DIONISIA CAPTURES ITALIAN OAKS

Dionisia (Tejano Run) produced a scintillating display to earn herself a place among the great winners of the G1 Oaks d'Italia and completed an afternoon Group 1 double for jockey Christophe Soumillon yesterday in Milan. Breaking with her customary enthusiasm, Dionisia was restrained by Soumillon to race in a stalking third early and stayed in the catbird seat until the top of the stretch. Launched passing the three-furlong marker, her acceleration carried her to the front in a matter of strides and she opened up with a surge to seal the victory. The bay filly failed to land a blow in the May 14 G2 Premio Regina Elena (Italian 1000 Guineas), but without drawing breath, she was back where she belonged with an easy win in the May 27 G3 Premio Mario Incisa. The filly came close to registering a success at the top level in October when second in the San Siro's feature event for two-year-olds, the G1 Gran Criterium. That game effort enhanced her juvenile record, which included wins in the Listed Premio Vittorio Crespi and Listed Premio Coolmore in Milan and the Listed Premio Repubbliche Marinare Tattersalls and Listed Criterium Femminile in Rome. Stakes win number five came in the Apr. 23 Listed Premio Torricola at the Capannelle.

BRASS HAT FINE AFTER FOSTER LOSS Trainer William "Buff" Bradley said that Brass Hat (Prized), a disappointing dead-heat fifth in Saturday's GI Stephen Foster H. at Churchill Downs, was understandably tired after the race but was otherwise fine. "He drank a bucket of water, which is more than he normally does," said Bradley of the five-year-old, who went off the 5-2 second choice in the Stephen Foster in his first race since returning from his disputed runner-up finish in the Mar. 25 G1 Dubai World Cup. "Coming off a layoff like that and doing what we did, you face those kinds of horses at top weight, I think it was just a little too much for him," Bradley added. Meanwhile, the trainer of the race's 91-1 upsetter Seek Gold (Touch Gold), Ron Moguett, said the significance of his charge's win was sinking in. "If you don't believe there is a racing god, then you have to now, right?," said Moquett. "If we lined back up with all those horses, I don't know that we could be beat 'em. But you know what? We did it [Saturday], and I thank God for that." Seek Gold's victory came at the expense of trainer Murray Johnson's Perfect Drift (Dynaformer), who was just caught on the line by his rival. Johnson said that he would now map out a campaign to get the seven-year-old gelding back to Churchill in November for an unprecedented fifth consecutive bid for the GI Breeders' Cup Classic.


