BATTLE OF THE B'S IN STEPHEN FOSTER

Fred Bradley's **Brass Hat** (Prized) and Gary Broad's **Buzzards Bay** (Marco Bay), the co-highweights at 121 pounds, meet for the first time in this afternoon's GI Stephen Foster H. on Super Saturday at Churchill Downs. Brass Hat, who made his career debut for a \$15,000 tag and broke his maiden in the Rushaway S. in 2004, is the Midwest's top handicap horse and enters this in the best form of his career. Since returning from an extended layoff in December, the bay rattled off a trio of stakes wins, including a first Grade I success in the Donn H. at Gulfstream Feb. 4. Sent to Dubai for racing's richest prize, the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 25, he led well into the final furlong before being overhauled by Electrocutionist. That result is the subject of some dispute, but what cannot be denied is that Brass Hat is ready to roll this afternoon. "We never were concerned about shipping him over to Dubai and then coming back and not being able to perform," said trainer William "Buff" Bradley. "We gave him a month off after we got him back and he loved that. He gained weight and he's come back super." The World Cup has been a productive springboard for the Foster. Street Cry (Ire) won in en route to victory in 2002, while Victory Gallop, third in the '99 World Cup, set a track record in taking that year's Foster. Silver Charm, victorious in Dubai in 1998, returned to be runner-up to Awesome Again in this three months later. Buzzards Bay, whose lone previous trip to Louisville resulted in a fifth in last year's Run for the Roses, has also never been better. Winless in five subsequent post-Derby starts, the attractive chestnut rolled to a four-length success in the GIII All-American H. at Golden Gate Feb. 20, then set a fast pace in the Apr. 8 GII Oaklawn H. last out and pulled away to take it by 6 1/2 lengths.

PHIPPS THERE FOR THE TAKING

Take D' Tour (Tour d'Or) had trouble winning allowance races at places like Canterbury Park and Hawthorne back in 2004, but that was then and this is now. The chestnut mare, who posted a front-running, 5 1/2-length victory over **Balletto (UAE)** (Timber Country) in the GII Shuvee H. May 21, shoots for her first score at the highest level in this afternoon's GI Ogden Phipps H. at Belmont Park. "The Shuvee was attractive because it was a one-turn mile," said trainer David Fawkes. Take D' Tour had won her two previous allowance tests at Gulfstream Park going that distance. "Obviously she was meeting much better horses than the ones she beat in Florida, but she was doing so well going into the race I had to feel confident." But today's competition should prove much saltier. Balletto, winner of the GI Frizette S. in 2004, is joined by fellow Grade I winners **Spun Sugar** (Awesome Again) and **In the Gold** (Golden Missile) and Grade II heroines **Bending Strings** (American Chance) and **Nothing But Fun** (Dixie Union). Trainer Todd Pletcher, who saddled Ashado to a victory in last year's Phipps, sends out Spun Sugar, who bested Happy Ticket in a thrilling renewal of Oaklawn's GI Apple Blossom H. Apr 8, and has been pointed for this ever since. "After the Apple Blossom, we circled the Ogden Phipps," the champion conditioner commented. "She's trained well." In the Gold earned her Grade I in last year's Gazelle S., but is winless in five starts since.

