Purchased for just 30,000 guineas at the Doncaster Breeze-Ups, the filly with a penchant for going it alone followed up her success in the Apr. 18 G3 Nell Gwyn S. to provide trainer Pam Sly, her son Michael and Dr. Tom Davies with the fairytale result. "It's just marvellous," Sly commented, saddling her first Classic runner from a string of just 13 flat Getty Images horses. "It's given hope to all the little

people and it says 'You can do it.'

#### PREAKNESS NEXT FOR DERBY WINNER

Barbaro (Dynaformer) returned from his authoritative win in Saturday's GI Kentucky Derby in fine shape and will now head to Maryland for the May 20 GI Preakness S. The Derby winner left Churchill Downs yesterday afternoon for trainer Michael Matz's base at Maryland's Fair Hill training center. Matz and his family enjoyed a relatively guiet evening after winning the Derby. After a visit to the Derby Winner's Party at the Kentucky Derby Museum, Matz checked in on Barbaro and returned to his hotel. "We didn't get back here to the barn until almost 9:30," Matz said. "He had his head in the bucket eating and we didn't want to bother him then, so we got back to the hotel and had a few drinks and that was it." Looking ahead to the Preakness and Belmont S., the trainer said, "I'm sure one day he's going to get beat. But I sure hope it's later than sooner. I mean, I hope he doesn't--maybe he's a once-in-a-lifetime horse. I don't know."

#### Second, Third Likely to Sit Out Preakness

Derby runner-up Bluegrass Cat (Storm Cat) and thirdplace finisher Steppenwolfer (Aptitude) exited the race in good order, but are both expected to skip the Preakness. "I want to evaluate the situation, but I would say the Preakness is unlikely," trainer Todd Pletcher said of Bluegrass Cat. Trainer Dan Peitz is planning on a Belmont ambush for Barbaro. "We're going right back to Belmont and we're just going to set up shop there and wait on [Barbaro]," Peitz said yesterday. "Wait on him to come to Belmont and just disappoint 100,000 people when they don't get a Triple Crown winner. Be the spoiler. Somebody's got to be the bad guy."

#### **Hendricks Eyeing Preakness Rematch**

Brother Derek (Benchmark), who lost a shoe during the Derby, will try to rebound from his fourth-place dead-heat finish Saturday in the Preakness. "I'd love to have another run at him," Hendricks said of the Derby winner. "We'll train here [at Churchill] until a few days before the race. This is home for him now." Other Derby winners considering a run in the Preakness are Sweetnorthernsaint (Sweetsouthernsaint), who finished seventh, and Lawyer Ron (Langfuhr), who finished 12th. Derby Handle Sets Record p7

Speciosa showed obvious talent at two after winning a Beverley maiden in August, finishing third in the G2 May Hill S. at Doncaster the following month before causing an upset when winning the G2 Rockfel S. at Newmarket in October. On that occasion, her tendency to drift left was curbed by her position against the stands' rail, but she did her best to throw the Nell Gwyn away by drifting from the far side towards the crowds in the closing stages. She even jinked off the gallop when the media came to visit in the build-up, but her trainer put her trait down to a need for her own space. She got plenty of that at Newmarket yesterday out in front under Michael Fenton, who allowed her to find her favored fence inside the final guarter. Drawing away up the rising ground, she had too many guns for the game runner-up. "As usual, she popped out and in front everything went straightfoward," Fenton explained. "I never saw another horse and the draw was ideal. She's very good and I was quietly confident the mile would suit her. You've just got to take it as it comes with her, but every time she's been in front she's been hard to pass." Trainer Pam Sly is considering supplementing Speciosa for the June 2 G1 Epsom Oaks to avoid the right-handed tracks of The Curragh and Ascot. "We've talked about the Oaks, as the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas is only three weeks away [June 28] and I'd like to let her down for a week or so," Sly added. "For me, she's going to get a mile and a quarter as the third dam produced Touching Wood and there's Alleged, Nijinsky and Sky Classic in there as well. Whether she'll like being held up I don't know, but the Irish Guineas and G1 Coronation S. [at Royal Ascot June 23] are right-handed and she does like to hang across to her left." She may meet runner-up Confidential Lady in the Oaks, according to trainer Sir Mark Prescott. "She's been beaten by a better horse," Prescott said. "We'll make up our minds whether we're bold enough to have a go at the Oaks, in which she might not stay, but I'd like to have a go." #### GEORGE BEST SINCE BEST

