Things nearly went amiss for Team Jazil right at the break, when Jazil brushed the gate, causing jockey Fernando Jara to lose his right iron. But the rider cooly reached down, regained the stirrup and guided his mount over towards the inside to save some ground.

On the front end, Bob and John, the highest-priced favorite in the history of the Belmont at \$4.70-1, set the pace in advance of **High Finance** (Talk Is Money), who took advantage of an opening left at the rail. The pace was honest enough as they covered the opening

quarter mile in :23.02 and the half in :47.36 into a strong headwind down the Belmont backstretch. About midway through the 12-furlong journey, Jara angled Jazil off the rail and they began to pick up horses, improving to a midpack position at the half-mile pole. Swung out six wide around the sweeping turn, Jazil hit the front outside of Bluegrass Cat, the \$4.90-1 third choice, at the five-sixteenths pole. The two dueled from the quarter pole to midstretch, but Jazil kept finding on the lead and inched clear late. It looked like he was moving easily. "When he came next to Bluegrass Cat, it didn't look like anyone else was gaining quickly. I was happy to be there," McLaughlin explained. "That's what everybody talks about. Deep closers can't win, so we had to be there with 3/8 left to go." Sunriver was onepaced in the final two furlongs, but stayed on for third, 1 1/4 lengths ahead of GI Kentucky Derby third-place finisher Steppenwolfer. "My horse broke good. I put him in good position early and he was comfortable," said Sunriver's rider Rafael Bejarano. "My horse fought hard. I was happy with his effort."

Steady Progression...

A distant sixth to Noonmark in his Oct. 23 bow at Belmont Park, Jazil improved in his second career outing, making up nearly all of an 18-length deficit to run Steppenwolfer (Aptitude) to a nost going seven furlongs at Aqueduct Nov. 12. After breaking his maiden in an off the turf event at the Big A Dec. 7, the \$725,000 Keeneland September yearling was runner-up to Corinthian in Gulfstream allowance company Feb. 2, but turned in a clunker when seventh in the GII Fountain of Youth S. Mar. 4, but reportedly bled through Lasix that afternoon. He proved that race was an aberration when he flew home to be second to Bob and John (Seeking the Gold) in a sloppy renewal of the GI Wood Memorial Apr. 8. The Shadwell runner got more practice dodging traffic in the GI Kentucky Derby and got a near perfect trip, rallying from 20th and last to dead-heat with Brother Derek for fourth money. Some rejected Jazil as a Belmont proposition, given his clean trip in the Derby, his deep-closing running style and a training schedule disrupted by the recent inclement weather.

A Powerful Pedigree...

Hailing from one of the preeminent families in the stud book, Better Than Honour was purchased for \$750,000 out of the 1997 Keeneland July sale by John Kimmel on behalf of owner Robert Waxman and became a successful racehorse, winning the GII Demoiselle S. in 1998 before finishing third in the GI Acorn S. and GI Mother Goose S. the following season. She has also become a commercial success. Prior to Jazil, she produced Teeming (Storm Cat), who made \$1.5 million as a weanling at the 2001 Keeneland November sale and Magnificent Honour (A.P. Indy), a \$925,000 graduate of the 2003 Keeneland September sale. Her foal of 2004, Rags to Riches (A.P. Indy), was knocked down for \$1.9 million to Demi O'Byrne at last year's September sale. Better Than Honour was sold at the 2004 Keeneland November sale for \$2 million to the BBA Ireland carrying a colt by Mineshaft. Her foal of 2006 is a colt by Giant's Causeway.




