was back in the sunshine yesterday when rocketing to a twolength success in a stellar renewal of the G1 Coronation S. at Royal Ascot. The lethal weapon of last year's G1 Fillies' Mile heroine is her finishing kick and, while that was blunted in the May 7 Newmarket Classic, it

was in full effect here. Sent on a daring stretch run up the inner by Jimmy Fortune, the 6-1 joint-favorite was in total command throughout the final furlong as **Flashy Wings (GB)** (Zafonic) chased in vain. "She's a beautiful filly and did nothing but progress last year," Fortune said. "She beat the best around at the back-end, but in the spring she just didn't come to herself. She didn't like the ground at Newmarket and it's a good job I wasn't too hard on her there, as today she showed what a very good filly she is." **Cont. p2**

Burdened with a seven-pound penalty over a trip short of his very best Tuesday, he defied the odds to win the G2 King's Stand S. and book his ticket to a place in the history books, rewritten after the feats of Choisir (Aus) in 2003. But, where Choisir was not counted as the best of his country's speedsters before his Ascot exploits, Takeover Target arrived in Berk-

shire at the top of the domestic tree. He started this year in imperious form when taking Flemington's major sprints, the Feb. 4 G1 Lightning S. and Mar. 11 G1 Newmarket H. Success here would take him through the £1-million barrier, as well as making him a household name. "His best distance is six furlongs and I think he'll appreciate that bit further," jockey Jay Ford said. Cont. p4

CROWNED QUEEN Nannina's turn of foot was on immediate display on debut at Pontefract last June, but she suffered reversals in the G2 Cherry Hinton S. at Newmarket and G3 Princess Margaret S. at Newbury the following month. Back in the winner's spot after the G3 Prestige S. at Goodwood in August, she got the better of subsequent G1 Epsom Oaks heroine Alexandrova (Ire) after a memorable tussle in the Fillies' Mile at Newmarket in September. If the Guineas was a non-event, all the ingredients were in place yesterday, and she enjoyed the perfect trip under cover in middivision as Speciosa (Ire) (Danehill Dancer (Ire)) carted the field along with her customary zest. Finding a golden rail in the straight, she swamped the long-time leader with 11/2 furlongs remaining and was soon clear as Flashy Wings led the late cavalry charge out wide. "We wanted fast ground at Newmarket and it rained all night, so she hated it," trainer John Gosden commented. "She'd worked really well before that, but we didn't want to abuse her as there was always the Coronation. It was a peach of a ride and the plan was always to try and get lucky up the inner. Cheveley Park are fabulous breeders and have won the championship fillies' mile race by two lengths, so full credit to them and to their young stallion Medicean." Nannina is to be aimed at the G1 Sussex S. at Goodwood Aug. 2. Trainer Pam Sly revealed that the 1000 Guineas heroine Speciosa would enjoy a vacation after tiring late to finish ninth. "I think probably the ground was a little bit quick for her," Sly explained. "She's going to have a rest now and come back for the autumn, when there should be a bit of give in the ground." Papal Bull has made giant strides since taking a Newmarket handicap in his three-year-old bow Apr. 20. He bested Dragon Dancer (GB) by a comfortable 3/4length margin in the May 11 G3 Chester Vase, but was denied a chance to confirm that form when 10th in the G1 Vodafone Derby June 3. Breaking smartly here, he was restrained by Kieren Fallon off the moderate early fractions set by Red Rocks and was forced to race without cover. He had to be niggled to stay on the tail of that rival, but was set alight challenging three wide on the final turn. Narrowly in front when hanging away from the whip and into Red Rocks in the closing stages, he found extra when straightened and was the comfortable victor in the end. "He's growing up now and I think he's got a big future," Fallon said. "These Montjeus just get better and better and, when they keep improving like this, you never know how good they are going to be." There was a distinct sense of deja vu in this opener of the fourth day of the Royal meeting, as Sander Camillo emulated her connections' La Chunga in dropping her maiden tag in this competitive affair. Like that filly, she had been well supported on debut, but failed to get off the mark when fourth on a rain-softened surface at Newmarket May 26. Encountering contrasting conditions here, she justified the stable buzz by showing early dash to race prominently under Frankie Dettori before shaking loose at the quarter pole. Asserting from there, she was beyond recall as Silk Blossom made late progress to fill the runner-up spot. "Her homework has been unbelievable," Dettori commented. "We were kind of shocked when she got beat first time, but we can blame the ground for that and Jeremy [Noseda] was full of hope." Soapy Danger survived a stewards' inquiry to capture this marathon prize. He has been a revelation since stepping up to a mile and a half, winning at Beverley Apr. 19 and finishing runner-up at Leicester 10 days later. He accounted for a Haydock handicap last time June 10 and earned his first stakes victory here. Lazy out of the gates, he was rousted awake by Kevin Darley and recovered to race behind the early leaders. Ridden on the approach to the final turn, he took time to organize, but responded with a surge to lead passing the quarter pole. Veering across the long-time leader Galient soon after, he put enough distance between himself and that rallying rival to satisfy the officials, who let the result stand. "He's been very consistent and, although he's not a stayer physically or on pedigree, he's a lazy horse with a very laid-back attitude," commented Mark Johnston, winning his fourth renewal since 2001. "We've seen that to the extreme today and you would never believe he was in trouble six out when you see the way he's gone away at the finish." If there is a potential class act amongst the home team, it could be Amadeus Wolf. He faces a tough task attempting to become the first sophomore to best his elders since Atraf (GB) took the race when it was known as the Cork and Orrery S. in 1996. The threeyear-old demonstrated the necessary speed when winning the G2 Gimcrack S. in August and G1 Middle Park S. in October, and was far from disgraced when seventh in the G1 2000 Guineas over a mile May 6. Trainer Kevin Ryan believes the drop back to six will prove the key. "He's a very uncomplicated horse and he's in great order," he said. Godolphin are currently winless at the meeting, but in Iffraaj they have a potent force. He recorded a time just short of that recorded by last year's winner Cape of Good Hope (GB) when winning the Wokingham H. at this meeting at York 12 months ago, but failed to handle rain-softened ground when down the field in the G1 July Cup the following month. Back to winning ways in the G2 Park S. at Doncaster in September, he encountered testing ground again when off the board in the G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp in October. "I like this horse--he is very honest and has plenty of speed," trainer Saeed bin Suroor said. "This is his first race of the year and he is almost ready--I think he is a nice horse for the future."