Susan Magnier, Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's George Washington (Ire) (Danehill) looks likely to be rated on 121 pounds by the official handicapper, making his G1 2000 Guineas performance the best since King's Best in 2000. Trainer Aidan O'Brien reported the colt to be none the worse for his exertions yesterday. "He seems to be fine this morning and in good form," O'Brien said. "He ate up last night and all the races such as the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas [at The Curragh May 27] and G1 St James's Palace S. [at Royal Ascot June 20] are open to him. To stretch him for the [June 3] G1 Epsom Derby might be selfish, when we weren't sure he'd get a mile, but everybody has got to get together and talk about it and decide what's going to happen." He also added that Horatio Nelson (Ire) (Danehill), who finished eighth, would be trained for the Epsom Classic. "We were happy with him and everything seems fine with him," O'Brien added. George Washington's 21/2length defeat of Sir Percy (GB) in Saturday's mile Classic at Newmarket impressed the British Horseracing Board's assessor Dominic Gardiner-Hill. "George Washington appears to have run to a mark of at least 121, which is the highest I've got recorded in the race since King's Best ran to 124 in 2000," he said.

#### **Percy Tired**

Anthony Pakenham's G1 2000 Guineas runner-up **Sir Percy (GB)** (Mark of Esteem {Ire}) was yesterday described by trainer Marcus Tregoning as a "bit tired" after his Newmarket exertions. Last year's G1 Dewhurst S. winner lost his unbeaten tag when beaten 2½ lengths by George Washington (Ire) in Saturday's Classic and is bound for the June 3 G1 Epsom Derby. "He ran a good race," the trainer told *PA Sport* yesterday. "He's a bit tired today, but I'm not surprised with the race, the noise and everything. It's some way off, but I think he'll go straight for the Derby. It seems the logical step. If it hadn't been for George Washington, he would have won nicely, but that's racing. We've just got to get on with the next target."





Gentlewave has common ground with that behemoth in that he has tough German bloodlines and is under the care of Andre Fabre, who has stamped his presence on this G1 Prix du Jockey-Club (French Derby) trial four times since 1988. Having beaten Numide by 11/2 lengths in the Listed Prix Maurice Caillault at Saint Cloud Mar. 18, he showed a smart turn of acceleration at this venue to come out on top of a blanket finish to the Apr. 17 G2 Prix Noailles and may hold stronger claims than stable companion Nordic Thunder. Trained in Germany last term, he finished second in the coveted G3 Preis der Winterfavoriten at Cologne in October, but disappointed when only fifth for his new connections in the Listed Prix François Mathet over this course Apr. 9. Despite his Maurice Caillault defeat, Numide is worth another chance, as he hails from the Jean-Claude Rouget barn successful here four times since 1997. Kentucky Dyanamite looked to have a bright future when winning a conditions event at Saint-Cloud last time Apr. 18 and is looking to give trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre his fourth renewal since 1995.

DERBY FIGURES SHATTER RECORDS Wagering on Saturday's GI Kentucky Derby shattered several records, including a North American mark for total betting on a single race--as a crowd of 157,536 packed into Churchill Downs to watch Barbaro win the Run for the Roses. The attendance mark was the second largest in the history of the race, trailing on the 163,628 that saw Cannonade win the 100th Derby in 1974. All-source total wagering on the Kentucky Derby soared to \$118,426,874. That figure shattered the North American record for wagering on a single race established in the 2005 Kentucky Derby. On-track wagering on the Kentucky Derby totaled a record \$12,075,504.

Also working over the turf for the Jim Murray, trainer Neil Drysdale's Always First (GB) (Barathea {Ire}) worked six furlongs in company in 1:16.80, while stablemate Macduff (GB) (Machiavellian), also working in company, went the same distance in 1:13.60. Macduff worked in company with Fourty Niners Son (Distorted Humor), who underwent ankle surgery after finishing ninth in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf. The five-year-old is being pointed to the June 10 GI Charles Whittingham H.

#### Derby Day a Record-Setter at HollyPark:

Hollywood Park handled a record \$26.7 million on Saturday's Kentucky Derby program, surpassing the mark of \$24.5 million set in 1999. The handle was the second-highest in the track's 67-year history, behind only Breeders' Cup day in 1997, when total handle was \$67,096,242. Saturday's on-track handle was \$4,907,421--up 12.6 percent from the 2005 figure--and the total handle of \$26,712,087 was up 22 percent from a year ago.
