Owners James and Alice Sapara found a little bit of heaven at Woodbine yesterday afternoon. Bidding for

their first victory in Canada's most prestigious event, the Alberta natives pinned their hopes for the 147th running of the Queen's Plate on Edenwold (Southern Halo), and they were not disappointed. Sent off at generous odds of 16-1, the chestnut colt joined front-running 4-1 shot Sterwins (Runaway Groom) as they headed into the far turn and dueled with that rival all the way to the wire to prevail by a determined 3/4 of a length. "Mrs. Sapara didn't leave me with much of a choice," said winning jockey Emile Ramsammy, who dyed his hair to match the Sapara's silks. "She said we will win it, and that was

the plan." Added James Sapara, "It's nice not to be the favorite--I was pretty calm and relaxed." **Wanna Runner** (El Corredor), sent off the 3-2 chalk, pressed the pace early before dropping back to 10th. "[Jockey Victor Espinoza] said, at the five-eighths pole, he acted like a horse that might have bled," trainer Bob Baffert remarked. "We're going to scope him." **Cont. p2**

DEEP IMPACT WOWS 'EM IN JAPAN FINALE

Some 80,000 Japanese fans braved the rain at Kyoto Racecourse to bid farewell to **Deep Impact (Jpn)** (Sunday Silence) in yesterday's G1 Takarazuka Kinen, and the reigning Horse of the Year didn't let them down, delivering a compelling performance under a confident Yutaka Take ride. In his final domestic appearance before shipping to Europe to tackle the Oct. 1 G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, the four-year-old superstar was given much to do as he settled second last through the opening furlongs. Fanned wide entering the straight, he came charging down the center of the course and easily wore down the game pacesetter **Balance of Game (Jpn)** (Fusaichi Concorde), who was caught late by **Narita Century (Jpn)** (Tony Bin {Ire}) for place honors. **Cont. p5**

Pride, successful in the G3 Prix Allez France in May of 2004 and in the G2 Prix du Conseil de Paris in Octo-



ber of that year, finished runner-up to Bago (Fr), before being demoted to sixth, in the G1 Prix Ganay last April. She put in a rare disappointing effort when sixth in the G1 Coronation Cup at Epsom in June, but was back to winning ways in the G2 Prix Jean Romanet in August, and the bay mare counted Alkaased and Shirocco (Ger) among her victims in the G2 Prix Foy the following month. Seventh in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe in early October, she rebounded from that effort and

came to the fore on the international stage when runner-up in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket 13 days later and again in the G1 Hong Kong Cup in December. Fourth on her comeback in the Apr. 30 Prix Ganay, she got her picture taken again after the G2 Prix Corrida at this track last time May 29. Content to rate off the tempo carved out by the rabbit Petrograd (Peintre Celebre), she allowed Hurricane Run first crack in the straight. But, after that rival had seen off Policy Maker (Sadler's Wells), Pride arrived with a flourish to claim his notable scalp. "I had to decide between Wednesday's G1 Prince of Wales's S. and this, but I feared the firm ground at Ascot and knew the shape of this race would be ideal, with the two pacemakers," Alain de Royer-Dupre said. "She likes to run at others and received a superb ride from Christophe. The plan beforehand was to aim at the G1 Yorkshire Oaks [at York Aug. 23], but now she has won a Group 1, we'll take our time to decide." Hurricane Run's owner Michael Tabor was on hand to witnessed the Arc hero's defeat. "You could see that he was not traveling as well as he usually does and that is a bit of a mystery," Tabor said. "As far as I know, the plan was go to Ascot for the [July 29] G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S., and that hasn't changed."

Edenwold was named Canada's champion two-yearold last year after reeling off wins in the Colin S. in July, Vanadal S. in August and Simcoe S. in September. He ended the season with off-the-board finishes in the Nov. 10 Coronation Futurity and Nov. 26 Display S., and was given a winter break. Beaten a neck by Atlas Shrugs (Compadre) in his return, the May 6 Queenston S., he was sent off at even-money in the June 4 Plate Trial, but tired to be fourth, leaving the impression that the 1 1/4 miles of the Queen's Plate would be a trip too far. It certainly didn't look like the race would set up for him. Sterwins broke sharply and sped right to the lead, with Edenwold sitting just off his heels through seemingly suicidal fractions of :22.73 and :45.98. The Sovereign Award winner slipped through along the rail to challenge after six furlongs in 1:11.28 and, although he dawdled through a final half in :54.02, had only the pacesetter to deal with down the lane, battling his way to a narrow decision and making Josie Carroll the very first woman to train a Queen's Plate winner. 

Steve Asmussen faces a six-month suspension and a \$2,500 fine after the Louisiana Racing Commission upheld an earlier decision stemming from a positive test for Mepivicaine on one of his runners following a race at Evangeline Downs Mar. 24. The suspension, which would be recognized in all racing jurisdictions, is to begin July 10 to give Asmussen, the second leading trainer in wins and earnings in the United States this year, an option to seek a court hearing. The commission issued its ruling June 23. Asmussen has led the nation's trainers in victories the past two years, winning a record-breaking 555 races in 2004. Mepivicaine, a Class 2 drug described as a local anesthetic with the potential to affect performance, was detected in tests of No End in Sight, who ran eighth in a race at Evangeline. An initial ruling was issued May 18. Asmussen told the Ft. Worth Star-Telegram that he wasn't at Evangeline Downs when the horse ran and did not authorize treating No End in Sight with Mepivicaine. However, he acknowledged trainer responsibility and said he has not decided whether to appeal.

"They have given everything of themselves to the track and to horse racing. They should be proud of themselves, and I congratulate them both." The Indiana natives first got into horse racing in the 1940s. Warren, 84, has saddled more than 1,350 winners. He captured the 1969 Gold Cup with Figonero (Arg), and took the \$1 million Godolphin Mile with Grey Memo in 2002. Mel, 78, guided Snow Chief to a victory in the 1986 Preakness S. and has accounted for two Breeders' Cup races, taking the Juvenile Fillies with Brave Raj in 1986 and the Sprint with Very Subtle in 1987. He has more than 1,950 winners to his credit. "It's a special honor to have this with Warren and I together, as brothers," said Mel. "We have done so much together. Without his help I could have never gotten here. Hopefully, I've been a help to him. It's something very special to me."
