Confidential Lady was kept busy as a two year old, taking minor seven-furlong events at Catterick and Beverley before stepping up in class to take the Listed Star S. at Sandown in July. Runner-up to Nasheej in the G3 Sweet Solera S. at Newmarket in August next time, she regained the winning thread in the G3 Prix du Calvados at Deauville later that month, but her season culminated with an uncharacteristically poor run when 10th in the Oct. 2 G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at Longchamp. Her veteran trainer broke new ground when he ran the daughter of Singspiel in the May 7 G1 1000 Guineas at Newmarket on seasonal debut and she justified that decision by finishing second to Speciosa (Ire). The homebred may have paid the price for forcing a strong gallop over heavy ground when fading into sixth in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas at The Curragh last time May 28, but bounced back here to record a career high. With different tactics here, she was settled in midfield along the rail through the early fractions. Taking closer order as the field straightened for home, jockey Seb Sanders angled her out to make a challenge at the quarter pole. Collaring Germance under a drive with 150 yards remaining, she was kept up to her work in the final sixteenth to establish a decisive margin at the line. "I'm sorry the owners [David and Patricia Thompson] and the trainer could not be here today as they would have enjoyed the moment," explained Chevelev Park Stud's Chris Richardson. "Sir Mark told us she was doing great beforehand and was confident she would run a big race. She ran a great race and certainly wasn't stopping in the 1000 Guineas, but the ground was against her in Ireland. We had a good draw [today], a suitable pace and it worked to perfection. Sanders' Victory Tempered By Ban

Seb Sanders' winning ride aboard Confidential Lady came at some cost as the rider will be forced to sit out the entire Royal Ascot meet after incurring an eight-day ban for using his whip 32 times on the winner. Senior steward Jean-Pierre Colombo was not on duty, but explained the official decision, "Sanders hit Confidential Lady 32 times which was four times over the limit stated in the French rules of racing," he told *Racing Post.* "These [rules] have been created to protect the horse and we have felt it necessary to suspend him for eight days which will sadly mean Sanders missing the whole of the Royal Ascot meeting."

Rouget Gracious In Defeat

While trainer Sir Mark Prescott was securing a maiden Classic triumph, Jean-Claude Rouget was left to rue another missed opportunity as runner-up Germance fared best of his four entries. The Pau-based conditioner still awaits a first Classic win, but was fulsome in his praise for both winner and second. "I have no excuses, Germance was beaten by a better filly on the day," he said. "Maybe the outside draw was not that good as she had to be used a little early, but hats off to the winner. After running in two Guineas and then coming back here after another tough fight it certainly shows that, at this time of year, the English horses are tougher competitors."




