Richard Strauss' G2 Prix Robert Papin winner New Girlfriend (Ire) (Diesis {GB}) will make her keenly awaited return in tomorrow's G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches at Longchamp. The bay filly looked top class when winning that Maisons-Laffitte contest in July, but flopped in the mud when only fifth in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville the following month and has not been out since. "The filly is very well," trainer Robert Collet told the Racing Post. "She has strengthened during the winter and has become a really powerful individual." Heading the usual strong overseas challenge are the Aidan O'Brien-trained duo Kamarinskaya (Storm Cat) and Beauty Bright (Ire) (Danehill), first and second, respectively, in the Apr. 15 G3 Leopardstown 1000 Guineas Trial, Jaber Abdullah's Newbury maiden scorer Silver Touch (Ire) (Dansili {GB}) is another poised to raid the kitty for trainer Mick Channon. Runner-up Orcadian visited most of the Roodeye before trying to pull himself up while in the lead at two-thirds distance, but a persistent Neil Callan galvanised extra effort from his reluctant charge and an impossible victory almost became reality in a thrilling renewal of this stamina-sapping contest. Orcadian was denied by a determined run from an admirably consistent old stager. The Whistling Teal responded to constant urging and came from off the pace to wear down the errant pacesetter nearing the line. The 10-year-old had posted a career best when chasing home Collier Hill (GB) in last term's G1 Irish St Leger, but had finished off the board in his last two starts, most recently when fifth in the Apr. 22 G3 John Porter S. at Newbury. This win doubled his group race tally. "It wasn't so much a race, but more of a war," explained Steve Drowne. "They went a terrific gallop and we were all at each other. He outbattled the second and he's a proper old horse." The Whistling Teal has a choice of options at the Royal Ascot meet, including the June 22 G1 Gold Cup, but his participation will hinge on track conditions, as he requires ease in the turf.

Cross Channel looked a filly with a bright future last summer when graduating on Newmarket's July Course, but gets the chance to redeem her reputation after two unplaced efforts at stakes level. While she may have found the test of the G1 Fillies' Mile coming too soon when fifth on the Rowley Mile in September, her tame effort when filling the same position in the Apr. 1 Listed Masaka S. on Kempton's polytrack is harder to forgive. This G1 Epsom Derby trial plays host to Sean Mulryan's G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud winner Linda's Lad, who bids to book his ticket to the June 3 Classic. One of France's top juveniles of 2006, he collected the G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp in September before his Saint-Cloud feat, but was only fourth on his return in the Apr. 17 G2 Prix Noailes at Longchamp. "He has definitely come on since his race at Longchamp and is very well," commented the owner's Racing Manager Herve Barjot. "While we were slightly disappointed with his last run, the race was not run to suit. He had to make the running, but he is a horse who likes to run behind a good pace, and he had no chance to take a second breath. Most of the others had a run under their belts and we are expecting a better performance this time." He shoulders a seven-pound penalty in the contest, but Barjot believes he can overcome the burden. "The Group 1 penalty is a slight worry, but he has that weight for a reason," he added. "He is a colt with a touch of quality and we hope that will be confirmed on Saturday. The left-handed track is definitely what he needs--he doesn't like going right-handed at courses like Longchamp. Good ground will be fine for him, but he has never run on very quick ground. Being by Sadler's Wells, the trip will be no problem for him. We hope to be in the first three and are confident he will run very well--if he does, he will head to Epsom for the Derby." Up against the French raider is Botteen, who beat Thursday's G3 Chester Vase winner Papal Bull (GB) in a Salisbury maiden in September.

Had a weak pattern last year, when moderate efforts twice sent him into a tailspin. This year he has been much more solid, and he moved up substantially when tried in grass sprints--no surprise when you look at Stolen Gold's sire profile. But Pure As Gold is up against it here; this one's on dirt, and his grass efforts wouldn't even be good enough.

Areyoutalkintome **Smokester**

Ran some very good figures last year, but recently has been showing the effects of 2 1/2 years of racing without a break--his good efforts are not as good, his bounces higher and the time between good ones getting longer. He did make a forward move last time, but coming back on only 13 days rest, we think he's more likely to back up now than go forward, and the bearing out last time ("bo") concerns us.

Cigar Pal **Benchmark**

Shows the classic sheet of the unsound horse--big efforts when fresh, short campaigns and long layoffs. He was able to follow up a good one with another last time, but that was on almost two months rest. Now he's off two efforts and has less rest, which means he's more likely to go back than make the necessary forward move.

Siren Lure Joyeux Danseur

Is by Joyeux Danseur, who was late developing himself, and so far has thrown the same. This one didn't start until late three, but has steadily improved since, running his race pretty much all the time, on any surface. The short-term pattern here is good, and he should run back to his top, but that probably won't be good enough-five pounds is worth one point on the Thoro-Graph scale, and he gives weight to everyone. Solid for a check, underlay in the win pool.

Secret Ridge (Brz) **Choctaw Ridge**

Came off a long layoff with an effort that was better than it looked--he was wide (4w, upper left) in a fast allowance. It's worth noting that back in Brazil this horse won his only other dirt start by eight lengths, with another 9 1/2 back to third, and his connections were so encouraged they never ran him back on dirt-nice management. It's also worth noting that trainer Lobo is not strong off layoffs, but very good next out-if you look in the sire profile, you'll see he has a \$5.41 ROI second off a layoff. Very live longshot, especially if the rider makes the light weight.

Prorunner Tejano Run 20-1

Has gradually improved, and last time ran the best race of his life to take a stakes at Turf Paradise. That's very likely to cause a bounce, since a lesser effort in January knocked him out for two races, and even a repeat of that last won't do it.

Oceanus (Brz) Rainbow Corner (Brz) 10-1

Is very similar to Areyoutalkintome, though a couple of points slower--he's been in training a long time, he was good early last year and he's showing signs of deterioration. Where he used to be able to string tops together he now bounces, and the efforts that cause the bounces now are not even tops. He does have decent time off into this, and that might help a little.

Thunder Touch Gulch 4-1

Ran some enormous figures last year, but managed to avoid doing so in graded races. Since this is exactly what we look for, we advised client Millenium Farms to buy him and they did, and sent him to California. After a short break and some minor problems that delayed his seasonal debut, he has trained well, and though Cerin is not a layoff trainer, there's a good chance Thunder Touch won't need his best to win this, even with the outside draw.

Bottom Line: Thunder Touch is the most likely winner, with Secret Ridge the live longshot.

CAL SENATE OKS POLYTRACK LEGISLATION

A bill that would require major racetracks in California to install a polymer synthetic type-racing surface by the end of 2007 sailed through the State Senate on May 11. SB 1464, authored by Sen. Jeff Denham (R-Merced), advances to the California Assembly on a vote of 31-4. The measure requires that the switch in surface be completed as a condition of issuing a license to any track that operates four weeks of continuous Thoroughbred racing in a calendar year. The tracks that would be affected under the existing allocation of racing dates in the state are Santa Anita, Hollywood Park, Golden Gate Fields, Bay Meadows and Del Mar. The bill follows a unanimous endorsement of the change to Polytrack, as it is known by trade name, by the California Horse Racing Board in February. Polytrack is a mixture of sand, synthetic fibers and recycled rubber coated with a wax substance to form the top layer of a racing surface that sits atop an elaborate drainage system. The CHRB believes that Polytrack creates a more consistent surface for horses to run on and will be safer for everyone. For the complete story, click here.
