PERCY POWER

A crowd of over 100,000 is expected at Epsom Downs today for the 227th renewal of the £1.25 million G1 Vodafone Derby, but few will have suffered the trials and tribulations that Sir Percy (GB) (Mark of Esteem {Ire}) has endured just getting there. Having pulled muscles after losing his unbeaten tag to George Washington (Ire) in the G1 2000 Guineas at Newmarket May 6, he looked unlikely to make the gig initially, but has made great strides at home to win the race against time. "I sat on him this morning and he was in great form," jockey Martin Dwyer said yesterday. "He's recovered well from his injury and, although it's never ideal, it's been done in the past." Bred for middle distances, Sir Percy won the G2 Vintage S. going seven furlongs at Goodwood last July, and ousted Horatio Nelson (Ire) (Danehill) in the G1 Dewhurst S. at Newmarket in October, then showed he retained his ability on his return in the mile Classic. He bids to become the first Guineas runner-up to go one better here since Grundy (Ire) in 1975. "Obviously, we thought we'd win at Newmarket, but we bumped into a very good horse...who was better on the day," trainer Marcus Tregoning said. "He changed his legs and hung to the left, but staved on really strongly up the hill and has beaten the rest very comfortably. It's usually a good pointer to the Derby and, in my heart of hearts, this horse stays." Epsom Derby cont. p3

SHIROCCO, SOUMILLON WEAR THE CROWN

Shirocco (Ger) (Monsun {Ger}) proved he can handle faster ground and left no doubts as to his status amongst Europe's elite when getting the better of chief rival Ouija Board (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom yesterday. His form was of the highest class even before he annexed the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Belmont in October, but most of his better performances had been on testing conditions. He certainly had those when winning the G1 Deutsches Derby and G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club in 2004 and in New York last October, and it had rained hard before his successful comeback in the G2 Jockey Club S. at Newmarket May 7. Alexandrova took three runs to break her maiden at two, but got the job done with a 10-length score at Tralee in August. Beaten a short head by Nannina (GB) in a bobbing finish to the G1 Fillies' Mile at Newmarket in September, she found **Short Skirt (GB)** (Diktat {GB}) too strong after stumbling at the start and struggling in the soft ground in the Musidora. Reversing that form comprehensively, she was detached in rear early by a confident Kieren Fallon and still had only one rival behind her on the downhill descent to Tattenham Corner. Angled wide as they rounded the final turn, she arrived full of run alongside the long-time leader Speciosa and the diminutive Rising Cross (GB) (Cape Cross {Ire}) passing the quarter pole before opening up in a matter of strides to settle the issue. "She was good today," commented John Magnier as he stood in the familiar surroundings of the winner's circle, adding, "This little bit of ground here is where we all want to be. She was bred to win the Oaks and she's won it, so we'll be careful with her."

Bucking The Odds...

For runner-up Rising Cross, who outran odds of 33-1, jockey George Baker said, "She traveled nicely throughout the race and I was just getting there a bit too soon, but then I saw Kieren upsides me and he flew by. She's done well to hang on for second, as she lost her balance a little bit and stumbled quite badly. She lost quite a bit of momentum, but she's a tough little thing." Speciosa led until being swamped at the quarter pole, but battled gamely to finish fourth. Her trainer, Pam Sly, was looking at a return to the scene of her Classic triumph as the next step. "When we got to the mileand-a-quarter mark, I could see she was going to get stuffed and she did," she told PA Sport. "But she has run a great race and she was coming back at the end. She's in [the June 23 G1 Coronation S.] at Royal Ascot, so we'll see how she is, and then there's the G1 Falmouth S. [at Newmarket July 12]." Adding intrigue to the cast is Hala Bek (Ire) (Halling), who has just a Newbury maiden success to his name Apr. 21. A dirty scope forced the Michael Jarvis-trained colt to miss the May 18 G2 Dante S. at York, but connections are willing to chance his inexperience in this test, which was won by the once-raced Lammtarra in 1995. "There is no doubt about it, he is potentially an extremely good horse, but this is the Derby and we'll find out on Saturday," said rider Philip Robinson.

Sir Michael Stoute has trained four Derby winners; the betting suggests that Freemason Lodge's best chance rests with **Papal Bull (GB)** (Montjeu {Ire}), who made the jump from a Newmarket handicap score Apr. 20 to success in the May 11 G3 Chester Vase, a race which has failed to throw up the winner of this since Shergar in 1981. "He's gone from strength to strength and has really improved," jockey Robert Winston said. "It looks a wide-open race and we hope to get a true gallop and a little luck in running."

Barastraight (GB) (Barathea {Ire}), who captured the Apr. 23 G3 Prix la Force at Longchamp, has been supplemented, while Numide (Fr) (Highest Honor {Fr}) bested subsequent G1 Derby Italiano hero Gentlewave (Ire) in the G2 Prix Hocquart at that venue last time May 8. The duo provide a formidable two-pronged attack for trainer Jean-Claude Rouget, still seeking a belated first victory in this Classic. Of the British raiders, Hazeymm (Ire) (Marju {Ire}) will lack nothing for toughness. He failed by a head to beat Linda's Lad (GB) in the G3 Lingfield Derby Trial May 13 and skips a rematch with that rival in today's G1 Epsom Derby to chance his hand here. "He's a strange little horse, as he wouldn't beat me at home," trainer Mick Channon commented. "Every time he's gone racing, he's just done enough. Sheikh Ahmed decided to go to France instead of Epsom and he has a decent chance. It's very open and he's a solid, reliable yardstick, who's been on all sorts of tracks and is used to travelling. He's a smashing, hardy horse."

onship season, Countess Diana won twice and was second in the GII Nassau County Breeders' Cup S. from eight starts and was purchased by Bill Casner and Kenny Troutt for \$1.8 million out of the 2000 Keeneland November sale.
