WANDERIN BOY SHARP IN BEN ALI VICTORY

Arthur B. Hancock III's homebred **Wanderin Boy** (Seeking the Gold) earned a 120 BRIS speed rating when he captured a Keeneland allowance test three weeks ago, and he carried that form into yesterday's GIII Ben Ali S. in Lexington. Sent off the crowd's odds-on choice, the lightly raced five-year-old led a six-horse field through sensible fractions and drew off impressively under Javier Castellano to defeat defending champ **Alumni Hall** (A.P. Indy) by 5 1/4 lengths. "I had plenty of horse all the way in the race," said Castellano. "I know what kind of horse he is. I rode him with a lot of confidence." It was the second graded victory for Wanderin Boy, who won the GIII Mineshaft S. in 2005.

WinStar Farm already has a GI Kentucky Derby contender in homebred Bluegrass Cat, and yesterday added a second when Bill Casner and Kenny Troutt's operation acquired an interest in Classic contender **Sharp**

Humor (Distorted Humor).

Sharp Humor was bred in New York by Chris Purdy and owned by Purdedel Stable, and will race in the Purdedel colors in the Derby. "Sharp Humor is a gorgeous colt with brilliant speed and, more impressively, the ability to carry that speed," said Doug Cauthen, president of WinStar Farm. "He possesses the strong determination that Distorted Humor

has been passing along to his progeny. He's great looking, he's precocious, he's brilliant and he's bred to run at Classic distances." WinStar stands the GI Florida Derby runner-up's sire, Distorted Humor, who already has a Derby winner to his credit in Funny Cide. Majority Purdedel partner Ed Edelberg added, "I'm excited to be associated with WinStar. Wouldn't it be nice if another New York-bred son of Distorted Humor crossed the finish line first on the first Saturday in May?" Sharp Humor, winner of the GII Swale S. in March, was second to Barbaro in the Apr. 1 GI Florida Derby and has amassed career earnings of over \$450,000.

Path to the Winner's Circle...

As a five-year-old, **Wanderin Boy** had made just eight career starts before the Ben Ali, but had collected wins in half of those efforts. After taking last year's renewal of the GIII Mineshaft H. at Fair Grounds in February, he finished a well-beaten seventh in the GII New Orleans H. a month later and was put away. He returned at Gulfstream this past winter, running second in an allowance Jan. 19 and third in a similar test Mar. 1, the latter coming against Bandini, who set a track record in the race. Moved to Keeneland for his latest, Wanderin Boy put everything together and romped by 10 lengths against allowance foes Apr. 7 and was well-backed taking the step up to stakes company. Hustled out from post six, he clicked off :23 4/5, :47 3/5, and 1:11 2/5 splits and, under a mild hand ride, drew clear down the lane. "You always worry about a horse running that big early in the meet and coming back, but obviously he met his task and he ran a tremendous race today," said winning trainer Nick Zito. **Click for the [brisnet.com](http://www.brisnet.com) chart.**

Seaside Retreat Works, Confirmed for Derby...

GII Lane's End S. runner-up **Seaside Retreat** (King Cugat) impressed his connections yesterday with a bullet five-furlong drill in :59 2/5 at Churchill Downs, and has been confirmed for the Kentucky Derby. Regular rider Patrick Husbands was aboard for the work, which was the fastest of 22 at the distance. "We talked last night and Patrick said, 'If he doesn't work good, I'm going to tell you,'" said Mark Casse, who trains Seaside Retreat for William S. Farish Jr. "I said, absolutely; tell me what you feel. He phoned me from the horse and said 'We are going to the Derby, boss.' He was really impressed." Casse added that a Derby field laden with speed should benefit his charge. "If he was a speed horse, I would be looking somewhere else," Casse said. "I think the race has a good chance to set up well for us."

Showing Up Gallops at Belmont...

Lael Stable's GII Coolmore Lexington S. winner **Showing Up** (Strategic Mission) galloped yesterday at Belmont Park. The colt has yet to be confirmed for the Run for the Roses, but trainer Barclay Tagg sounded optimistic about a trip to Louisville when he said, "If everything looks good on Wednesday [of Derby week], I'll enter him, and if everything looks good on Thursday, I'll ship."

SONGANDAPRAYER COLT TOPS OBS DAY 3 A colt by second-crop sire Songandaprayer topped yesterday's third session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's Spring Sale, attracting a final bid of \$460,000 from Zayat Stables. The juvenile, consigned by Eisaman Equine, agent, is out of Island Lake (Meadowlake) and had the fastest quarter-mile work of :20 4/5 at the under tack preview. Songandaprayer was also responsible for the day's second highest-priced lot. Bloodstock agent Buzz Chace went to \$375,000 to secure hip 909, a bay colt out of Just Personal (Personal Hope). The two-year-old was consigned by Hartley/DeRenzo Thoroughbreds, agent. Through three sessions, OBS has sold 578 juveniles for a total of \$19,982,400. The cumulative average of \$34,572 is up 19.5 percent from a year ago. The sale's final session gets underway today at 10:30 a.m.

DISCREET CAT DWYER-BOUND Godolphin's undefeated sophomore **Discreet Cat** (Forestry), the G2 UAE Derby hero who bypassed the spring Classics to focus on the second half of the racing season, is being aimed toward the GII Dwyer S. at Belmont Park July 4, reports *Daily Racing Form*. "The boss [Sheikh Mohammed] probably did the right thing by skipping the Derby," Rick Mettee, who is overseeing Godolphin's New York string, told the publication.



"He's a May 1 foal; to go into that race off three races is hard to do. He didn't get probably as much as we thought he would out of the UAE Derby. He almost won it a little too easy."

Bring Forth drew the one hole for the opening race on opening day Apr. 7 and missed the break, but recovered nicely to finish third. Stronger for the experience and with an interim three-furlong bullet over the Polytrack in :36 Apr. 21, the \$32,000 KEESep yearling was made the 5-2 second choice. A much better dispatch saw the bay on the lead while scraping the paint and he powered away impressively in the stretch to win by a widening 6 3/4 lengths.
