The 22-year-old rider, who broke the record for most victories in a single meet this winter at Turfway Park, shared the riding title with Rafael Bejarano at the recently concluded Keeneland spring meet. Ex Caelis, who will attempt to give Lukas his fifth victory in the Oaks, covered six furlongs over Churchill's main track in 1:15 Saturday morning. The dark bay, runner-up in last year's GII Alcibiades S. and GIII Arlington-Washington Breeders' Cup Lassie S., concluded her 2yo campaign with a good fourth to stablemate Folklore in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies.

"He has always been a good horse, but he was very difficult to train in his younger days and took a while to settle," Delzangles added. This race is a virtual rerun of the Apr. 1 G3 Prix Edmond Blanc over course and distance, where Svedov got the better of Art Master and Helios Quercus in the soft going. With drying conditions expected for this contest, that form could be reversed now that the second and third finishes have race fitness on their side. While that success came as a surprise for Svedov, Art Master had looked set for greater things when scoring in the Listed Prix de Pontarme at this course and G3 Prix de la Jonchere at Chantilly at three and when delivering a highly impressive finishing burst to take the G3 Prix du Palais Royal on his only four-yearold start at Longchamp last May. He bids to provide Andre Fabre with his fourth renewal of this race since 1991. Helios Quercus was a top-class juvenile, winning the G1 Criterium International over course and distance, but the wheels came off the wagon last term and only two listed races fell his way. His return, however, hinted that he might regain lost glories. Special Kaldoun faces a stiff task as he attempts to defy a penalty in a race in which he has finished off the board the last three seasons. Nevertheless, he is a solid performer at this level on his day and is looking for his seventh group success. He ran with his usual enthusiasm when runner-up to Kendor Dine in the G3 Prix Exbury over 10 furlongs over this circuit last time Mar. 8.




