

Lael Stables' Barbaro (Dynaformer), foaled Apr. 29, 2003, went to work on his birthday, stopping the timer in :46 for his half-mile move, the fastest of 69 horses



at the distance. "We just basically wanted to blow him out," commented trainer Michael Matz. "Right now, he's ready to go into the starting gate." With exercise rider Peter Brette in the saddle, the strapping bay galloped out strongly, getting his five furlongs in:59 2/5 and three-quarters in 1:12 1/5. Matz is certain that the

Fourth to Exclusive Quality in his Jan. 7 bow at Gulfstream, Bernardini graduated by 7 3/4 lengths in South Florida Mar. 4. The horse he beat on that occasion, High Finance, came back to take a Keeneland maiden by over nine lengths Apr. 15. A foot bruise cost him a start in a race ultimately won by Luxembourg on the Wood Memorial undercard Apr. 8, but Albertrani was never concerned. "His foot bruise was really a minor deal," he commented. "We backed off him for a couple of days, and then it was right back to his usual routine." The conditioner added that he would consult with John Ferguson and Sheikh Mohammed, but that the GI Preakness S. May 20 is under consideration.

Pletcher Brigade Out a Day Early...

Trainer Todd Pletcher sent out his trio of Derby hopefuls yesterday, trying to beat the weatherman. Aaron and Marie Jones' **Sunriver** (Saint Ballado) was first out, drilling six furlongs in 1:13.60. "Excellent. It looked good to me," Pletcher said of the colt, who has quietly become his top contender. Starlight Stable, Saylor and Lucarelli's **Keyed Entry** (Honour and Glory), most recently third in the GI Wood Memorial, went the same distance in 1:12.80. WinStar Farm's **Bluegrass Cat** (Storm Cat) breezed a half-mile in :50.80. "He was very aggressive today," commented his exercise rider Luis Castillo. "I had to take a pretty good hold of him. He is feeling very good and he likes what he's doing."

Peitz' Don't Care Attitude...

Trainer Dan Peitz has a one-headed monster at Churchill Downs and his name is **Steppenwolfer** (Aptitude), runner-up to Lawyer Ron in the Arkansas Derby. The gray colt turned in his typically solid work yesterday, going six furlongs in 1:13 under jockey Robby Albarado. "I didn't know how fast the track was going to be, but I was hoping he would go in about 1:13," the satisfied conditioner commented. "I don't care how fast everybody else worked," he added. "That's their horse and I know what my horse has to do and what he needs to do and we did what we wanted to do."

Sweetnorthernsaint Fires His Best Shot...

Joseph Balsamo and Ted Theos' **Sweetnorthernsaint** (Sweetsouthernsaint), who figures no worse than the fourth choice on Saturday, pleased connections with a six-furlong breeze in a race-like 1:11.60 over the glib surface. "I was pleased with how the horse worked," commented trainer Michael Trombetta. "The fractional times were good. I think they finished the last quarter in :23 and change and they galloped out well." Jockey Calvin Borel was in the boot for the move, replacing regular rider Kent Desormeaux, who retains the Derby mount, despite going AWOL for yesterday's work.

The colt had his shins pinfired following that disappointment and did not reappear until September, when he finished third in a one-mile conditions event at Doncaster. His comeback continued with an impressive victory in the Sept. 30 G3 Joel S., but he was down the field in the G1 Champion S. Oct. 15 at Newmarket. Racing a shade keenly in second through these steady early fractions, he was nudged along to challenge Kings Point at the quarter pole. The brown colt drew away from the field, and jockey Mick Kinane did not need to give him the full treatment to score from Babodana. "My fellow picked up well and got a little tired close home," Kinane said. "This is a very genuine horse; he's matured well, seems to be sound and could have a nice year." Andre Fabre, who has won this three times since 1990, relies on the ex-German Manduro to increase that tally in a substandard renewal. Trained by Peter Schiergen at two and three, Manduro annexed the G3 Preis des Winterfavoriten at Cologne in October 2004 before enduring an injury-interrupted sophomore campaign that was nevertheless highlighted by successes in the Listed Grosser Bavaria-Preis at Munich in September and G3 Preis der Deutschen Einheit at Hoppegarten in October. He lost his unbeaten tag when fourth in the G1 Premio Roma the following month, and was something of an unknown quantity when returning for his new conditioner in the Apr. 9 G2 Prix d'Harcourt at this track, but sealed his reputation by beating Corre Caminos by a half length and setting a new 10-furlong record in the process. His chief threats may be the distaffers in the line-up. Heading them is Pride, who was disqualified from second place behind Bago (Fr) in this 12 months ago. She proved herself a top-class performer subsequently when taking the G2 Prix Jean Romanet at Deauville in August and G2 Prix Foy at this track in September before returning to finish seventh in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in early October. She excelled just 13 days later when finishing runner-up to David Junior in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket and when filling the same spot in the G1 Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin in December, and bids to provide trainer Alain de Roye-Dupre with his fifth success in this since 1991. Royal Highness is worthy of respect on the best of last season's form, capturing the G2 Prix de Malleret at Saint-Cloud in June either side of chasing the tail of Shawanda (Ire) in the G3 Prix de Royaumont at Chantilly in June and G1 Prix Vermeille here in October.
