

CAN ANYBODY BEAT BARBARO?

There hasn't been a Triple Crown winner in 28 years, but after watching unbeaten Barbaro (Dynaformer)



Barbaro

storm down the stretch to win the 132nd running of the GI Kentucky Derby by 6 1/2 lengths over 30-1 Bluegrass Cat (Storm Cat) at Churchill Downs yesterday, it's easy to believe that the drought is about to end. Posting the biggest winning margin since Assault won by eight in 1946, the imposing dark bay became the sixth undefeated three-year-old to wear the blanket of roses. He looks to follow in the hoofsteps of Seattle Slew as the Horsephotos second to sweep the series. "I never had a doubt about the kind

of horse he is," said jockey Edgar Prado, who was winning the race for the first time. "He is a very nice horse--now, hopefully, he can win the Triple Crown." Kentucky Derby cont. p2

A Dream Trip...

Barbaro bobbled slightly as he raced away from post 8, but eased his way through the field to sit fourth, going stride for stride with stablemate Showing Up (Strategic Mission) as they raced around the first turn and down the backstretch. On the front end, it was Keyed Entry (Honour and Glory) leading Sinister Minister (Old Trieste) as they dashed off fractions of :22.63, :46.07 and 1:10.88, and those two were still at it as they neared the far turn. Showing Up, on the outside, and 5-1 chalk Sweetnorthernsaint (Sweetsouthernsaint), from the rail, were the first to go after the frontrunners, but they were quick to fade, and Barbaro was just getting into gear. He carried jockey Edgar Prado to the front after a mile in 1:37.02 and was in complete control down the lane, getting his last quarter in :24.34 in a dominating performance. "He stumbled a little bit coming out of the gate, but after that I was just waiting for the time to turn him loose," Prado said. "And you saw what he did when I turned him loose--he exploded like a rocket." Bluegrass Cat came from just off the pace to be second, while Steppenwolfer (Aptitude) closed from far back for third. Brother Derek (Benchmark) was six wide around the far turn, was steadied twice at the end of the backstretch and was fanned out to the middle of the track while making his move in the stretch, then finished evenly to dead-heat with Jazil (Seeking the Gold) for fourth. A Roller Coaster Ride...

It was yet another of the remarkable milestones in the life of trainer Michael Matz. Matz, 55, emerged a hero from an airplane crash in a cornfield in Sioux City, Iowa, 17 years ago and became an Olympic silver medallist in show jumping seven years later. He retired from that sport in 2000 and turned his attention to horse racing. Barbaro was his first Derby starter. "This is a great feeling," Matz said as he stood on the podium in the Churchill Downs infield. "I'm so happy to have a horse like Barbaro--I can't tell you how happy I am."

Lucky 13...

Michael Matz was the subject of much criticism for racing Barbaro just once in the 13 weeks leading up to the Derby. A perfect three-for-three on the turf to start his career, the colt tried the dirt for the first time in the Feb. 4 GIII Holy Bull S. and prevailed by 3/4 of a length despite an obvious dislike for the sloppy Gulfstream strip. It was eight weeks before his next appearance in the Apr. 1 GI Florida Derby, but he came back to beat a stubborn Sharp Humor (Distorted Humor) by a halflength. It had been 50 years since a horse had been off for as many as five weeks before getting it done on the first Saturday in May, but Barbaro silenced the doubters to follow in the hoofsteps of Needles. If Matz felt vindicated, he kept his thoughts to himself. "I think [the outcome] speaks for itself," he said. "I don't have to say anything." Everyone expects to see the Derby winner in the gate in the May 20 GI Preakness S. While Matz wasn't ready to commit to the race, he did say, "It looked like he did it easy enough; it looked like he came back well. I don't think Edgar got after him too hard--I don't know if he hit him at all."

A Classic Double...

Roy and Gretchen Jackson's Lael Stables had more than the Derby to celebrate yesterday. The Jacksons also became the first breeders in history to produce the winners of the first leg of the American Triple Crown and the first leg of the British Triple Crown, the G1 2000 Guineas, in the same year. Yesterday's 2000 Guineas hero George Washington (Ire) (Danehill) was also bred by Lael, but was sold to Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith for 1,150,000gns as a yearling at the Tattersalls October sale. After the Derby, Roy Jackson said, "I don't know how to explain it. I don't know why this is happening to us, but we are really enjoying it. This is a dream come true for us, and I think it's extra-special to win the Derby with a homebred. We had the mare and raced her, and to have her go on and produce a Derby winner is the icing on the cake. I'm sort of speechless right now. I just feel blessed to be standing here today."

Confirming that his brace of Group 1 wins at two was just an appetizer, George Washington sliced through his peers at Newmarket yesterday before dominating the final quarter mile of this Classic under an assured Kieren Fallon, who was chalking up his eighth win in the Classic. But, not content with making a mockery of a high-class field, the Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith colorbearer planted himself on the walkway back to the winner's enclosure.

