#### **CHAMPION FOLKLORE RETIRED**

Last year's Juvenile filly champion Folklore (Tiznow-Contrive, by Storm Cat) has been retired because of a stress fracture in her knee, trainer D. Wayne Lukas confirmed yesterday. Robert Lewis, who cam-

paigned the filly with his wife Beverly in 2005, died earlier this year. Winner of the GI Matron S. and GII Adirondack S. earlier in 2005, the bay concluded her juvenile campaign with an emphatic victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies at Belmont Park. "We're going to retire her," Lukas told the Lexington Herald-

### Burning Bush...

Confirmed front-runner **Bushfire** (Louis Quatorze), who won in a gallop over **Wait a While** (Maria's Mon) and **Balance** (Thunder Gulch) in the Apr. 8 GI Ashland S., will attempt to collect her second consecutive Grade I in today's Oaks. "She's as good or even better than she's ever been," said trainer Eddie Kenneally. A narrow winner in her 2006 debut in a Gulfstream allowance, the filly foundered, finishing seventh, in a sloppy edition of the GII Davona Dale S. Feb. 4, but rebounded to take the Mar. 18 Florida Oaks at Tampa. Ready to roll on the front end here, the filly fired a sharp :47 2/5 final time in her latest workout at Keeneland Apr. 29. "She can be aggressive when she gallops, but her exercise rider [Desi Farrell] knows how to switch her off. That's why I bring her out late...It's quieter. She's very competitive."



# Strong Supporting Cast...

Anthony Pakenham's unbeaten Sir Percy (GB) (Mark of Esteem {Ire}), who will start from stall four, will bid to become only the second winner of the G1 Dewhurst S. to come back to Newmarket and win since 1995. Great things were hardly expected of the son of the 1996 Guineas hero when bought for just 16,000 guineas at Tattersalls, but Sir Percy defied his pedigree and humble price tag with scores at Goodwood and Salisbury before heading back to the former venue to annex the G2 Vintage S. in July. After a near three-month break, he returned to best Horatio Nelson by a neck in the Dewhurst, form that has solid foundations due to the presence of the third and fourth, Opera Cape (GB) (Barathea {Ire}) and Red Clubs (Ire) (Red Ransom). After some stellar workouts at home and at Newbury, connections are feeling the strain. "There's so much hype and a lot is expected of [Sir Percy], but we know he is in brilliant hands," commented Victoria Pakenham. "It's incredible how much publicity he's getting--he looks sensational and [trainer] Marcus [Tregoning] and his team have got him to a perfect pitch."

### Hills' Triple Threat...

Trainer Barry Hills, who doubled his tally in the race two years ago with Haafhd (GB), will saddle three and jockey Michael Hills has chosen to ride John Grant's G3 Craven S. winner Killybegs (Ire) (Orpen). Jamie Spencer will take the ride on Bill Gredley's Olympian Odyssey (GB) (Sadler's Wells) and he is hopeful of a bold show from the Listed Fielden S. runner-up. "He worked very well yesterday and he went very nicely," Spencer said. "He's a lovely horse and he ran a good race at Newmarket--he was unfortunate not to win and it should have left him right for this weekend. I would say he has a good each-way chance, but it looks a very competitive Guineas." Richard Hills will partner Ronnie Arculli's G3 Greenham S. winner Red Clubs (Ire) (Red Ransom) and he said of the colt, "He has got a good draw in box three and the stalls are in the middle. Red Clubs is stepping up to a mile for the first time, but he is quite a laid-back horse and most of my father's horses tend to stay, so I don't think the distance is any concern at all."

## Race Another Day...

There were no surprises among the scratchings, with O'Brien ruling out Amadeus Mozart (Ire) (Mozart {Ire}) and James Joyce (Ire) (Danehill), Jim Bolger withdrawing Heliostatic (Ire) (Galileo (Ire)) and Hughie Morrison the maiden Supaseus (GB) (Spinning World). With the weather forecast changeable, Clerk of the Course Michael Prosser was weighing up his options yesterday. "It is getting up to 24 degrees today and the ground is quickening up all the time," he said. "The rain is still due, albeit 24 hours later than we were forecast earlier in the week. Unless there is another change in the forecast tomorrow morning which indicates that the thundery rain will not hit us after all, I will not be watering the course. It is out of the question to do so with the weather forecast as it stands." Prosser also confirmed that the stalls would be placed in the middle of the track.

and in the last two renewals of the G1 Grosser Preis von Baden, was being retired due to wear-and-tear to his joints. "It was a very easy decision to make," Brittain said yesterday. "We'd given him a good break during the winter and he appeared to return in good form, but on Monday

morning we detected some heat in a joint and when we had him X-rayed, there was a little chip in the back of the sesamoid in a very awkward position. It would have meant surgery and there was no quarantee of success, so the decision was taken very quickly." Warrsan, who was campaigned over five seasons, was also successful in the 2003 G2 Jockev Club S, at Newmarket and finished runner-up in the G1 Gran Premio di Milano and third in the G1 Hong Kong Vase that season, as well as finishing second in the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown the following year. "With Warrsan, you had a fighter who would give you 100 percent and you can't ask for more than that," Brittain added. "Epsom is a very unforgiving course, but he was tough enough to survive and go back and win again." Warrsan, whose stud arrangements have yet to be confirmed, won nine of his 43 lifetime starts and amassed a total of £1,118,854 in prize money.