Supporting the Australian cause is Garry Chittick's Glamour Puss, who has around a length to find on Takeover Target on her running when seventh in the King's Stand. She took the G1 Goodwood H. and G1 Salinger S. in 2005 and takes another shot at her archrival. "She has come through her first run tremendously well and [trainer] Danny [O'Brien] couldn't be any happier with her," Chittick told New Zealand Thoroughbred Marketing. "She usually takes a run to get to her best form, and this is the main race we brought her to Europe for." Michael Hill's evergreen Quito is in the form of his life, having won the Listed John of Gaunt S. at Haydock last time June 8. "He seemed as good as ever last time and he's still very well," trainer D. W. Chapman told PA Sport. "We'll give them all a run for their money anyway."

Godolphin rely on one of their biggest hopes for 2006 in Shawanda here. Campaigned by Alain de Royer-Dupre last term, she rose to the heights with an emphatic five-length success in the G1 Irish Oaks at The Curragh in July. She made light work of her opposition in the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp in September and was injured when sixth behind Hurricane Run (Ire) in a strong renewal of the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe back at that venue the following month. Sir Michael Stoute has won this three times and covers all bases with a trio headed by Maraahel, who was runner-up to Bandari in this race 12 months ago before finishing third behind Electrocutionist in the G1 Juddmonte International S. at York in August. He warmed up for this with an easy score in the G3 Ormonde S. at Chester May 11. Last year's G2 Great Voltigeur S. winner Hard **Top** ran better than his latest fifth placing in the June 4 G2 Grand Prix de Chantilly suggests, while the Listed Festival S. runner-up Mountain High completes the Freemason Lodge hand.