He refused to have his picture taken, forcing connections to unsaddle in the pre-parade ring. "He didn't want to come in because the other horses had gone the other way," trainer Aidan O'Brien, celebrating his fourth 2000 Guineas score, told *Racing Post*. "There was no point getting into an argument. If he pleases us on the track, that's the big thing."

In a League of His Own...

George Washington debuted at this meeting 12 months ago and was nearly knocked over before finishing third in a five-furlong maiden. He made all four subsequent juvenile starts at The Curragh, simply breezing through a maiden and the G2 Railway S. before opening up by eight devastating lengths in the G1 Phoenix S. over six furlongs in August. Sent a panel further in the Sept. 18 G1 National S., he inhaled his rivals with ease, but did not clear away as he had the previous month, winning by two lengths. Almost replicating that performance here, he was rank early and buried deep in the pack as Olympian Odyssey (Sadler's Wells) set a moderate pace. He split horses passing the quarter pole, went clear in a matter of strides and allowed Fallon the luxury of basking in the final 50 yards. "They don't get much better than this," the rider explained. "He's always shown an electric turn of foot and has done everything right today--he's a great horse to ride and I've never ridden anything like him." O'Brien believes there is more to come. "He'll get better and we can look forward to an exciting year," he remarked. "He's a very well-balanced, good-moving horse who loves racing. He doesn't do preliminaries great, but he has so much natural speed and cuts horses down so quick." Connections of Sir Percy were far from downbeat and the June 3 G1 Epsom Derby is in the cards. "He looks like he is going to come out of this race fine and I imagine it would be the plan to go straight to the Derby, but I'll have to discuss it with the owners," trainer Marcus Tregoning said. Olympian Odyssey, who kept up his early work to be third, will also be aimed at the Blue Riband. Click for the racingpost.co.uk chart or the free brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree.

Park Appeal...

Cheveley Park Stud have long been associated with choice distaffers, but their big-race fortunes took a turn for the better when Russian Rhythm provided a first win in this Classic in 2003. They are two-handed this time with Nannina (GB) (Medicean {GB}), who repre-

sents the John Gosden barn--successful in 2000 with Lahan (GB)--and Confidential Lady (GB) (Singspiel {Ire}), who is a landmark first runner in an English Classic for Sir Mark Prescott. Nannina followed success in the G3 Prestige S. in August with a hard-fought defeat of Alexandrova (Ire) in the

G1 Fillies' Mile over course and distance in October. She makes her seasonal bow, but it is well documented that she has so far refused to shed her winter coat. Confidential Lady had a busy summer, winning the Listed Star S. at Sandown in July, then finishing second in the G3 Sweet Solera S. at the July Course and beating Quiet Royal in the G3 Prix du Calvados at Deauville in August. She disappointed when down the field behind Rumplestiltskin (Ire) (Danehill) and Quiet Royal in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac in October, but, unlike Nannina, has advertised her well-being at home this spring. "Both fillies love fast ground," Cheveley Park's Managing Director Chris Richardson told Racing Post. "We're pleased to have two homebred fillies lining up, as that's a pretty big compliment to the whole operation. Confidential Lady was over the top in the Marcel Boussac and didn't appreciate the ground at Longchamp, running well below her form on that day. Its been a bore for the other filly that she hasn't come in her coat, but we've got to get on with it."

A Change of Pace...

Sir Robert Ogden's colors are more familiar at the major jumping meets, but in La Chunga (More Than Ready) he has a filly to light up the flat. She provided one of the most visually exciting displays at the Royal Ascot meeting at York last June, running away from the smart Vague and Rumplestiltskin in the G3 Albany S. before finishing fourth under a penalty in the G3 Princess Margaret S. at Newbury the following month. She found Flashy Wings (GB) (Zafonic) a length too strong in York's G2 Lowther S. in August, but jockey Darryll Holland thinks she will be on that rival's case again. "She's in great form and has worked really nicely," he said. "Her run behind Flashy Wings last year suggests wherever she finishes, we'll be right there. It's just the distance that's a concern, as she's got a lot of pace." 1000 Guineas cont. p5

Christophe Soumillon, who was forced to miss the ride on Araafa (Ire) in yesterday's G1 2000 Guineas due to a back injury, will wait to decide if he can partner Shirocco today. The reigning French champion jockey is suffering from the effects of a fall at Marseille-Borely Friday. His agent Shippy Ellis told PA Sport, "He will ride out early tomorrow morning before deciding whether he will be able to ride Shirocco." Sir Michael Stoute, who has won this six times, saddles Hard Top, who faces the starter for just the fifth time. Nevertheless, he proved he was made of the right material when denying The Geezer (GB) in the G2 Great Voltigeur S. at York in August. His subsequent fifth in the G1 St Leger the following month may be attributable to the deep ground prevalent at Doncaster and he will have a livlier surface to help.