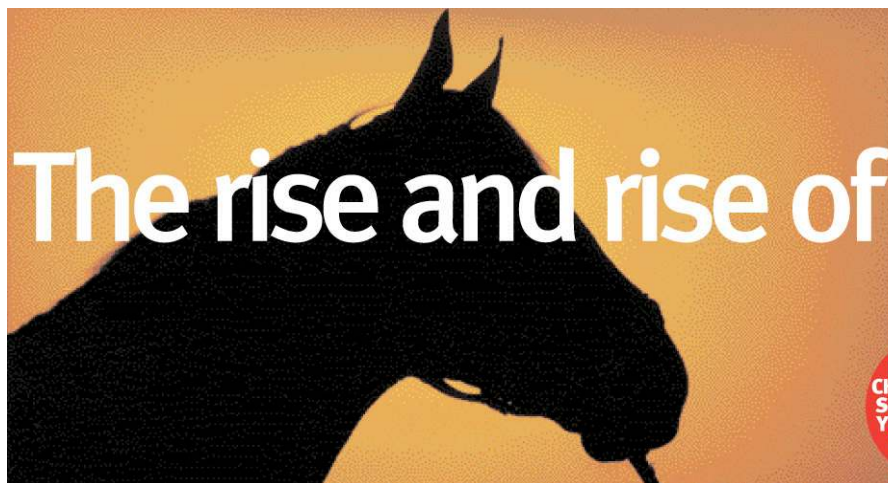

GI Ballerina H. winner **Happy Ticket**, who won 10 of her first 11 starts, looks to get back on track after losing four of her last five. The bay finished off the board for the only time in her career when 11th in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. She opened 2006 with a handy score over Louisiana-bred stakes company Feb. 18, then was beaten a neck in both the Mar. 11 GIII Azeri BC S. and the Apr. 8 GI Apple Blossom H. "She had two tough races back-to-back," said trainer Andrew Leggio Jr. "We gave her about a 10-day vacation after that particular race. We got her right back on track after 10 days and we've been going forward since." On the other hand, **Oonagh Maccool** goes for her fourth straight victory. Beaten just once in six starts, the chestnut filly took the Mar 25 GII Rampart H. at Gulfstream and the May 5 GII Louisville BC H. at Churchill.

Brilliant bids to make it a perfect three-for-three on the lawn. The dark bay colt hit the board in all five dirt starts, then switched to the turf and captured a Churchill allowance Apr. 29. He bested **Obi Wan Kenobi** by 1 3/4 lengths to make it two in a row May 20, and stretches out off those two mile tests. "What encourages me about him is that the colt's demeanor and temperament is really exactly what you look for," said trainer Neil Howard. "I guess the best way to say it is that if he turns out to be pretty serious horse on the grass, it wouldn't shock me."

Demoted to eighth after crossing the line first in a maiden race at Gulfstream in March, **Yate's Black Cat** was tossed into the Apr. 20 Forerunner S. at Keeneland off the effort and closed to be second behind the ill-fated Up an Octave, with **Tahoe Warrior** another neck back in third. He came back to break his maiden in a Churchill allowance May 14, beating **Mercurius** by a length. **Storm Treasure** tries the grass for the first time after running 11th in the GI Kentucky Derby.

Manduro Added to Prince of Wales's...

Baron Georg von Ullmann's **Manduro (Ger)** (Monsun {Ger}) was yesterday supplemented for Wednesday's G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot, for which 10 entries stood their ground at the five-day stage. Conditioner Andre Fabre paid the £25,000 fee to take on Roldvale Limited's **David Junior** (Pleasant Tap) and Godolphin's **Electrocutionist** (Red Ransom) with the Apr. 9 G2 Prix d'Harcourt scorer, who was second in the May 21 G1 Prix d'Ispahan at Longchamp last time out. Von Ullmann's Racing Manager Paul Harley told *PA Sport* yesterday, "Mr. Fabre is absolutely delighted with him. The ground was pretty quick the other day in Paris when he was second in the Prix d'Ispahan, so it should be fine for him." Ed Dunlop has left in Lord Derby's **Ouija Board (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), but no decision has been made yet as to whether the five-year-old will line up in the 10-furlong contest or tackle Saturday's G2 Hardwicke S. over a mile and a half. After a pair of Group 3 wins in France, Last Tycoon came across the Channel to annex the G1 King's Stand S. and the G1 William Hill Sprint Championship, then defeated a top field in the Breeders' Cup at Santa Anita. He was named champion sprinter in both England and France, and retired with a record of 13-8-0-0 and earnings of \$689,543. Entering stud in 1987 at Coolmore Stud in Ireland, Last Tycoon sired G1 St. James's Palace S. winner Marju (Ire) in his first crop, and was later represented by European Group 1 winners Bigstone (Ire), Ezzoud (Ire), Lady of Chad (Ire) and Taipan (Ire). From his travels to the Southern Hemisphere, the grandson of Northern Dancer sired 1994 Australian Horse of the Year Mahogany (Aus) and two Horses of the Year in New Zealand, O'Reilly (NZ) in 1997 and Tycoon Lil (Aus) in 1998. To date, he is the sire of at least 76 stakes winners from 15 crops of racing age. Last Tycoon is also the broodmare sire of Group/Grade 1 winners Vintage Tipple (Ire), King's Drama (Ire), Keltos (Fr), The Deputy (Ire) and King Kamehameha (Jpn).
