel at the San Siro in July, but he had looked special at this venue in all other outings and rounded off with an impressive six-length score in a conditions event in November.

Returning here for a course-and-distance warm-up Apr. 2, he again showed his ability to quicken off a fast pace to score by five lengths and benefited from scorching fractions set by Magic Box (Ity) (Namid {GB}) in this test. Always traveling strongly in mid-division against the rail under a confident Fabio Branca, he received a dream run up the rail in the straight to arrive on the pacesetter's tail full of run approaching the quarter pole. His jockey was still sitting tight until Adorable Fong arrived on his outer and, when asked the question, quickened to the front with a furlong remaining, gaining crucial first run on Royal Power and Ted Durcan. Christophe Soumillon knows this circuit like the back of his hand and he used all his know-how to steer Daltaya to a career-best in this tight contest. With a November conditions score at Maisons-Laffitte to her name, she returned to finish runner-up to Daaly Babet (Fr) in a course-and-distance conditions event on heavy going last time Apr. 6, but stepped forward on this livelier surface to give connections a Classic quandary. Quickest away from the stalls, she enjoyed a lead from Ring Hill (GB) (Bering {GB}), acting as rabbit to the favored Quiet Royal, until taking over at the top of the straight. Driven out to hold her advantage late on, she was in the clear as Olivier Peslier extracted the crowd's choice from the pack to lead a vain chase. "She is very lazy in the mornings and I don't usually run them two weeks apart, but she showed me she had really improved since her comeback," trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre explained. "Before this, Soumillon suggested a mile might be her limit, but that run suggests she'll stay further, so we'll make a decision between the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulaches [French 1000 Guineas over course and distance May 14] or G1 Prix Saint-Alary here [over 10 furlongs May 21]." Having won a Clairfontaine conditions race in October, Stormy River was officially runner-up, beaten three lengths, by Carlotamix (Fr) (Linamix {Fr}), in the G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud 15 days later. However, that result did not tell the entire story, as he led home his own group on the far side only to be undone by that rival racing against the stands' rail. After a smooth return score in the Listed Prix Djebel at Maisons-Laffitte Apr. 4, he was ready to settle scores here and did so in emphatic style. Breaking well, he was keen early without cover in a stalking third before settling as the pace sharpened before halfway. When the button was pressed at the quarter pole, Stormy River put the result beyond doubt in a matter of strides. "My only concern was the ground, as most by Verglas like it soft, but he quickened brilliantly and will go for the G1 Poule d'Essai des Poulains [French 2000 Guineas over course and distance May 14]," conditioner Nic Clement said of the winner. "I was never really worried, as I know he can quicken and he'll head straight to the G1 Prix du Jockey-Club [French Derby at Chantilly June 4] after we've supplemented him." At the conclusion of the weanling sale, the Easter Broodmare Sale started its three-day run with **Lady Larissa** (Belong to Me) bringing a final bid of A\$500,000 to top the session. Entering the ring as lot [268](#), the four-year-old mare, in foal to General Nediym (Aus), was consigned by Craig Anderson's Broadwater Farm, agent. Bloodstock agent Steve Brem purchased the filly.