Argentina has moved on to the second phase of the FIFA World Cup, and Argentina makes her move to the East Coast. Multiple Group 1-placed in France last year, the Irish-bred four-year-old came up short in three outings in California, all graded stakes. She missed by a half-length as the runner-up in the GII Santa Ana H. Mar. 26 in her U.S. bow, then finished fourth in the GII Santa Barbara H. Apr. 22. The Wildenstein homebred had the lead late before surrendering to be third in the GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. May 29 at Hollywood, and the sweeping contours of Belmont's turf course should be just the tonic. Angara went off form following her victory in the 2005 GI Beverly D. S., finishing off the board in her final three starts for trainer Patrick Biancone. Purchased privately after RNA'ing for \$2.2 million at FTKNOV, the bay ran sixth in her first start for the Sangster family and trainer Bill Mott, the GIII Beaugay H. at Aqueduct Apr. 29. She rallied to be third by 1 3/4 lengths in the GII Sheepshead Bay H. over this course May 27 and should move forward off that. Noble Stella has been the pacesetter in her last two, taking the GIII Bewitch S. at Keeneland Apr. 26, but just failing to see off Honey Ryder when second in the Sheepshead Bay H. "She ran a very gutsy race...and she seemed to like the course," trainer Roger Attfield said. "Those are the reasons we're coming back. I'd love to win a Grade II race with her."

PASEANA DIES IN ARGENTINA Two-time Eclipse Award winner and Hall of Fame member Paseana (Arg) (Ahmad {Arg}--Pasiflin {Arg}, by Flintham {Arg}) died June 21 at Dr. Ignacio Pavlovsky's Haras San Ignacio de Loyola in Argentina, according to The Blood-Horse. "She died from hemorrhaging following a ruptured blood vessel in her abdomen," Pavlovsky told the publication. "It was very sad." Foaled in 1987, the bay was a Group 1 winner in her native land before being purchased by Sid and Jenny Craig. Under the tutelage of Ron McAnally, Paseana became a standout in the U.S., capturing 14 of 28 starts in this country and finishing second in an additional 10. She received her first Eclipse Award as the nation's top older mare in 1992, after a season in which she captured the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff, GI Apple Blossom H., GI Santa Margarita Invitational H., GI Vanity Invitational H., GI Santa Maria H. and GI Milady H. In 1993, she doubled up victories in the Apple Blossom and the Milady, as well as winning the GI Spinster S. and finishing second in the Breeders' Cup. After earning another Eclipse for 1993, Paseana stayed in training for two additional seasons before finally being retired in 1995 with \$3,115,012 earned on these shores. She was plagued by fertility problems during her breeding career and produced only one foal, the six-year-old Paseana's Girl (Arg) (Lode), who is now a broodmare for the Craigs.

### CHRB Leads Strategic Planning Discussion:

The California Horse Racing Board held its first public meeting Thursday on strategic planning for the future of racing in the state, with an emphasis on developing alternatives should any of the privately owned racetracks cease conducting racing. "There is no secret that two of our racetracks [Bay Meadows and Hollywood] have been purchased and may be converted to alternative non-racing uses," said Board Chairman Richard B. Shapiro. "Given the possibility that two or possibly even more tracks could close sometime in the future, it is prudent for this industry to look at all the options--to create and study possible alternatives to ensure prosperity for California horse racing. Recognizing that any deviation from the current racing facilities would entail long lead times, and possibly legislation, it seems like a good idea to get a jump on it." Representatives at Fairplex Park presented a proposed \$100-million project that would involve expanding the main oval and installing a synthetic surface, as well as putting in a turf course and expanding the grandstand. Cliff Goodrich, the former president of Santa Anita and Arlington Park, who now serves as a consultant for Fairplex Park, said in order to justify this kind of investment, Fairplex would require 20 weeks of racing (17 more weeks than its current allotment), or a minimum of 12 weeks of racing supplemented by revenue equating to eight weeks of racing. The sources of the alternative revenue would need to be negotiated and Goodrich cautioned, "Fairplex would require a one- or two-year headstart to do what needs to be done. For that reason, I would encourage the Board to begin issuing multi-year race date allocations--perhaps as long as a five-year calendar." In the past, management and potential investors in Los Alamitos Race Course have discussed similar plans to expand that property and acquire Thoroughbred racing dates were Hollywood Park to close. In a reference to that rival proposal, Goodrich advised the racing commissioners that only one project could be financially viable. "Fairplex Park and Los Alamitos could not spend \$200 million [\$100 million per property] and split the [Hollywood] dates," said Goodrich. "One of the two would have to prevail."
